Overall Fatigue

- Fatigue management goes beyond counting hours on timesheets, it is individualized and overt.
- Cumulative fatigue is dangerous. It prevents sound decision-making, confounds situational awareness, and dulls reaction times. It is as problematic in the office as it is on the fireline.
- Becoming **cold** and **wet** does add to fatigue. Wear warm clothing and take necessary precautions to stay as dry as possible.
- Cumulative fatigue is manifest in the explanations used when folks are asked to take a break, or take a day off..."I don't have time." "There is too much going on." "As soon as things calm down a bit."



Incoming/relief personnel will NEED TO HAVE A COVID-19 TEST <u>prior</u> to going to the line. (see COVID-19 testing page)
