WEATHER DISCUSSION: Major storm continues into the morning. *Expect a storm total of 2-5 inches of rain and 2-6 inches of snow above 5500ft. Flooding and debris flows are possible through the morning. A winter weather warning has been issued as a result.* The heavy precipitation ends this morning, with showers remaining this afternoon. Winds stay strong today, up to 35 mph mainly in the morning. Weather does begin to calm this afternoon and clears Tuesday.

*****WINTER STORM WARNING*****

TODAY: Heavy Rain and snow early in the morning. Flash flooding/debris flow possible in the AM. Strong southwest winds, highest gusts in the morning and along ridgetops. Rain/snow showers continue in the afternoon, mainly in areas of terrain on the western and southwest divisions of the West Zone.

High Temperatures: Valley/Drainages: 43-50° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 35-40° Ridges (> 5500 FT): 30-37°

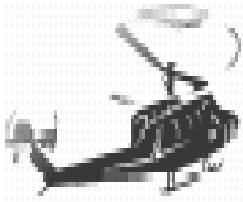

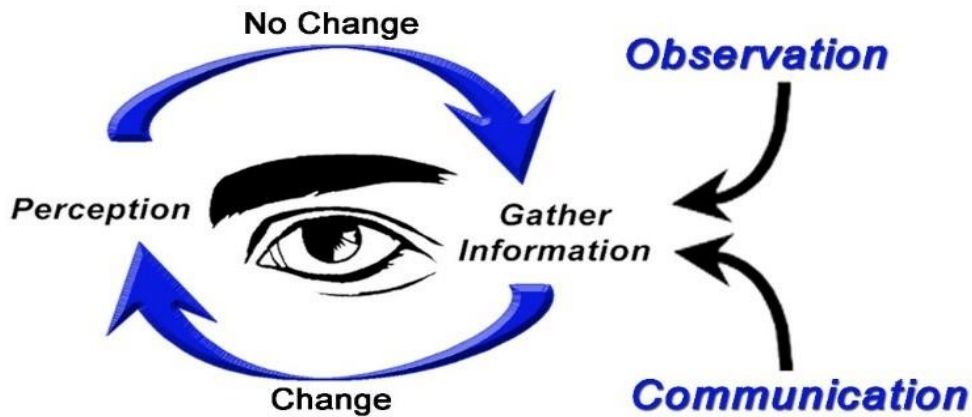

The Situation is Always Changing



AWARENESS!

- Maintain situational awareness to anticipate needed actions.
- Develop contingencies and consider consequences. (Risk vs Gain)
- Improvise within leader's intent to handle a rapidly changing environment (IRPG p vii)

Driving: Some roads are slick. Do not drive roads unless necessary.

Flexibility: Remain flexible in an ever-changing environment.

Communication: Communicate any changes to those you supervise, subordinates and adjoining resources.

Safety Message:

SAFETY IS OUR FIRST PRIORITY
Firefighter safety comes first on every fire, every time.



Safety Thought:

“MODULE AS ONE”

Module as One should be used by crews and modules to reduce exposures to COVID-19 and other sickness from outside resources or the public. Face coverings must still be worn within the module when operating in close quarters EXCEPT when alone, when outside and able to maintain at least 6-feet of distance, or actively engaged in firefighting on the fireline.

Key Points:

- *Exposing yourself could mean also exposing your module and your family.* Crews and modules should limit close contact with other resources and the public on incidents to insulate their module. When coming into close contact or riding in vehicles, all resources should wear cloth face coverings or masks. While the practice of handshaking, hugging, or any physical contact is a deeply rooted etiquette within the United States, this practice should be avoided to reduce further potential for disease transmission.
- *Further reduce exposure by identifying select individuals on your crew or module that will pick up meals and supplies, interact with the public and enter ICP.* Ensure these select individuals protect themselves by using face coverings, physical distance, and good hand hygiene during every interaction. This is especially important when working in or traveling through an area with high community transmission.

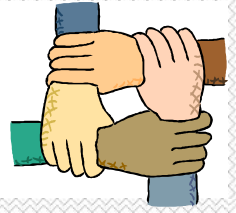

Step 2: Return all accountable property (i.e., radios, supplies, etc.) to the COMS Unit and/or SUPPLY at Hat Creek or ICP.

Step 3: ALL NON-LOCAL VEHICLES that have been off pavement must go through WEED WASH at: 1620 Riverside Dr. Susanville, CA prior to demobilizing.

Step 4: Finalize all CTRs and Shift Tickets and complete any other required Finance demobilization item(s). For **FINANCE** questions: call **279-203-4435** or email **2021.dixie.ca.west.finance@firenet.gov**.

Step 5: Deliver Unit Logs, Performance Evaluations and other documentation to the Documentation Unit at the ICP. If you are unable to check-out at the ICP, arrange with your supervisor to deliver your documentation to the Documentation Unit.

Step 6: After you have completed the applicable previous Steps, use the QR code to complete the demob process.

The Demobilization Unit will not demobilize you from the incident until it has received completed virtual Demobilization Form. For DEMOB questions, email 2021.dixie.ca.west.demob@firenet.gov or call 279-203-4451.

NOTE: IF YOU ARE TRAVELING HOME BY AIR, YOU MUST CONTACT THE DEMOBILIZATION UNIT NOT LESS THAN 72 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR DEMOB DATE TO CONFIRM TRAVEL INFORMATION.

EXTENSIONS AND CREW SWAPS

Extensions – when Equipment and Overhead personnel are assigned longer than 14 consecutive days

- Your DIVS/Unit Leader will ask if you want to extend
- Obtain an “Extension Request Form” and fill out section A and C (be specific on number of days to be extended, first working dates, R&R dates,...., etc.)
- Have your DIVS/Unit Leader sign section B (incident supervisor) and Approved by #2 , then have your home unit supervisor sign Section D. (if your supervisor isn’t available to sign, an email is acceptable).
- Return form to DIVS/Unit Leader or Unit Leader to be routed for other signatures.

Crew Swaps – when swapping equipment operators

- Within 2 days of DEMOB (aka, your name appears on Tentative DEMOB list), fill out the “Departing and Arriving Person(s) Section” of the form.
- Submit completed and OSC approved Crew Swap form to Plans/Demob/Check-In at ICP or email to 2021.dixie.ca.west.checkin@firenet.gov.

Incoming/relief personnel will NEED TO HAVE A COVID-19 TEST prior to going to the line. (see COVID-19 testing page)

The PLANS/DEMOB/CHECKIN trailer will be staffed from 0630-1030 daily.

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT, WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.
