- Ensure effective communications are occurring by giving clear instructions and asking clarifying questions.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Hot, dry and very unstable weather will return again for Friday once valley inversions lift midday. Rapid pyro-cumulus growth will be possible over smoke columns beginning around 1400 and continuing through the afternoon and evening. Scattered afternoon and evening thunderstorms will be an additional concern with strong outflow winds, cloud to ground lightning and brief down pours all possible hazards. NE down canyon overnight through mid-morning winds will continue to be enhanced due to hot temperatures. Afternoon general winds on the other hand will be on the lighter side with up-slope/up-valley terrain driven winds dominating.

FRIDAY

WEATHER: Following a smoky morning hot, dry and very unstable conditions will develop in the afternoon. Cumulus build-ups will begin forming in the early afternoon with scattered thunderstorms developing in the afternoon and evening. **Rapid pyro-cumulus development is also possible over areas of more intense heat.**

MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE: Highs upper 90s to low 100s 2000-3000 ft valleys and mid 80s 6000-7000 ft ridges.

MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY: Mid teens.

20 FOOT WINDS:

Branch I & V - NE down-canyon winds around 15-20 mph with gusts to 30 mph diminishing between 0900 & 1000. Up-slope winds 3-5 mph developing late morning then becoming predominately SW and increasing to 10-15 mph. Expect swirling and battling winds near drainage intersections.

Branch VII – NE winds 8-11 mph will channel through valleys draining to the SW away from the High Lakes Plateau until around 1000 with lighter E-NE wind near the plateau edge. Light up-slope winds will develop late morning and become W to SW 5-8 mph with gusts to 15 mph in the afternoon.

Branch IX & X - Light winds through midday becoming up-slope 3-5 mph early afternoon and W to NW 4-7 mph with gusts 10 to 12 mph mid to late afternoon.

Peaks & Higher Ridges - E-NE winds 5-10 mph through 1000. W-SW winds 10-15 mph in the afternoon with gusts up to 20 mph.

STABILITY: Inversions lifting around 1100 western areas & 1300-1500 elsewhere. Unstable in the afternoon.

CHANCE OF RAIN: 30% **LAL:** 3

SMOKE TRANSPORT WIND: W around 10 mph near ridge level backing to S-SE with height.

FRIDAY NIGHT

WEATHER: Scattered thunderstorms continuing into the evening with cloud cover decreasing after midnight.

MINIMUM TEMPERATURE: Lows in the upper 60s to low 70s ridges and upper 50s to mid-60s valleys.

MAXIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY: 30-35% ridges and 50-60% valleys...higher in any locations that receive rain.

20 FOOT WINDS: W-SW 10-15 mph in the evening, diminishing around 2200. In Branch I, V & VII winds will become NE around 2200 and increase to 10 to 15 mph through channeled areas around 0100 with local gusts to 25 mph after 0400. In Branch IX & X W-NW winds will diminish around sunset with SE (Branch IX) and SW (Branch X) down-valley winds 4 to 7 mph developing during the early morning hours.


STABILITY: Smoke settling in valley inversions overnight with strengthening thermal belts developing along upper slopes and ridges. NE down canyon winds will carry smoke pooling in Feather River Valley downstream to the SW.

CHANCE OF RAIN: 20% **LAL:** 3 in the evening becoming 1 overnight.

SMOKE TRANSPORT WIND: SW 10 mph in the evening becoming NE down valley after midnight.

OUTLOOK FOR SATURDAY THROUGH WEDNESDAY: A couple bands of mid-level moisture will move through Sat and Sun bringing more cloud cover at times and slightly cooler temperatures. A drier airmass will push into the area Mon-Wed as S to SW winds aloft increase. Temperatures will warm through the first half of the week with RHs dropping rapidly and SW winds increasing.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

General:

Potential still exists for increased fire activity today. Successive drying days increase chance for rekindle. Main fire activity will continue in the North and West sides of the fire as unburned interior islands consume. The fire will remain active at night as dry fuels continue to consume. Probability of Ignition (PIG) is high today due to higher temperature. Spotting distances should remain less than 1/2 mile, unless an extreme crown run occurs. Increased activity is again likely when the smoke cover breaks with inversion lift. Large fuel mop up still critical due to dryness. Watch for needle drop.

