

Ensure firefighter and public safety by using strategies and tactics, with the highest probability of success, that keeps the fire within the existing containment lines and minimize the impact to the cultural, heritage, and natural resources. 2. Implement and/or account for the repair of fire suppression-related activities as specified in the Dixie Fire Suppression Repair plan 3. Identify and communicate hazards and conduct actions only when risks have been mitigated to acceptable level. 4. Maintain an elevated awareness of current COVID-19 precautions and best infectious disease control measures to ensure the health of fire personnel and the public. 5. Provide safe and efficient initial attack within the current fire area or when requested by the local units. 6. Provide timely and accurate information to the public, stakeholders, cooperators and the adjacent incident management teams (East & West zones) about fire status, fire management strategies and tactics, repair efforts, and any potential fire-related safety and health concerns. 7. Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk. <p>Control Objectives: Keep the fire within the current containment lines and maintain availability for initial attack if requested.</p>

Suppression damage repair - Repair damage to Forest Service improvements. Repair or minimize damage to soil, water, and other resources directly attributable to the fire suppression activity on National Forest System lands. Repair or stabilize watershed areas that have had their erosion potential significantly increased, or their drainage pattern altered by suppression-related activities.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Intermittent rain continues today, with highest amounts on the west side of the fire and drier on the east side of the fire. This is due to rain shadowing from the Sierras. Conditions will continue to stay cool and cloudy with generally fall-like conditions. Though rain will continue, this afternoon into tonight will be a brief reprieve from heavier precipitation. Expect elevated winds in the morning to taper off in the afternoon hours. Plenty of moisture in the area will keep RH values elevated.

TODAY: Cloudy. Rain on western side of the fire with totals 0.25-0.5 inches. Rain Showers on the east side of the fire with totals up to 0.1 inches. Visibility may be reduced in rain. Wind conditions with wind and rain tapering in the afternoon.

High Temperatures: Valley/Drainages: 48-55° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 43-48° Ridges (> 5500 FT): 40-45°
Minimum Relative Humidity: Valley/Drainages: 45-50% Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 50-55% Ridges (> 5500 FT): 50-60%

Interior heat islands (near DP-301): Southwest winds 15-25 mph with gusts to 35 mph possible in the morning.
DIV S/U: Southwest winds 10-20 mph with gusts to 30 mph possible in the morning.
DIV W/Z: Southwest winds 10-20 mph with gusts to 30 mph possible in the morning.
DIV J/K/L: Southwest winds 15-25 mph with gusts to around 45 mph in higher elevations during the morning. Winds 15-25 mph in the afternoon.
DIV P/O/N: Southwest winds 15-25 mph with gusts to around 45 mph in higher elevations in the morning. Some sheltering due to Lassen Peak may occur. Winds 15-25 mph in the afternoon.

Stability: Weak inversion possible in protected valleys. Inversion break by 1200. Mixing heights will increase to around 2900 FT.
Chance of Precipitation: 60% **LAL:** 1 **Transport Winds:** Southwest 40-45 mph.

TONIGHT: Precipitation chances will decrease into the overnight hours and then increase in the early morning hours. Some snow possible above 6000 FT elevation. Winds will decrease overnight but not fully subside. Cloudy conditions.

Low Temperatures: Valley/Drainages: 25-39° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 30-35° Ridges (>5500 FT): 25-30°
Relative Humidity Recovery: Susanville ICP: 35-38° Hat Creek Spike: 36-39°
Valley/Drainages: > 95% Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): >95% Ridges (> 5500 FT): > 95%

Interior heat islands (near DP-301): South-Southwest winds 15-20 mph.
DIV S/U: South-Southwest winds 8-15 mph.
DIV W/Z: South-Southwest winds 12-20 mph.
DIV J/K/L: South-Southwest winds 15-20 mph.
DIV P/O: South-Southwest 12-20 mph. Some downslope enhancement may occur to 25 mph.

Stability: Weak inversion in protected valleys possibly setting up around 0400 PDT (Thursday)
Chance of Precipitation: 50% **LAL:** 1 **Transport Winds:** Southwest 30-40 mph.

