<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION</u>: Calm weather today. Cool and mostly cloudy conditions remain with some light showers. The next major storm will enter tonight, bringing heavy rain to the area tonight. As a result, a flood watch has been issued starting at 2300L. Expect heavy rain to continue through the day tomorrow.

**TODAY:** Cool and cloudy conditions with light rain showers and snow showers at higher elevations. Winds out of the southwest.

**Extended Outlook (Sunday through Wednesday):** Sunday will see the arrival of our next major storm. Expect significant rain Sunday, causing major impacts. Rainfall should be between 2 and 5 inches. A flood watch has been issued due to this heavy rain.

Temperatures will be cooling Sunday into Monday, dropping snow levels to 5500 ft. This will bring snow to many areas of the fire, with most locations seeing between 2 and 6 inches. A winter weather watch has been issued for higher elevations as a result. We can also expect strong winds Sunday into Monday with winds gusting as high as 40 mph. Rain and snow will linger through Tuesday depending on the elevation. Weather will eventually clear late Tuesday and Wednesday will see fair weather with warming temperatures.

#### "MODULE AS ONE"

**Module as One** should be used by crews and modules to reduce exposures to COVID-19 and other sickness from outside resources or the public. Face coverings must still be worn within the module when operating in close quarters EXCEPT when alone, when outside and able to maintain at least 6-feet of distance, or actively engaged in firefighting on the fireline.

#### **Key Points:**

- Exposing yourself could mean also exposing your module and your family. Crews and modules should limit close contact with other resources and the public on incidents to insulate their module. When coming into close contact or riding in vehicles, all resources should wear cloth face coverings or masks. While the practice of handshaking, hugging, or any physical contact is a deeply rooted etiquette within the United States, this practice should be avoided to reduce further potential for disease transmission.
- Further reduce exposure by identifying select individuals on your crew or module that will pick up meals and supplies, interact with the public and enter ICP. Ensure these select individuals protect themselves by using face coverings, physical distance, and good hand hygiene during every interaction. This is especially important when working in or traveling through an area with high community transmission.



NOTE: IF YOU ARE TRAVELING HOME BY AIR, YOU MUST CONTACT THE DEMOBILIZATION UNIT NOT LESS THAN 72 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR DEMOB DATE TO CONFIRM TRAVEL INFORMATION.

#### **EXTENSIONS AND CREW SWAPS**

**Extensions** –when Equipment and Overhead personnel are assigned longer than 14 consecutive days

- Your DIVS/Unit Leader will ask if you want to extend
- Obtain an "Extension Request Form" and fill out section A and C (be specific on number of days to be extended, first working dates, R&R dates,..., etc.)
- Have your DIVS/Unit Leader sign section B (incident supervisor) and Approved by #2, then have your home unit supervisor sign Section D. (if your supervisor isn't available to sign, an email is acceptable).
- Return form to DIVS/Unit Leader or Unit Leader to be routed for other signatures.

#### **Crew Swaps** – <u>when swapping equipment operators</u>

- Within 2 days of DEMOB (aka, your name appears on Tentative DEMOB list), fill out the "Departing and Arriving Person(s) Section" of the form.
- Submit completed and OSC approved Crew Swap form to Plans/Demob/Check-In at ICP or email to 2021.dixie.ca.west.checkin@firenet.gov.

Incoming/relief personnel will NEED TO HAVE A COVID-19 TEST <u>prior</u> to going to the line. (see COVID-19 testing page)

The PLANS/DEMOB/CHECKIN trailer will be staffed from 0630-1030 daily.

#### **Medical Incident Report**

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT, WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM ICP COMMUNICATIONS.

Use the following items to communicate situation to ICP COMMUNCIATIONS.

1. CONTACT ICP COMMUNICATIONS: (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic.

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.

Ex: "ICP Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.) This will be the Trout Meadow Medical, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
