


WEATHER DISCUSSION: Patchy dense smoke will be most widespread in the drainage basins and valleys, with higher elevations likely seeing mostly sunny skies. The clearing of dense smoke should take place along the outer periphery of the Dixie Fire with interior portions of the fire and ICP seeing reduced visibility until mid to late afternoon. There's a non-zero risk for isolated showers across Branch XX and XXIII in the afternoon. Gusty outflow winds will be possible. Otherwise, near-critical afternoon RH is expected with blustery west winds.

TODAY: Patchy dense smoke expected through the afternoon hours. Otherwise, hot and mostly sunny conditions are expected.

Max Temperatures:	Valley-2000 FT: 93-98°	2000-4000 FT: 94-99°	4000-6000 FT: 94-99°
Minimum Relative Humidity:	Valley-2000 FT: 17-27%	2000-4000 FT: 15-25%	4000-6000 FT: 15-25%

Mt. Hough Area: Down-valley/downslope (cross slope on the east aspect) flow under 5 mph will transition to westerly cross slope to gradual upslope flow (more west-southwest on the west aspect and possibly more NNW on the east aspect). Speeds are expected to range between 8 and 12 mph with gusts to near 15 mph. Ridgeline gusts near 20 mph cannot be discounted.

Round Valley Lake Area: NNE winds will gradually turn more to the west through the day and increase in the afternoon. Speeds should approach 8 to 10 mph with gusts to near 12 mph. Winds may vary between a northerly and southerly direction through the afternoon. Minimum afternoon humidity values in the mid to upper teens.

Bucks Lake Area: 4-8 mph ENE downslope flow will transition to more of a westerly wind by 1400. Speeds are expected to increase into the 8 to 12 mph range by 1500. Gusts to near 18 mph can be anticipated, though a few gusts to near 20-22 mph cannot be ruled out. Minimum afternoon humidity falling down into the upper teens.

Stability: Inversion lifting around 1200-1300 and becoming unstable in the afternoon. Smoke columns possible.
CHANCE OF RAIN: 3% **LAL:**1 **TRANSPORT WINDS:** ENE becoming S by mid-afternoon with speeds around 10 mph.

TONIGHT: Patchy dense smoke developing after sunset. Otherwise, partly cloudy skies with decreasing winds.

Min Temperatures:	Valley-2000 FT: 50-55°	2000-4000 FT: 58-63°	4000-6000 FT: 57-62°
Relative Humidity Recovery:	Valley-2000 FT: 65-75%	2000-4000 FT: 45-65%	4000-6000 FT: 45-65%

Mt. Hough Area: Westerly flow may persist through at least 2200 with speeds between 8 and 12 mph. Gusts to near 15 mph are possible, mainly on the west aspect. Between 2200 to midnight, downslope/down-valley flow will commence with speeds falling to under 5 mph. Min RH toward the lower elevations may climb above 50%, with mid and upper slopes likely falling as low as 45%.

Round Valley Lake Area: NNE winds will subside by 2200 with light and variable winds (between NNE and SW) continuing. Min RH, especially near the lakeshore will remain elevated near 75%, with most other surrounding areas between 50% and 60%.

Bucks Lake Area: Westerly flow will quickly transition to easterly breezes between 2000-2200 immediately near the lakeshore. Closer to DP255 and DP260, N and NE downslope flow will take place. Toward Meadow Valley downslope flow will be out of the SE. Min RH values will range between 65% and 75%.


Stability: Inversion setting in around 2200-2300. Smoke likely becoming trapped beneath inversion in valleys.
CHANCE OF RAIN: 2% **LAL:** 1 **TRANSPORT WINDS:** Becoming calm.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: The extended forecast will be characterized by continued heat and near critically dry afternoon humidity. Overnight humidity recovery will remain above 40%, especially in the drainage areas. Depending on fire behavior and burnout operations, dense smoke may continue to plague the incident site, especially for the valleys and drainages. Non-zero shower chances remain primarily across the divisions in Branch XX. There will be a potential for gusty outflow to arrive from the east and short term trends will be monitored. Increased shading due to cloud cover toward the end of the week may mean that smoke and fog may have difficulty eroding.

WEATHER SUMMARY: Warm and Dry, More Clearing and Instability 1100-1300 ***3% chance of Isolated T-storms over the fire, approach will be from the south***

Temps: Day 86-96 Night 50-62

RH: Day 15-25% Night 55-65%

Winds: Day Ridges W/SW 5-12 gusts to 16mph Night Ridges 2200 N/NE/E 6-7mph becoming light variable downslope at 0200

Fuels: ERC's will remain at or above the 97th percentile. All fuels are receptive to burn.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Main fire progression will continue to the north and east and be mainly fuels driven. However, the fire has fallen out of alignment in most areas and fire behavior is likely to be challenging but manageable. Where wind and slope align expect the potential for extreme fire behavior to include sustained crown runs and long-range spotting (1 mile+). In general, spotting will be less than ¼ mile and from rollout. Fire will remain active under the smoke. Watch for fire whirl development at intersecting drainages and on the lee side of any large column.

