1. Keep informed on FIRE WEATHER conditions and forecasts.
2. Know what your FIRE is DOING at all times; observe personally, use scouts.
3. Base all action on current and expected BEHAVIOR of FIRE.
4. Have ESCAPE ROUTES for everyone and make them known.
5. Post a LOOKOUT when there is possible danger.
6. Be ALERT, keep CALM, THINK clearly, ACT decisively.
7. Maintain prompt COMMUNICATION with your men, your boss, and adjoining forces.
8. Give clear INSTRUCTIONS and be sure they are understood.
9. Maintain CONTROL of your men at all times.
10. Fight fire aggressively but provide for SAFETY first.

# Dixie Fire East Zone Weather Forecast



**FORECAST NO:** 4

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Very dense smoke and pyro-cumulus (low lightning potential) is forecast today with increasing rain/storm chances tonight into Tuesday (20-30%). Widespread wetting rainfall is unlikely and the main concern will be for lightning strikes outside of rain cores as well as gusty and erratic outflow winds. Smoke and haze may improve for southern portions of the fire area on Tuesday.

**TODAY:** Very warm and blustery. Haze and Very Dense Smoke. ***Smoke Columns and Pyro-Cumulus both possible with lightning. Gusty and erratic winds should be expected near the collapse of columns/pyro-cumulus.***

<b>Max Temperatures:</b>	<b>Valley-2000 FT:</b> 88-93°	<b>2000-4000 FT:</b> 88-93°	<b>4000-6000 FT:</b> 82-87°
<b>Minimum Relative Humidity:</b>	<b>Valley-2000 FT:</b> 12-17%	<b>2000-4000 FT:</b> 13-18%	<b>4000-6000 FT:</b> 13-18%

**Fly Fire:** Early morning downslope/down-valley (generally SE winds) flow under 5 mph will yield to increasing upslope/up-valley flow between 1200-1400 (largely W-WNW breezes around 4-9 mph w/ gusts to 12 mph). Between 1500-1600, W-SW winds increase into the 8 to 12 mph range with gusts to near 18 mph. Minimum RH 10-15%.

**East of Greenville "Y":** Morning downslope/down-valley flow becoming upslope/up-valley between 1300-1500 (winds will be 5 mph or less). Between 1500-1700 westerly winds (WNW near Greenville and WSW near Crescent Mills) will increase into the 10 to 15 mph range with gusts to near 18 mph. Minimum RH 13-18%.

**Bucks Lake Area:** Morning downslope/down-valley flow (generally NE winds) under 6 mph will become upslope/up-valley (southerly winds) between 0900-1100. Between 1400-1600, upslope flow (W-SW winds) will range between 8-12 mph (gusts to 15 mph). W-SW winds of 10 to 15 mph with gusts to near 17 mph are forecast from 1600-1800. Minimum RH values between 13 and 18% (*higher min RH values immediately near Bucks Lake*).

**Stability:** Inversion around 2,000 – 2,500 FT, likely remaining through 1500. Unstable above 2,500 FT with smoke columns/pyroc.

**CHANCE OF RAIN:** 5%    **LAL:** 1    **TRANSPORT WINDS:** S-SW at 8 to 12 mph.

**TONIGHT:** Dense smoke and haze likely settling into valleys/drainages by early evening. Showers and isolated storms possible after 2200. Gusty and erratic winds possible beneath showers. Isolated lightning strikes possible with storms. Rain amounts are likely to remain below 0.05"

<b>Min Temperatures:</b>	<b>Valley-2000 FT:</b> 55-60°	<b>2000-4000 FT:</b> 58-63°	<b>4000-6000 FT:</b> 58-63°
<b>Relative Humidity Recovery:</b>	<b>Valley-2000 FT:</b> 35-45%	<b>2000-4000 FT:</b> 25-35%	<b>4000-6000 FT:</b> 25-35%

**Fly Fire:** Westerly upslope flow (on west aspects, downslope on east aspects) at 8 to 12 mph with gusts to near 15 mph will subside to under 5 mph between 2200-2300. Upslope flow may continue on south and west aspects, otherwise, expect downslope flow. Speeds will be 3 to 6 mph. RH recovery between 25% and 45%.

**East of Greenville "Y":** Westerly flow at 7 to 12 mph with gusts to 15 mph becoming SW to southerly with speeds diminishing to 4 to 9 mph by 2400. Higher speeds with gusts near 12 mph possible on ridges. Winds near Crescent Mills and Greenville will become light and variable, less than 3 mph. RH recoveries in the East Branch North Fork Feather River Valley will likely remain elevated between 45% and 50%. Mid/upper slopes along the River Valley will likely experience RH recovery between 30%-40%.

**Bucks Lake Area:** Westerly flow at 7 to 12 mph with gusts between 15 to 18 mph becoming southwesterly at 5 to 10 mph (13 mph gusts) by 2200 and remaining elevated through sunrise Tuesday. RH recovery between 40%-45%. RH recovery will increase closer to Bucks Lake.