Extreme Fire Behavior:

Extreme behavior is mostly influenced by heavy fuel loadings, stand density and steep slopes. When this occurs, it will burn with high intensity with group torching and spotting. The potential for crown runs is likely when intensive surface fire occurs where slopes and wind align in thick stands with low branches. These runs can develop Pyro cumulus clouds.

****light winds can make Pyro cumulous clouds unstable and unpredictable****

Fuels: There is a large variety of fuels throughout the area. Mixed pine forest with grass or shrub understory, open grass and isolated shrub areas. Live fuel moistures are very low. Drought conditions are extreme in the region and large dead fuels are very dry. The predominant fuel type in the fire area is TL6, TU5 and GS2.

Energy Release Component is **above the 97th** percentile at 85. (*Fuel Model G 97th percentile is 85*)
ERC is projected to continue increasing slowly with no significant decrease in the forecast.

1HR fuel moisture: 4% (-- from yesterday)

10HR moisture: 5% (--)

100HR fuel moisture: 5% (--)

SPECIFIC: West Zone

BRANCH I: Holding and mop up today should not have adverse conditions. Smoldering and torching still possible with increase in temperatures and low RH. Expect activity to pick up after 1400.

BRANCH V and VII: Holding today and improving the line should be facilitated by light winds. Beware of local influences on winds such as ridges and drains. Expect activity to pick up after 1400. Snags from previous firing will continue to smolder and present spotting. Down drain winds will keep smoke on the line. Any spots outside containment will spread quickly.

BRANCH IX: Fire continues to burn interior areas. Large column development conditions are possible. Pay attention to light winds and the smoke column. Watch for sudden changes in wind. Expect activity to pick up after 1400.

BRANCH X: Holding and mop up today should not have adverse conditions. Smoldering and torching still possible with increase in temperatures and low RH. Any spots outside containment will spread quickly. Expect activity after 1400.

AIR OPERATIONS and SMOKE FORECAST: Visibility will improve for air operations after 1200

SAFETY:

Fire Order #4: Identify escape routes and safety zones and make them known.

Any time large Pyro cumulus are forming, and thunderstorms are active, chances increase that a sudden change can occur, and you will need to get to your safety zone.

Firing Operations:

Follow the Firing Operation Checklist. Assure that: Lookouts are posted, communications are established with both firing and holding teams, escape routes and safety zones are established and not compromised by the firing operations, and that the firing plan has been approved and relayed to all adjoining forces.

COVID-19:

Follow California Department of Public Health masking guidance. Ensure you are performing good personal hygiene practices by washing your hands frequently. Ensure you are reporting any illnesses or if you are not feeling well to your supervisor. If you are coughing or sneezing, ensure you cover your mouth properly.

Power lines:

Follow Power Line Safety guidelines (IRPG pg.24)
Follow FIRESCOPE identification and management of Life Safety Zones procedures, 3 horizontal strands of fire line tape, write "Do not enter" or "Do not cross"

Wildlife:

Rattlesnakes, bears, and other potentially dangerous animals have been spotted in the fire area. Be aware of where you are stepping and placing your hands especially around rock piles. If you come across a potentially dangerous animal, let it be known and leave the area.

Multiple Base Camps:

The fire has three base camps. It is imperative that personnel and resources are briefed on which base camp they are assigned to. Personnel shall receive a briefing at each base camp. The Westwood and Quincy base camps are in areas that personnel have not been to before. Please make sure you are driving safely, increase following distances, and maintain situational awareness.

Zoning the fire:

With the fire being zoned, maintain accountability of all personnel and resources in assigned work locations. Ensure personnel have access to both IAP's and specifically review the communication plan for both zones. Personnel should be aware of the strategy and tactics occurring in different zones.

Physical and Mental Wellness:

Continually monitor yourself and your crew. Hydrate and increase your caloric intake when performing arduous work during long shifts. Monitor work / rest cycle.

Communications:

There are areas on the fire that Command Channels have limited reception. Use human repeaters to relay messages. Make sure your radios are cloned with the correct frequencies. Review the ICS 205 for both zones. Monitor neighboring Tac channels.

