

Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success.</p> <p><u>Leaders Intent</u></p> <p>Provide the highest level of customer service to all affected by the Dixie Fire. Ensure transparent, timely and accurate communication at all levels of the incident and strengthen relationships with cooperators. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Professional behavior and conduct. Personal safety and the safety of others, including driving slowly and defensively. Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work/rest cycles. Minimize risk and limit exposure to infectious disease by minimizing large group settings, social distancing, wearing face coverings, and handwashing <p><u>Management Objectives</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process. Protect communities, critical infrastructure including transmission towers, communication towers, hydroelectric systems, railroad, and highways. Coordinate all public information with CAL FIRE Team 1 assigned to West Zone of Dixie Fire to provide timely and continuous information to affected agency partners, cooperators, and to the public. Coordinate suppression activities with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources. Ensure resource allocation and mission are documented for cost apportionment. <p><u>Control Objective</u></p> <p>Keep the Dixie Fire:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> East of Hwy 32 to limit fire spread into private timberlands and bordering communities. South of Hwy 36 and Hwy 89 to protect Chester and Lake Almanor communities. West of the Genesee Valley Road and Grizzly Ridge to Hwy 70 to limit fire spread. North of Hwy 162 and the junction of Hwy 70 to protect Quincy and surrounding communities.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Mostly sunny skies are anticipated today and tonight, with a potential for smoke and haze during the morning hours, pending overnight fire activity. The *smoke forecast is highly uncertain* and if smoke lingers, RH will be greater and winds may be more subdued than forecast below. The current forecast will advertise relatively warmer conditions compared to the past several days with mostly cloud-free skies. If dense smoke lingers during peak heating, it'll be cooler than forecast. Winds are expected to elevate with gusts near 15 mph and afternoon humidity values will fall down toward 20%, with some spots seeing min RH near 15%. There will be a less than 5% chance for rain across Branches XX & XXIII this afternoon.

TODAY: Warmer and mostly sunny with pockets of dense smoke in the morning, especially in the drainages and valleys. Patchy smoke during the afternoon. Smoke columns may develop depending on fire behavior.

Max Temperatures:	Valley-2000 FT: 89-94°	2000-4000 FT: 88-93°	4000-6000 FT: 84-89°
Minimum Relative Humidity:	Valley-2000 FT: 17-27%	2000-4000 FT: 18-28%	4000-6000 FT: 18-28%

Mt. Hough Area: ESE to ENE winds (mostly downslope toward the East Fork of the Feather River Valley) at speeds of 2-4 mph. By noon, winds will become more WNW with speeds between 5 and 10 mph. Gust between 13 and 16 mph can be expected along the ridgeline.

Round Valley Reservoir Area: Variable winds (with a slight preference to NE-ESE winds) with speeds under 4 mph. Winds will become more WNW through the day with speeds between 3 and 7 mph. A few gusts to near 10 mph cannot be discounted.

Bucks Lake Area: NE to ESE winds (generally down-valley/downslope) under 5 mph. Winds will shift to become more westerly by noon with speeds between 6 and 12 mph and gusts near 15 mph.

Stability: Inversion lifting between 0900-1100 LT. Unstable in the afternoon with smoke plume potential.

CHANCE OF RAIN: 3% **LAL:** 1 **TRANSPORT WINDS:** S to SSW at 5 to 10 mph.

TONIGHT: Patchy smoke may become more widespread at lower elevations. Winds aloft in the thermal belt may remain more active than previous nights with gusts near 8 mph possible around sunrise.

Min Temperatures:	Valley-2000 FT: 50-55°	2000-4000 FT: 60-65°	4000-6000 FT: 58-62°
Relative Humidity Recovery:	Valley-2000 FT: 55-65%	2000-4000 FT: 35-45%	4000-6000 FT: 35-50%

Mt. Hough Area: Westerly flow diminishing down to below 5 mph by 1000 LT with ESE winds (generally downslope/down-valley) between 1-3 mph, becoming 3-5 mph around 0600.

Round Valley Reservoir Area: WNW winds diminishing down into the 2-4 mph range with periods of variable winds. Some portions of the reservoir area may experience several hours of calm flow.

Bucks Lake Area: West winds of 4 to 8 mph with gusts to near 10 mph through early evening. After 0200-0400 (Thursday morning), downslope/down-valley flow will increase with speeds between 1-6 mph. A gust to near 8 mph is possible.

