WEATHER DISCUSSION: Rain showers are present again today, with highest amounts on the west side of the fire and drier on the east side of the fire. This is due to rain shadowing from the Sierras. Though rain will continue through the day, it should just be light showery precipitation. Conditions will continue to stay cool and cloudy with generally fall-like conditions. Winds will still be breezy but lighter than yesterday. Tonight into tomorrow a weather system will drop heavy rain so a Flash Flood Watch has been issued. Please see the tonight section for details.

TODAY: Cloudy. Rain on western side of the fire with totals 0.25-0.5 inches. Rain Showers on the east side of the fire with totals up to 0.15 inches. Visibility may be reduced in rain.

High Temperatures: Valley/Drainages: 48-55 ° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 43-48° Ridges (> 5500 FT): 45-50° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 70-90% Ridges (> 5500 FT): 70-90%

Interior heat islands (near DP-301): Southwest winds 15-25 mph.

FLASH FLOOD WATCH 2300 TONIGHT UNTIL 1100 FRIDAY MORNING

<u>TONIGHT:</u> Cloudy with showers. Significant rain will arrive in the early morning hours, around 0500L, starting on the West Side of the fire. Rain will be heavy at times, so flash flooding with debris flows are possible.

Extended Outlook (Friday through Monday): The incoming weather front tonight will continue through Friday morning. Therefore, the Flash Flood Watch remains in effect until 1100 Friday morning. This system will exit Friday afternoon, cooling temperatures behind it. Saturday will see a brief reprieve from impactful weather, with just some passing rain showers, with snow at higher elevations. Sunday sees the next weather front move in, which is anticipated to be a significant event. Heavy rain is anticipated Sunday, followed by cooling temperatures and snow Tuesday. Snow may be heavier in passes and higher elevations. Windy conditions will be present as well with the passage of this system. Please pay attention to this active weather pattern.

Safety Thought:

"MODULE AS ONE"

Module as One should be used by crews and modules to reduce exposures to COVID-19 and other sickness from outside resources or the public. Face coverings must still be worn within the module when operating in close quarters EXCEPT when alone, when outside and able to maintain at least 6-feet of distance, or actively engaged in firefighting on the fireline.

Key Points:

- Exposing yourself could mean also exposing your module and your family. Crews and modules should limit close contact with other resources and the public on incidents to insulate their module. When coming into close contact or riding in vehicles, all resources should wear cloth face coverings or masks. While the practice of handshaking, hugging, or any physical contact is a deeply rooted etiquette within the United States, this practice should be avoided to reduce further potential for disease transmission.
- Further reduce exposure by identifying select individuals on your crew or module that will pick up meals and supplies, interact with the public and enter ICP. Ensure these select individuals protect themselves by using face coverings, physical distance, and good hand hygiene during every interaction. This is especially important when working in or traveling through an area with high community transmission.



Step 5: Deliver Unit Logs, Performance Evaluations and other documentation to the Documentation Unit at the ICP. If you are unable to check-out at the ICP, arrange with your supervisor to deliver your documentation to the Documentation Unit.

Step 6: After you have completed the applicable previous Steps, use the QR code to complete the demob process.

Medical Incident Report

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT, WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM ICP COMMUNICATIONS.

Use the following items to communicate situation to ICP COMMUNCIATIONS.

- 1. CONTACT ICP COMMUNICATIONS: (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)
 - Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic.
- 2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.

Ex: "ICP Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.) This will be the Trout Meadow Medical, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