**Stability:** Inversion by 2400-0200.

**CHANCE OF RAIN:** 20%    **LAL:** 2    **TRANSPORT WINDS:** Becoming SE at 5 to 8 mph around 2300.


**Tuesday through Thursday:** Rain and isolated storm chances continue into Tuesday (around 20-30%). Rain amounts will likely remain below 0.10", except directly beneath shower/storm cores. Isolated lightning strikes outside of precipitation areas are possible along with gusty and erratic winds. Mid-week and beyond: rain/storm-free conditions are expected, but winds will increase Tuesday and Wednesday during the afternoon and overnight hours.

## OUTPUTS

### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**GENERAL:** Main fire progression will continue to the north and east and be mainly fuels driven, however the increase in general winds aloft will increase potential fire behavior. Where wind and slope align expect the potential for extreme fire behavior to include sustained crown runs and long-range spotting (1 mile+). In general, spotting will be less than ¼ mile and from rollout. With the increase in general flow, fire will remain active under the smoke after 1100. Watch for fire whirl development at intersecting drainages and on the lee side of any large column.  
The fire will remain active at night along ridge tops and in canyon bottoms that align with the down canyon winds. All fuels are available to burn and the Probability of Ignition will be 80-90%

### SPECIFIC:

#### East Zone:

**Branch XX:** The fire will continue to impact HWY 70 and 89. Expect rapid rates of spread and long-range spotting. Structures along HWY 70 and 89 will be impacted by intense flanking and backing fire as the fire continues to move north on 89 from the HWY 70/89 junction. \*\*\*Dixie Creek will be the area to watch out for as the fire flanks and backs into it. Fire is established on both sides of HWY 89. Winds have been observed to battle up and down canyon making fire whirls probable\*\*\*.

**XXIII:** Expect the fire to continue burning NE and East. The fire will exhibit extreme rates of spread when burning along aligned ridges and when established at the bottom of any slope. Spotting will be about a quarter mile and from rollout. As the fire slopes over Mount Hough it will fall into a backing alignment, however it will continue to burn aggressively.  
\*\*\*Montgomery Creek is setting up for a slope reversal as fire backs down into it\*\*\*.

**Branch XXV:** Expect active flanking and head fire runs along the ridges. The fire will continue to back and flank into the valley. If fire becomes established east of the lake expect wind aligned runs with rapid rates of spread to the east. As the fire moves east it will burn into difficult terrain and align with west facing slopes. Smoke should settle in at night and dampen fire behavior.

**AIR OPERATIONS:** Smoke will limit air operations to the north and east sides of the fire and other areas until the smoke mixes out around 1100-1200hrs.

## SAFETY

- Heavy smoke will impair visibility for lookouts.
- Roads will be impacted by roll out debris and falling snags in any burn area.
- Smoke impacts to powerlines, review powerline safety in the IRPG.
- Unburned fuel between you and the fire.

- Take down hazard trees only with qualified sawyers and then only if necessary.





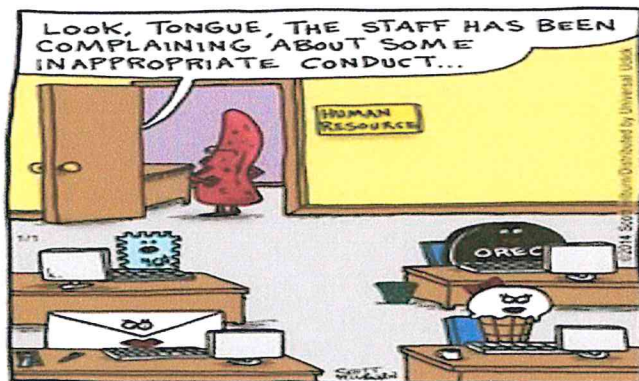
## Incident Behavior

It is extremely important that inappropriate behavior be recognized and dealt with promptly. If inappropriate behavior is allowed to continue, not only would it adversely impact the affected individual, as a witness, you could be held accountable for your inaction.

Inappropriate behavior is considered any form of conduct that negatively impacts the work environment for the affected individual or those who witness the conduct or that violates any Forest Service rule or regulation. Any form of harassment and/or bullying or use of any language that could violate a Civil Rights policy, will not be tolerated and must be reported to your supervisor and the Human Resources Specialist (HRSP).

When you observe or hear of any inappropriate behavior, you should:

- Immediately direct the alleged offender to stop their behavior and counsel them.
- Provide support to anyone who was negatively impacted by the inappropriate behavior.
- If the behavior is minor in nature, such as being rude or discourteous, advise them if the behavior continues, you will need to report the misconduct to Human Resources.
- If the behavior could be interpreted as bullying and/or harassment, immediately contact your supervisor and/or the HRSP.
- Document the inappropriate behavior with facts.