Stability:

CHANCE OF RAIN: 0% **LAL:** 1 **TRANSPORT WINDS:** SSW becoming ENE with speeds under 5 mph.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Near critically dry conditions will exist through the remainder of the week with afternoon RH falling into the teens. Overnight humidity recovery will be modest with values ranging between 40 and 50 percent. Daytime highs in the 90s can be expected with the typical upslope/up-valley and downslope/down-valley wind patterns anticipated. Patchy dense smoke will be possible, especially across the valleys and in drainage basins. If smoke remains dense, future forecasts will decrease wind magnitudes and increase afternoon minimum RH values. There will be a non-zero risk for a shower or isolated thunderstorm later this week, but the potential is greater farther east of the Dixie East Zone.

WEATHER SUMMARY: Warm and Dry, More Clearing and Instability around 1100 ***5% chance of Isolated T-storms over the fire, approach will be from the south***
Temps: Day 84-94 Night 50-62
RH: Day 17-27% Night 35-55%
Winds: Day Ridges W/SW 5-12 gusts to 16mph Night Ridges 2200 N/NE/E 6-7mph becoming light variable downslope at 0200
Fuels: ERC's will remain at or above the 97th percentile. All fuels are receptive to burn.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Main fire progression will continue to the north and east and be mainly fuels driven. Where wind and slope align expect the potential for extreme fire behavior to include sustained crown runs and long-range spotting (1mile+). In general, spotting will be less than ¼ mile and from rollout. Fire will remain active under the smoke. Watch for fire whirl development at intersecting drainages and on the lee side of any large column.

The fire will remain active at night along ridge tops and in canyon bottoms that align with the down canyon winds.

All fuels are available to burn.

Increased clearing and ventilation of smoke is in the forecast, fire activity will respond and burn aggressively.

SPECIFIC:

East Zone:

Branch XX: The fire will continue to impact HWY 70 and 89. Expect rapid rates of spread and long-range spotting with any head fire runs. Structures along HWY 70 and 89 will be impacted by intense flanking and backing fire as the fire continues to move north on 89 from the HWY 70/89 junction. Burnout operations are expected to hold. ***Dixie Creek will be the area to watch out for as the fire flanks and backs into it. Fire is established on both sides of HWY 89. Winds have been observed to battle up and down canyon making fire whirls probable***.

XXIII: Expect the fire to continue burning northeast and east. The fire will exhibit extreme rates of spread when burning along aligned ridges and when established at the bottom of any slope. Spotting will be about a quarter mile and from rollout. Fire will continue to flank to the south in the area of Gilson Creek and Tollgate Creek. Burnout operations are expected to hold. *** Line construction in Montgomery Creek has been successful, however be on the look out for spots.***

Branch XXV: Expect active flanking and head fire runs along the ridges. The fire will continue to back and flank into the valley. If fire becomes established east of the lake expect wind aligned runs with rapid rates of spread to the east. As the fire moves east it will burn into difficult terrain and align with west facing slopes. Direct attack has been challenging, expect this to continue. ***Smoke is forecasted to clear a bit more, increasing potential fire behavior***.

All Branches: Firing operations will be affected by increasing RH's around 0300. However, in heavier pockets of continuous dead and down, fire will still carry. Take local weather obs.

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke will limit air operations to the north and east sides of the fire area.

SAFETY

- Heavy smoke will impair visibility for lookouts.
- Roads will be impacted by roll out debris and falling snags in any burn area.
- Smoke impacts to powerlines, review powerline safety in the IRPG.
- Unburned fuel between you and the fire.

Signs of Stress

Some signs of stress include anxiety, increased heart rate, increased muscle tone, digestive complaints, inability to sleep well, headaches and increased irritability.

Coping with Stress

1. Track your stressors- Identify which situations create the most stress and how you respond to them. Did you raise your voice? Did you talk to someone about it? Did you take a walk?
2. Develop healthy responses- Instead of attempting to fight the stress, do your best to make healthy choices when you feel the tension rise.
3. Learn how to relax- Techniques such as meditation, breathing exercises, and mindfulness can help melt away stress. You can start by going for a walk in high stressful situations or doing a simple deep breathing exercise while walking to get your next meal. Learn to relax and joke with your team (workplace appropriate), laughter is one of the biggest coping mechanisms to relieve stress.
4. Recharge- When available take the time to recharge and avoid the chronic stress and burnout. During your off time, take the time to unwind so when your next shift comes up, you can come back able to perform your best.
5. Talk to your supervisor- Employee health is a major contribution to the success of the workplace. Start by having a conversation with your supervisor, the purpose of this is not to lay out all of your complaints, but rather to come up with an effective plan to manage the stressors you have identified, so you can perform at your best while on the job.

