

Management Objectives:			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Ensure firefighter and public safety by using strategies and tactics, with the highest probability of success, that keeps the fire within the existing containment lines and minimize the impact to the cultural, heritage, and natural resources.</li> <li>2. Implement and/or account for the repair of fire suppression-related activities as specified in the Dixie Fire Suppression Repair plan</li> <li>3. Identify and communicate hazards and conduct actions only when risks have been mitigated to acceptable level.</li> <li>4. Maintain an elevated awareness of current COVID-19 precautions and best infectious disease control measures to ensure the health of fire personnel and the public.</li> <li>5. Provide safe and efficient initial attack within the current fire area or when requested by the local units.</li> <li>6. Provide timely and accurate information to the public, stakeholders, cooperators and the adjacent incident management teams (East &amp; West zones) about fire status, fire management strategies and tactics, repair efforts, and any potential fire-related safety and health concerns.</li> <li>7. Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.</li> </ol>

Keep the fire within the current containment lines and maintain availability for initial attack if requested.			
<b>4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:</b>			
An audible is a verbal instruction that can slightly change the predetermined play, or completely scrap it for something else. A quarterback often calls an audible when he doesn't like how the offensive play that was called matches up with the defensive formation. Apply the audible concept to your work assignment: are you prepared to adjust the plan to meet changed conditions?

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Calm weather today. Cool and mostly cloudy conditions remain with some light showers. The next major storm will enter tonight, bringing heavy rain to the area tonight. **As a result, a flood watch has been issued starting at 2300L.** Expect heavy rain to continue through the day tomorrow.

**TODAY:** Cool and cloudy conditions with light rain showers and snow showers at higher elevations. Winds out of the southwest.

**High Temperatures:** Valley/Drainages: 40-45° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 38-42° Ridges (> 5500 FT): 35-40°  
**Minimum Relative Humidity:** Valley/Drainages: 55-70% Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 70-90% Ridges (> 5500 FT): 70-90%

**DIV S/U:** SW winds 10-20 mph gusting to 30 mph in the morning.  
**DIV W/Z:** SW winds 10-20 mph.  
**DIV J/K/L:** SW 10-20 mph.  
**DIV P/O/N:** SW winds 10-20 mph gusting to 30 mph in the morning.

**Snow Level:** 6000 feet rising to 7000 feet.  
**Chance of Precipitation:** 70% **Transport Winds:** West-Southwest around 30 mph.

### **\*\*\*FLOOD WATCH BEGINNING 2300L TONIGHT\*\*\***

**TONIGHT:** Cloudy skies and rain beginning after midnight. Winds increasing out of the Southwest.

**Low Temperatures:** Valley/Drainages: 28-38° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 30-35° Ridges (>5500 FT): 30-35°  
**Susanville ICP:** 35-38°  
**Relative Humidity Recovery:** Valley/Drainages: > 95% Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): >95% Ridges (> 5500 FT): > 95%

**DIV S/U:** Southwest winds 10-20 mph increasing to 20-30 mph gusting to 35 mph after midnight.  
**DIV W/Z:** Southwest winds 10-20 mph increasing to 20-30 mph gusting to 35 mph after midnight.  
**DIV J/K/L:** Southwest winds 10-20 mph increasing to 20-30 mph gusting to 35 mph after midnight.  
**DIV P/O/N:** Southwest 10-20 mph increasing to 20-30 mph gusting to 35 mph after midnight.

**Snow Level:** About 7000 feet.  
**Chance of Precipitation:** 100% **Transport Winds:** Southwest 30-40 mph.

**Extended Outlook (Sunday through Wednesday):** Sunday will see the arrival of our next major storm. Expect significant rain Sunday, causing major impacts. Rainfall should be between 2 and 5 inches. A flood watch has been issued due to this heavy rain. Temperatures will be cooling Sunday into Monday, dropping snow levels to 5500 ft. This will bring snow to many areas of the fire, with most locations seeing between 2 and 6 inches. A winter weather watch has been issued for higher elevations as a result. We can also expect strong winds Sunday into Monday with winds gusting as high as 40 mph. Rain and snow will linger through Tuesday depending on the elevation. Weather will eventually clear late Tuesday and Wednesday will see fair weather with warming temperatures.



*Module as One should be used by crews and modules to reduce exposures to COVID-19 and other sickness from outside resources or the public. Face coverings must still be worn within the module when operating in close quarters EXCEPT when alone, when outside and able to maintain at least 6-feet of distance, or actively engaged in firefighting on the fireline.*

**Key Points:**

- *Exposing yourself could mean also exposing your module and your family.* Crews and modules should limit close contact with other resources and the public on incidents to insulate their module. When coming into close contact or riding in vehicles, all resources should wear cloth face coverings or masks. While the practice of handshaking, hugging, or any physical contact is a deeply rooted etiquette within the United States, this practice should be avoided to reduce further potential for disease transmission.
- *Further reduce exposure by identifying select individuals on your crew or module that will pick up meals and supplies, interact with the public and enter ICP.* Ensure these select individuals protect themselves by using face coverings, physical distance, and good hand hygiene during every interaction. This is especially important when working in or traveling through an area with high community transmission.
