#### **SAFETY THOUGHT**

Hazard trees, both dead and live green trees, are one of the most common risks encountered on the fireline. All firefighters should frequently survey their work area for potential hazard trees.

#### MAJOR HAZARDS AND MITIGATIONS

- Dehydration Drink lots of water with electrolytes
- Spot fires, unburned fuel Ensure LCES is in place
- Bears Keep a clean camp
- Thunderstorms/Lightning hazard Shelter, keep dry
- Snags/Hazard Trees Heads up, share info, fall/flag
- Driving-- Lights on, seatbelts, chock blocks, watch for livestock/wildlife on roads, appropriate speeds.
   Expect the unexpected – Drive Defensively
- Rocky, rough terrain--falls/slips
- Wasps identify hives, share info, flag, avoid



#### IAZARD TREE INDICATORS

- Trees have been burning for an extended period
- Dead or broken tops and limbs overhead
- Absence of needles, bark or limbs

- High risk tree species (rot and shallow root system)
- Numerous down trees, accumulation of down limbs
- Leaning or hung-up trees

#### ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS THAT INCREASE SNAG HAZARDS

- Strong winds
- Diseased or bug-kill areas

- Steep slopes
- Night operations

#### SNAG SAFETY

Size up snags and other hazard trees in the work area. Keep personnel out of high-risk areas.

**Never become complacent.** Keep looking, checking, and listening.

<u>A</u>lways look up. Use lookouts and warning flagging in areas where hazard trees have not been felled.

Get weather reports. Strong winds increase the risk of hazard trees and limbs falling.

Scout out parking, sleeping, and work areas and safety zones. Everywhere you may be.

Advise co-workers of known hazards. Multiple sets of eyes always beat one set.

Face your hazard and take appropriate actions. Never ignore the hazard!

**Examine work area for other hazards.** Never focus on one hazard to the exclusion of others.

Take extra caution around heavy equipment. Working equipment can knock down hazard trees.

You are ultimately responsible for your own safety. The best safety officer for you is YOU!

# Dixie Fire West Zone TYPE 3 TEAM COVID-19 Exposure Notification Plan

**Scenario 1: Individual exhibits signs symptoms of covid.** Supervisor uses chain of command to notify appropriate Command and General (C&G) staff member. C&G staff member informs Safety Officer and/or Incident Covid Advisor of situation. Safety informs Incident Commander of possible case(s). Incident Commander (IC) advises Agency Administrator as outlined in Delegation of Authority.

**Scenario 2: Individual tests positive for Covid:** Incident Covid Advisor (or Incident Safety officer) informs Forest Covid Advisor and Incident Commander of a positive case. Incident Commander advises Agency Administrator of positive case(s) as outlined in the Delegation of Authority.

Scenario 3: Individual(s) has been exposed to another individual who has tested positive with Covid. Incident Covid Advisor (or Incident Safety officer) assists exposed individual in arranging covid testing. Safety Officer informs Forest Covid Advisor and Incident Commander of situation. Incident Commander informs Agency Administrator as outlined in Delegation of Authority.

In all scenarios the Incident Safety Officer will keep the following Command and General Staff members informed of the situation. Finance Section Chief, Planning Section Chief, Logistics Section Chief.

In all scenarios follow protocols established in R5 REGION 5 Pacific Southwest Region COVID-19 Response Action Process c3 (August 18, 2021)
