WEATHER DISCUSSION: A near critical fire weather threat will exist across the entire area due to hot, dry and breezy conditions. Dense smoke and haze is expected mainly across Divisions Sierra and Uniform. Afternoon humidity values will fall down below 20% for most of the burn area. Generally south to southwest winds will prevail in the afternoon, though winds will be highly variable in areas of complex terrain as well as near the vicinity of smoke columns. Downslope/downvalley winds are expected to develop during the overnight hours.

TODAY:

Weather: Hot, dry, breezy and unstable in the afternoon. Smoke columns likely.

Max Temperatures:

Valley-2000 FT: 95-97°

2000-4000 FT: 79-81°

4000-6000 FT: 74-76°

Minimum Relative Humidity: Valley-2000 FT: 8-13%

2000-4000 FT: 10-15%

4000-6000 FT: 15-20%

20 Foot Winds:

DIV S & U - Humidity recovery will remain poor during the morning hours, especially for elevations above 4,000 feet. Humidity values will briefly fall near or just below 10% before increasing through mid-morning. RH will then fall at all elevations through the day. General upslope and up-valley flow will commence around 1000-1100 coincident with the inversion lifting. Immediately near the intense fire center, winds may be gusty and erratic. Winds will generally be southerly with speeds of 10 to 20 mph in the afternoon. Gusts to near 25 mph are expected (30 mph possible at the highest elevations). Large smoke columns are anticipated, but the potential for lightning remains low (but non-zero).

Stability: Valley inversions lifting around 1000-1100. Becoming unstable early to mid-afternoon with smoke columns highly likely.

CHANCE OF RAIN: 0%

LAL: 2

SMOKE TRANSPORT WINDS: S to SW 20-25 mph in the afternoon

Weather: Cool at ICP, mild at mid/slope and upper elevations. Dense smoke in drainage basins/valleys in DIV S & U.

Max Temperatures:

2000-4000 FT: 67-69°

4000-6000 FT: 67-69°

Relative Humidity Recovery: Valley-2000 FT: 25-30% 2000-4000 FT: 15-20% 4000-6000* FT: 15-20%

*Note, humidity may dip down to or just below 10% just prior to sunrise as downslope/down-valley flow intensifies above 4,000 feet. RH will recover during the morning hours and climb to near 20%.

20 Foot Winds:

SW winds of 10 to 20 mph in the evening will subside down to 5 to 15 mph through mid-evening hours and slowly becoming downslope/down-valley for elevations below 3,000 feet. Elevations above 3,000 feet, down-slope/down-valley flow may not become established until around 0200-0400. Speeds of 5 to 10 mph with gusts to near 15 mph are expected with this down-slope/down-valley flow at elevations above 3,000 feet.

CHANCE OF RAIN: 0%

LAL: 2

SMOKE TRANSPORT WINDS: Becoming down-valley at 5 to 15 mph

The Weekend and Early Next Week: Very hot, dry and breezy conditions are anticipated this weekend. Afternoon temperatures at locations below 2,000 feet (including ICP) will likely eclipse 100 degrees. Afternoon RH values will fall down into the single digits to low teens across much of the burn area. Daily smoke columns are possible. More substantial pyro-cumulus is probable on Sunday with a risk for rain and thunderstorms (wet) next week. Rain/storm chances are around 20%.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Main fire progression will continue to the north and east and be mainly fuels driven. Where wind and slope align expect the potential for extreme fire behavior to include sustained crown runs and long range spotting (1mile+). In general spotting will be less than ¼ mile and from rollout. Areas of the fire that remain under the smoke will see diminished fire activity. These areas will be mainly on the north and east sides and in drainage bottoms. Watch for fire whirl development at intersecting drainages and on the lee side of any large column.

The fire will remain active at night along ridge tops and in canyon bottoms that align with the down canyon winds. All fuels are available to burn and the Probability of Ignition will be 80-90%

SPECIFIC:

West Zone:

Branch I: Expect mainly backing fire along the HWY 70 corridor. There remains a potential for the fire to make down canyon runs at night when the wind reverses. Keep a heads up for fire whirl development. Smoke settling in at night will limit visibility.

Branch V: No forward fire progression expected on DIV F/M. DIV P/Q short range spotting will continue to be problematic but mainly short range. If the Branch remains under the smoke column, this will dampen fire behavior, potentially allowing opportunities for direct attack. If the smoke lifts out, expect a dramatic increase in fire activity and an increase in spotting distances.

Branch X: Most of the Branch will remain under the smoke. The fire is also out alignment with sparser fuels. All of these factors should diminish fire behavior. If the smoke does clear out, expect a dramatic increase in fire activity where wind and slope align.

East Zone:

Branch XX: The fire will most likely be compromising HWY 89 at the beginning of the shift if not expect it to do so early in the day. Expect rapid rates of spread and long range spotting. Structures along HWY 70 will be impact by flanking and backing fire. The new start has the potential to impact travel to much of the Branch.

Branch XV: Expect active flanking and head fire runs along the ridges above HWY 70. There is the potential for the fire to spot over the highway. The fire will continue to back and flank into Buck's Lake. If fire becomes established east of the lake expect wind aligned runs with rapid rates of spread to the east. Smoke should settle in at night and dampen fire behavior. Fly Fire: Expect the fire to continue burning NE. The fire will exhibit extreme rates of spread when burning along aligned ridges. Spotting will be about a quarter mile and from rollout.

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke will limit air operations the north and east sides of the fire and other areas until the smoke mixes out around 1100-1200hrs.

SAFETY

- Make sure lookouts are posted in places where they can see potential spotting.
- Roll out and debris from burned areas will impact HWY 70 and Caribou Rd.
- Smoke impacts to powerlines, review powerline safety in the IRPG.