Driving:

Steep, narrow, or dusty roads throughout fire area. Maintain safe following distances and appropriate speed when traversing roads. SLOW DOWN! Flag unstable roads and other hazards that may be encountered while driving. Follow posted speed limits while driving in base camp. Drive with your vehicle headlights on. Pay extra attention while driving on Highway 70, there are several areas where rocks have fallen onto the roadway and closures maybe in effect. Limit your exposure time while in the Highway 70 fire area. Reduce speed on Hwy 32 and always maintain control of your vehicle.

Extreme Fire Behavior:

Expect intense fire runs with plume dominated fire behavior. Take weather regularly. Maintain situational awareness specific to wind direction changes and increased fire spread. Long range spotting of one mile plus has been observed. Beware of pyro-cumulus development and the potential for rapid changes in conditions and weather/lightning associated. Prepare for possible deterioration of pyro-cumulus which will cause severe out flow winds in all directions.

Entrapment Avoidance:

Adhere to the 10 Standard Firefighting orders. Consider the 18 Situations that Shout Watch Out. Consider the Common Denominators of Fire Behavior on Tragedy Fires. Maintain LCES. Establish your decision point(s). Conduct risk management.

Safety Zones/TRA:

Locations where the threatened firefighter may find refuge from danger. Safety zones should be large enough and planned as a location where no shelter is needed. Utilize temporary refuge areas when appropriate.