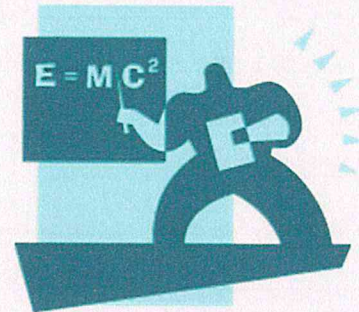

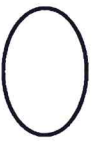

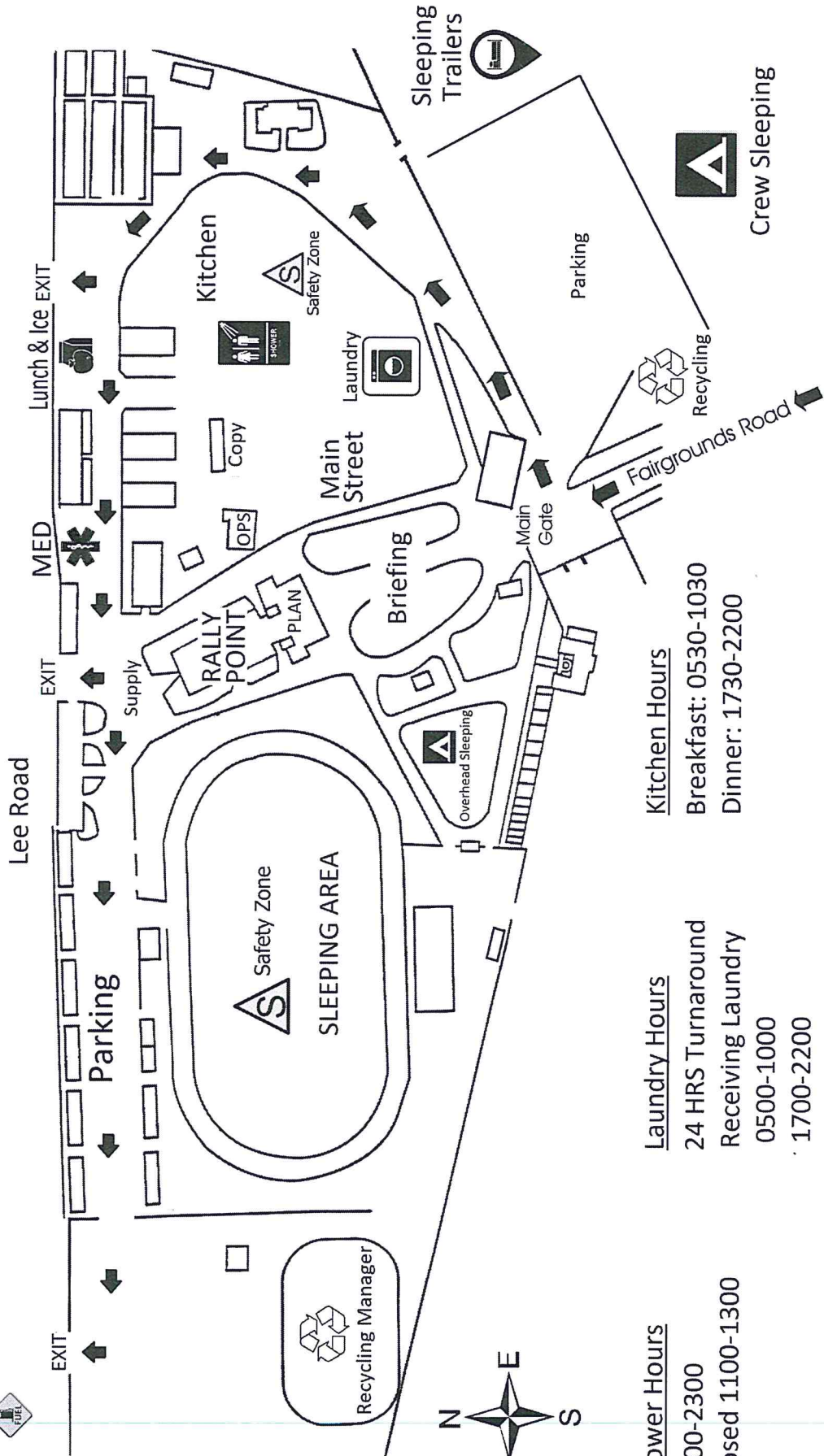