The fire will remain active at night along ridge tops and in canyon bottoms that align with the down canyon winds.

All fuels are available to burn.

Increased clearing and ventilation will increase fire activity in the afternoon.

SPECIFIC:

East Zone:

Branch XX: The fire will continue to impact HWY 70 and 89. Expect rapid rates of spread and long-range spotting with any head fire runs. Structures along HWY 70 and 89 will be impacted by intense flanking and backing fire as the fire continues to move north on 89 from the HWY 70/89 junction. Fire will continue to back down the north aspect of Hough Mountain with torching and short intense uphill runs in the afternoon. Burnout operations are expected to hold. ***Fire is established on both sides of HWY 89. Winds have been observed to battle up and down canyon making fire whirls and cross canyon spotting probable***.

XXIII: Expect the fire to continue burning northeast and east. The fire will exhibit extreme rates of spread when burning along aligned ridges and when established at the bottom of any slope. Spotting will be about a quarter mile and from rollout. Fire will continue to flank to the south in the area of Gilson Creek and Tollgate Creek. Burnout operations are expected to hold. Established containment lines are expected to hold. *** Line construction in Montgomery Creek has been successful, however be on the look out for spots.***

Branch XXV: Expect active flanking and head fire runs along the ridges. The fire will continue to back and flank into the valley. If fire becomes established east of the Buck's Lake expect wind aligned runs with rapid rates of spread to the east. As the fire moves east it will burn into difficult terrain and align with west facing slopes. Direct attack has been challenging, expect this to continue. ***Smoke is forecasted to clear a bit more, increasing potential fire behavior***.

All Branches: Firing operations will be affected by increasing RH's around 0300. However, in heavier pockets of continuous dead and down, fire will still carry. Take local weather obs.

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke will limit air operations to the north and east sides of the fire area.

SAFETY

- Heavy smoke will impair visibility for lookouts.
- Roads will be impacted by roll out debris and falling snags in any burn area.
- Smoke impacts to powerlines, review powerline safety in the IRPG.
- Unburned fuel between you and the fire.

Exposure and Effects of Smoke

Smoke has both short and long-term negative health effects. The greatest smoke exposures are direct attack, line holding, burnout activities, and during inversions. While it may be “part of the job”, you can limit your exposure:

- Rotate personnel out of the worst smoke.
- Whenever possible, wait for heavies to burn down before mop-up.
- If you’re close enough to an ignition source to have watery eyes and snotty nose, you are also being exposed to carbon monoxide (CO).
- Monitor yourself and each other for CO exposure symptoms, including **headache, dizziness, nausea, and confusion.**

- Mutual Respect is your responsibility to treat people with dignity and respect, it is also your right to receive the same treatment.

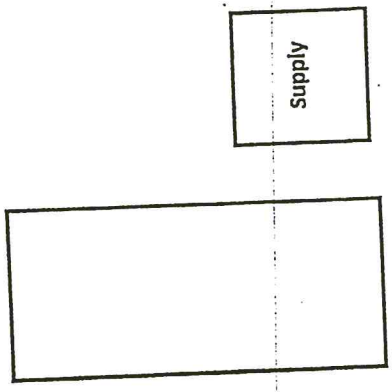
Some things to remember while on this incident:

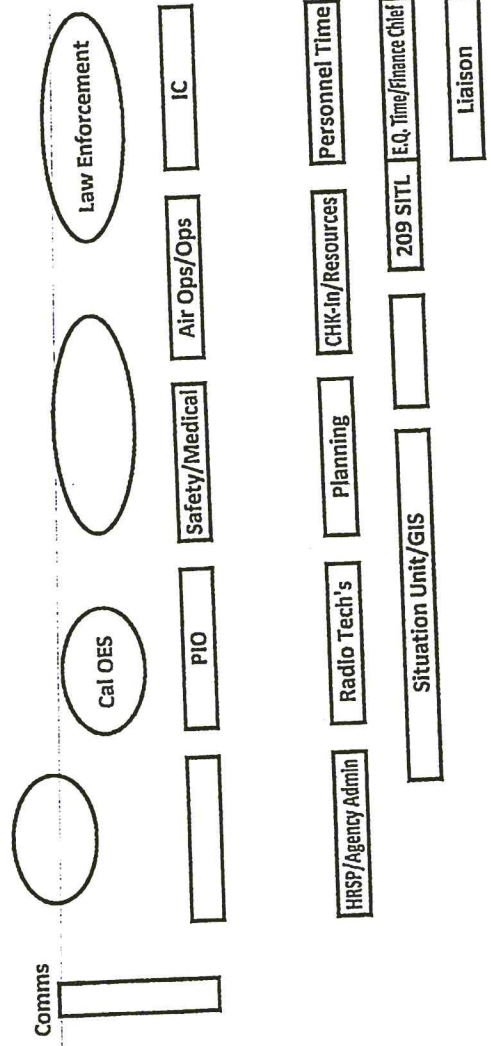

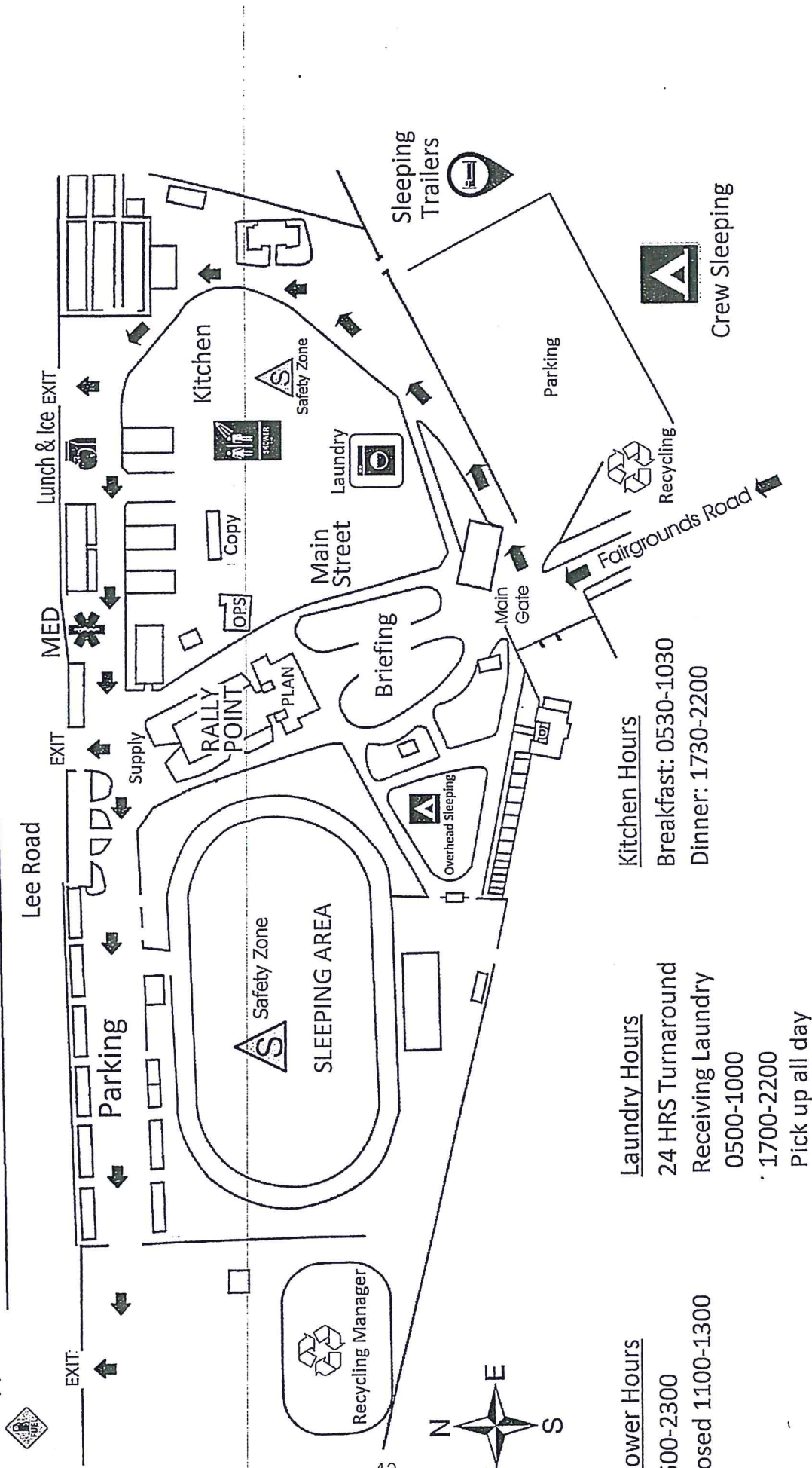