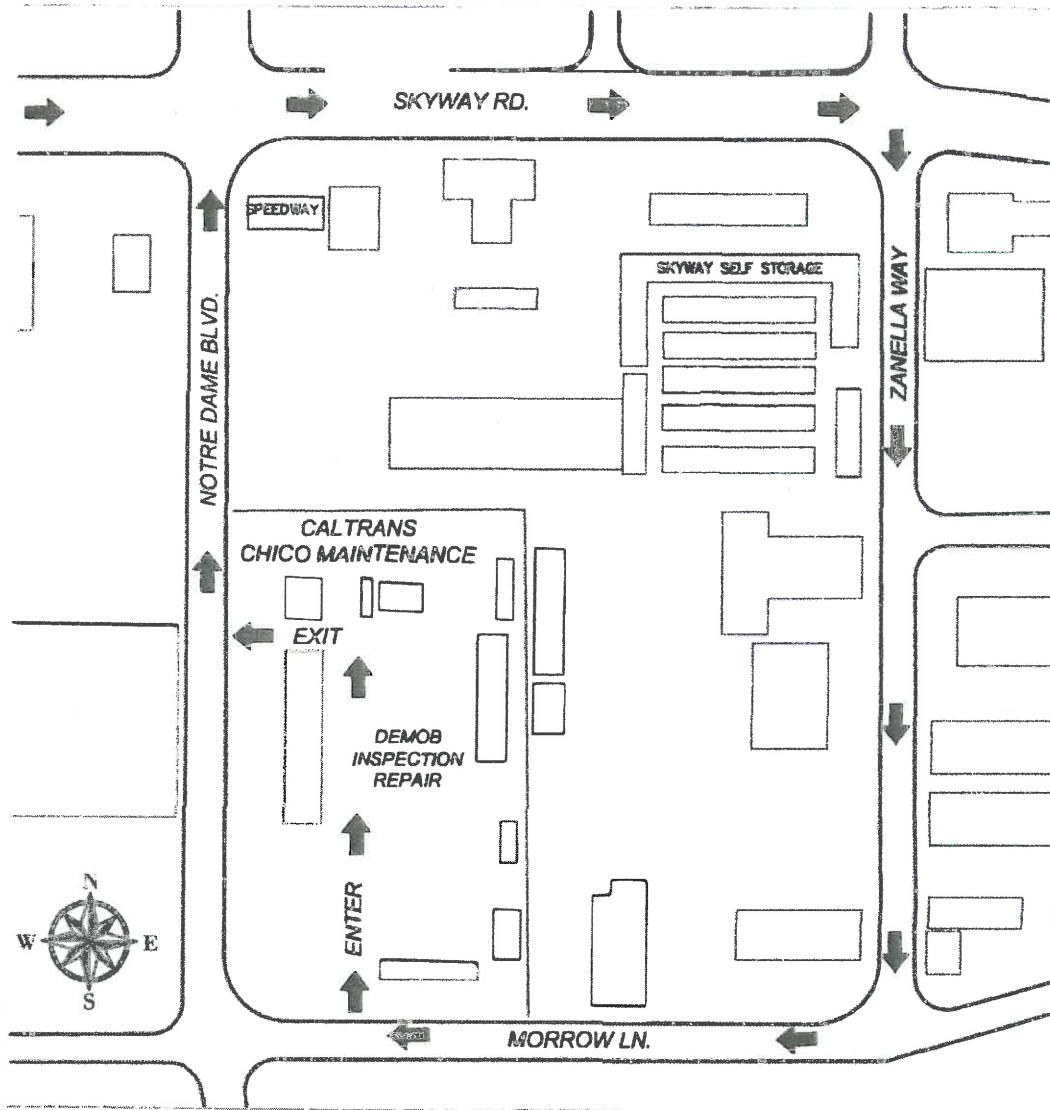

