- > Rain & Wind Shelter in safe locations to minimize exposure.
- > Flash Flooding Avoid flooded areas. Turn Around Don't Drown!
- ➤ **Debris Flows** Avoid low areas, drainages and creeks. Move to higher ground.
- > Driving Watch for debris on roads. Wet, slippery roads and limited visibility.
- ➤ Hazard Trees Assess all trees in your work, staging and sleeping areas.
- > Steep Terrain & Rolling Debris Evaluate the necessity to send personnel into areas.
- ➤ Foot Travel Be careful walking in mud and areas with slick rocks, deep puddles.
- Extended Medical Extraction Times: Make a solid medical plan with your division in the morning. Make sure all resources understand the plan.
- COVID 19 and Illnesses Wash hands frequently, practice social distancing, wear face coverings when and where required. Avoid congregating in groups.

#### Fire/Flood/Landslide area Not Scouted and Sized up

- Do you know the condition of the roads?
  - Ask yourself: Is this travel necessary?
- Are there areas in your division that have a high likelihood for debris flow?
  - Watch out for steep slopes with no vegetation.
  - Do you have egress if the road is compromised due to a landslide?
- Is it too wet to accomplish work objectives?
- Notify appropriate authorities prior to taking repair action on a debris flow.

#### **Guidance On Safe Transition To Home Unit**

#### After Demobilization

The Incident Commander and the EAIMT leadership offer this informational guidance to refer to concerning safe travel after demobilization from the Dixie East Zone during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Once you leave the Incident, you will lose the protective "bubble" you have built up and will be traveling among the public. It is readily evident that social distancing, handwashing, and vaccinations are inconsistent in many communities that you will travel through.

For you to remain free from exposure to COVID-19, you will need to be especially disciplined in continuing these common practices. The safe practices that have been developed for health and safety remain:

- Social Distance: Maintain minimum of 6 feet spacing whenever possible. Expose as
  few team members as possible to public areas like shops and convenience stores
  whenever possible. Avoid unnecessary face-to-face or close contact with persons
  outside your module while in transit. Avoid sharing food, utensils, or personal items.
- Mask: Wear your mask, especially if you are not vaccinated.
- Hand Hygiene: Continue regular hand hygiene. Wash hands for 20-30 seconds with soap and water. You may substitute hand sanitizer as needed. Rub generously into all hand surfaces for 20-30 seconds.
- Disinfect and Clean Common Spaces: Clean and disinfect all areas such as door handles (interior and exterior), dashboards, steering wheel, buttons/knobs, and other interior surfaces. Be especially careful of contact with public items, including gas pumps, door handles, restroom surfaces and keypads.
- Regular Monitoring and Self-Assessment: Daily self-check using the standard symptom list. Maintain awareness of any change in your health. Immediately discuss with your supervisor should you exhibit symptoms.

Should you develop symptoms and exhibit distress, seek care immediately. Do not delay care to continue travel to your home unit.

Symptoms to monitor (This list does not include all possible symptoms):

- Headache
- New Loss of Taste or Smell
- Sore Throat
- Congestion or Runny Nose
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fever or Chills

- Measured Temperature of 100.4 or Greater
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or Body Aches


