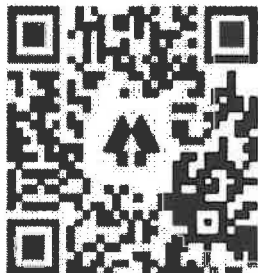

Implement and/or account for the repair of fire suppression-related activities as specified in the Dixie Fire Suppression Repair plan</li> <li>3. Identify and communicate hazards and conduct actions only when risks have been mitigated to acceptable level.</li> <li>4. Maintain an elevated awareness of current COVID-19 precautions and best infectious disease control measures to ensure the health of fire personnel and the public.</li> <li>5. Provide safe and efficient initial attack within the current fire area or when requested by the local units.</li> <li>6. Provide timely and accurate information to the public, stakeholders, cooperators and the adjacent incident management teams (East &amp; West zones) about fire status, fire management strategies and tactics, repair efforts, and any potential fire-related safety and health concerns.</li> <li>7. #### **Major Hazard and Risk:**

- **Hazardous Trees & Roads:** Narrow roads, steep drop offs, erratic drivers, and operator fatigue are all prevalent on this and other assignments. Heads up, always look out for hazard trees around your work area.
- **Hydration:** Stay hydrated, eat properly, drink fluids in a 3:1 ratio of water to sports drinks, take frequent breaks, and pay attention to your body.
- **Extended Extraction Times:** Be familiar with the medical plan. Develop a plan on how you would get an injured firefighter out timely. Factor in how smoke inversions will reduce the likelihood of utilizing helicopters for a medevac.
- **Infectious Disease/COVID-19:** Wash hands frequently, practice social distancing, wear face coverings when required, clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces, don't share cell phones, radios etc.

**Narrative:** As time moves on with this incident, so does our risk. With each passing day the very roots that secure the trees around you are burning away or the tree itself is burning from within just waiting for the right opportunity to come down on you.

**Never stop looking at the environment around you!**

#### Defensive Driving

- **Be a defensive driver at all times.**
- **Drive like other drivers don't see you.**
- **Be courteous to all vehicle traffic to and from the fire area(s).**
- **Don't have side bar conversations on the roads....provide the margin of SAFETY for all road users.**