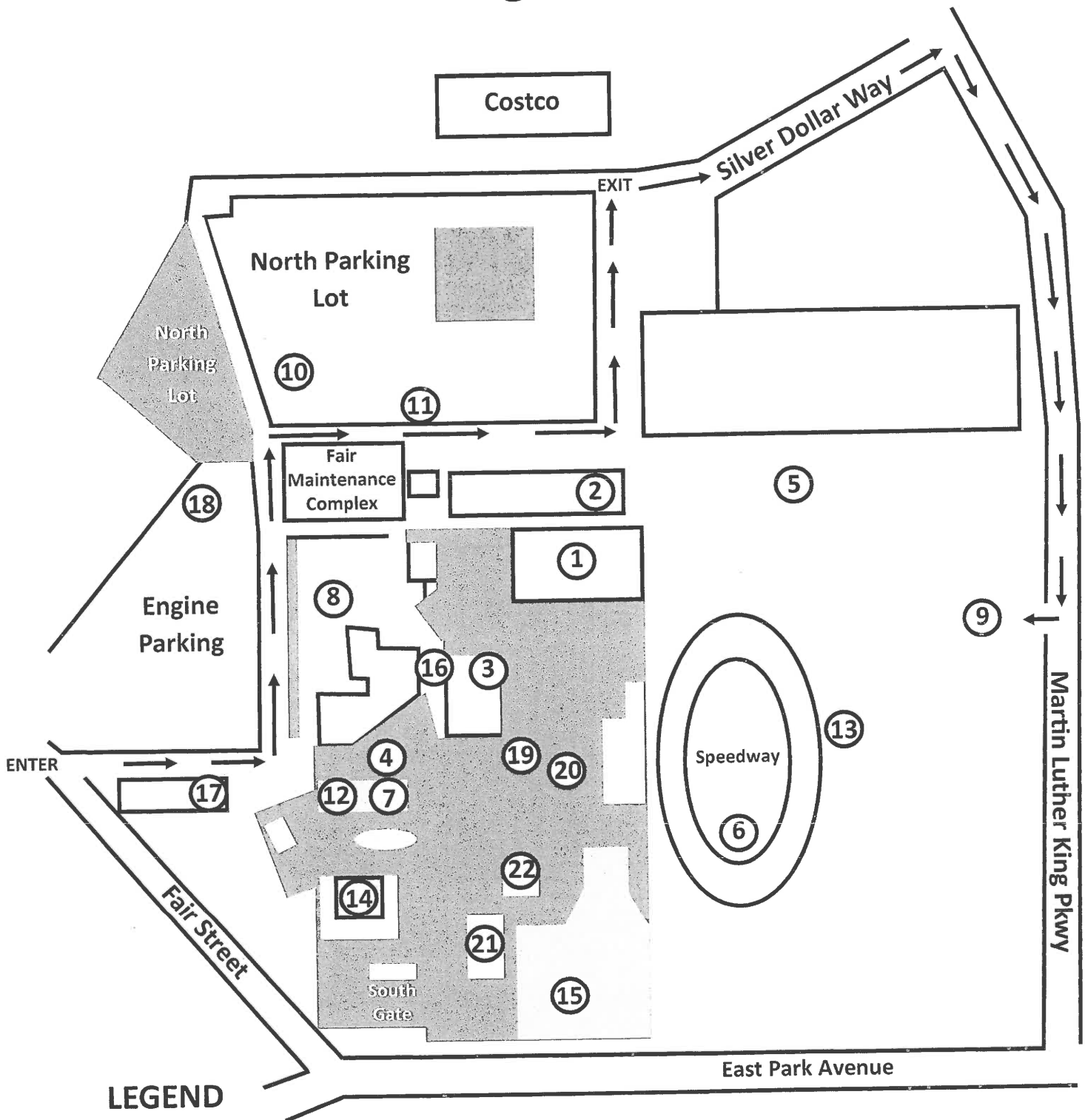

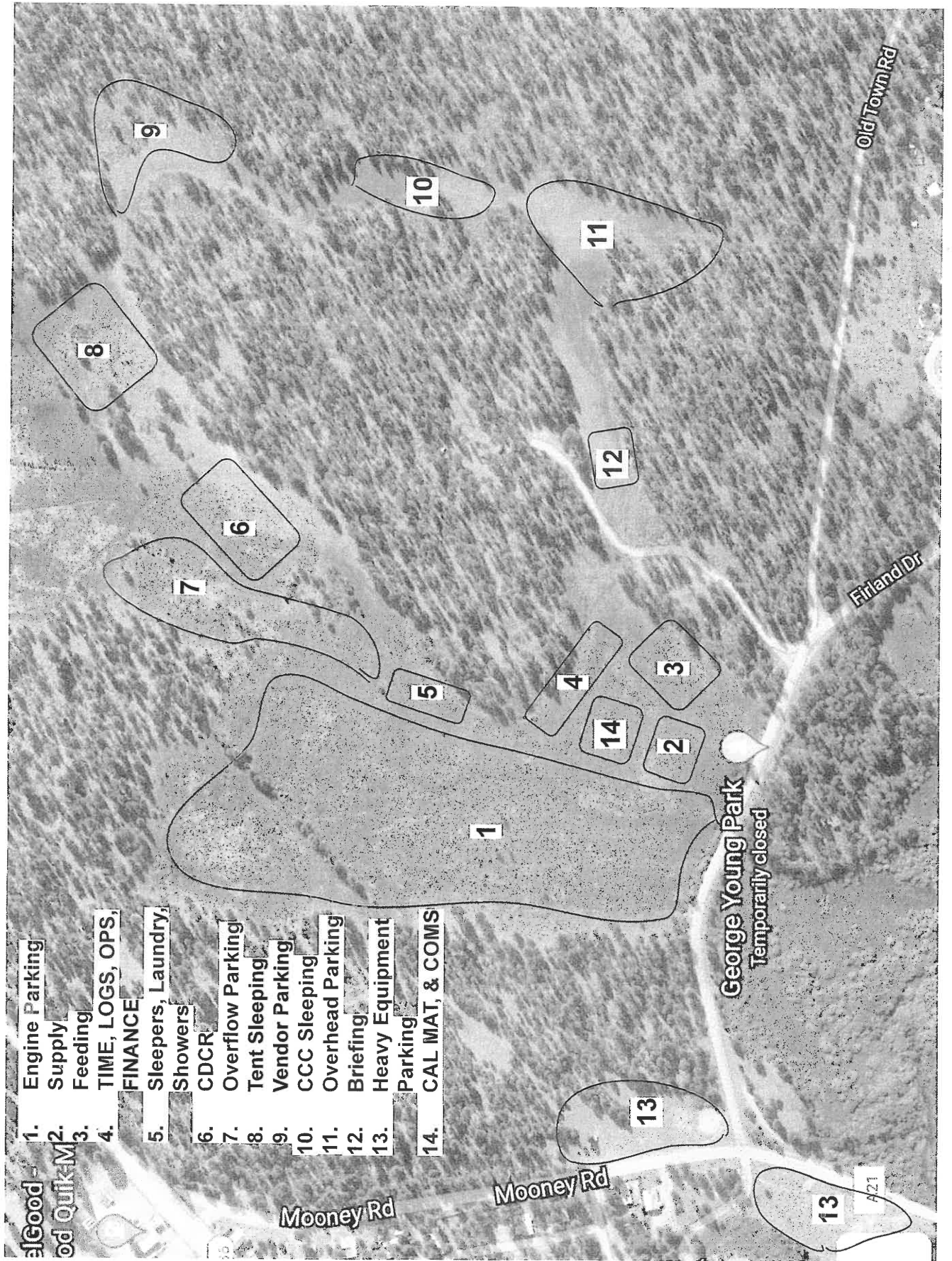
