### \*\*\*Gusty Winds Today, Hard Freeze Tonight\*\*\*

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Gusty north to northeast winds are expected for a second day today. The strongest winds will be in well-aligned valleys (mostly northeast to southwest) with sustained winds around 15 mph with gusts to around 30 mph. Highs today look to reach a bit higher than yesterday, with most of the area rising into the 50s, and the warm spots trying to crack the 60 degree mark. Tonight looks cold again, though - overnight lows are forecast to drop into the upper teens and lower 20s once more.

TODAY: Windy again, with peak gusts for the day near or a little above 25 mph. These strongest winds are expected to be mid-day to early afternoon, and in exposed locations and valleys/drainages oriented northeast to southwest. After a cold start, afternoon temperatures will be modestly warmer than they were Monday.

**High Temperatures:** Minimum Relative Humidity: **General Winds:** 

Valley/Drainages: 57-63° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 ft): 50-57° Ridges (> 5500 ft): 44-50° Valley/Drainages: 12-20% Mid-Slope (4500-5500 ft): 15-25% Ridges (> 5500 ft): 15-30% Valleys and Lower Slopes: NE 10-15 mph, gusts above 20 in open areas and aligned valleys.

Upper Slopes and Ridges: NE to around 15 mph, with 25-30 mph in well-aligned terrain.

Stability: Weak inversion, lifting after 0700 with mixing heights rising to around 5000 ft AGL in the afternoon.

Chance of Precipitation: 0% LAL: 1 Transport Winds: NE 15-25 mph.

TONIGHT: Mostly clear, light winds, and cold. A hard freeze is expected across the fire area. Mid-level clouds increase near dawn. Low Temperatures: Valley/Drainages: 19-25° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 ft): 21-27° Ridges (>5500 ft): 19-25° **Humidity Recovery:** Valley/Drainages: 65-75% Mid-Slope (4500-5500 ft): 60-70% Ridges (> 5500 ft): 60-70% Winds:

Valleys/Drainages: NE 5-10 mph becoming light and variable after 2300.

Slopes and Ridges: NE 5-10 mph, becoming downslope 5 mph or less after 2300.

Stability: A more typical nighttime inversion returns after a two night absence, forming after 1900.

Chance of Precipitation: 5% LAL: 1 Transport Winds: Light and variable.

WEDNESDAY: Becoming partly cloudy and a little bit warmer, with some spots managing to see high temperatures above 60 degrees. Winds continue to gradually diminish, but some afternoon gustiness may linger. A slight chance for very light flurries or a shower of snow pellets returns, mainly in the morning. If there is precipitation, no accumulation or impacts are expected.

12 mph after 1400.

Upper Slopes and Ridges: W below 10 mph until 1100, then increasing to 10-15 mph for the

afternoon.

Stability: Inversion lifting after 0800 with afternoon mixing heights 6500-7000 ft AGL. Chance of Precipitation: 15% LAL: 1 Transport Winds: W 10-20 mph.

Extended Outlook: For the second half of the week, expect a slow, gradual warming trend, but chilly nights will remain the norm. After a weak upper disturbance passes through Wednesday into very early Thursday brings a tiny chance of a shower, fair but dry weather and moderate winds are forecast to prevail through at least the weekend.

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### **GENERAL:**

\*Northeast California Energy Release Component is about 55\*

- Expect very little fire activity with a few isolated areas of smoldering and creeping in unburned interior islands, dozer berms, stumpholes and post-burn needlecast. Strong northeast could cause rapid fire spread outside of containment lines.
- Fuels are grass, brush and timber Scott and Burgan fuel models GS2, SH3/4/9, TU1/5 and TL 6/9. 1000-hour fuel moistures are < 10% and live fuels are 60 70%.
- **Topography is varied** and includes mountains, hills, drainages, benches and meadows. The elevation ranges from 4000' to over 8000' in Lassen Park. All aspects are represented and slopes range from 0 to 80%.

#### SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Very low fire behavior and potential. Very few smoldering hotspots remain within the fire perimeter.

West Zone: There are a few areas of unburned interior islands of vegetation in Lassen Park and Lassen Forest/Prospect Peak/Cluster Lakes areas that will continue to burn themselves out with low intensity. Light smoke may be visible. Any new starts or fire outside containment lines near DIV's S, P, O, N and L could rapidly spread southwesterly.

East Zone: Very little heat evident. There may be a few remaining hot stumpholes and buried heat in dozer berms. Very light smoke visible near Greenville but not a threat to containment lines.

Maximum Fire Behavior (new starts or outside of containment lines):

- Surface Flame Lengths 6-9'
- Rate of Spread 15-35 chains/hour grass and 10-20 chains/hour in timber
- Spotting Distance up to ½-½ mile
- Probability of Ignition 60%



Manage conflict well, often, and with respect or it will manage you into chaos.

# 8. MEDICAL EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

#### LINE "MEDICAL-EMERGENCY" PLAN:

- Crew Supervisor to contact Division Supervisor/Operations with:
  - Patient Complaint, Condition and Location via Tactical or Command frequency. Priority 1/Red Tag or Priority 2/Yellow Tag trigger Incident within Incident (IWI).
- -Division Supervisor/Operations contacts East Zone Communications: If Red Priority Request Emergency Traffic/Clear Channel
  - Division Supervisor or POC\* will run "Medical –Emergency" on the Command frequency.

#### **EMERGENCY DURING OPS. BRIEF 0700-0730:**

 If you have an emergency while briefing is going on over the command channel. Wait for a break and transmit your emergency traffic.

#### **LINE "NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT" PLAN:**

- Crew Supervisor to contact Division Supervisor with:
  - Patient Complaint, Condition and Location via Tactical or Command frequency. Priority 3/Green Tag Patients only trigger an Incident within Incident (IWI) if they are being transported to a medical facility.
- Division Supervisor contacts East Zone Communications:
  - Division Supervisor or POC\* will run "Non-Emergency Incident" on the Command frequency.
  - Division Supervisor or POC\* will use "Medical Incident Report" on back/next page of 206

FOR A <u>MEDICAL EMERGENCY</u>: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM COMMUNICATIONS

Use the following items to communicate situation to communications/dispatch.

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report) Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.

Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.)