Extended Outlook (Thursday through Sunday): The active weather pattern will continue through the weekend. Light rain is expected again Thursday, mainly on western areas of the fire. A pattern shift and increase in weather intensity begins Friday and lasts through the weekend. Event total rainfall amounts remain uncertain, but Sunday could be the start of a significant and highly impactful event. Winds remain elevated through the extended outlook, with another round of high winds possible on Sunday.

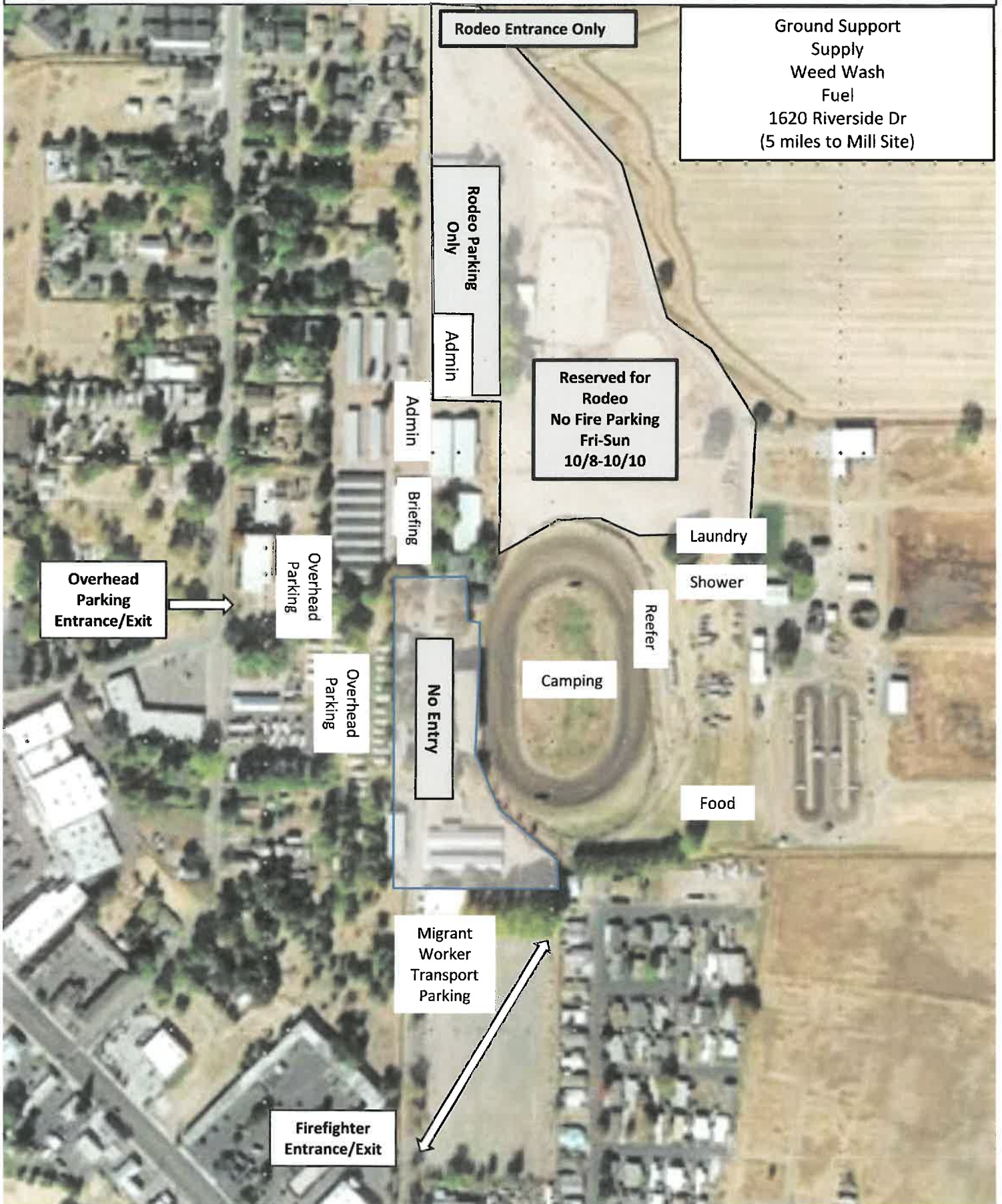
