WEATHER DISCUSSION: Showers and isolated to scattered thunderstorms are anticipated today and this evening, especially across Branch XX and Branch XXIII. Very gusty and erratic winds are likely with and in the vicinity of showers and storms. The risk for showers and storms will continue Saturday and possibly Sunday. Most areas will likely only see a few hundredths of an inch of rainfall, though the locations beneath the strongest shower/storm cores could see up to a tenth. This may result in tricky conditions on non-paved surfaces. Dry lightning will be possible as well.

TODAY: Partly sunny with a risk for late morning to afternoon showers and isolated storms. The best rain/storm chances will be between 1100 and 1900. ***Strong wind gusts along with erratic wind directions can be expected. Rapid pyro-cumulus development is likely.*** Otherwise, dense smoke is likely in the valleys/drainages through the day.

Max Temperatures: Valley-2000 FT: 90-95° 2000-4000 FT: 89-94° 4000-6000 FT: 82-87°
Minimum Relative Humidity: Valley-2000 FT: 20-30% 2000-4000 FT: 35-45% 4000-6000 FT: 35-45%

Mt. Hough Area: Down-valley/downslope (cross slope on the east aspect) flow under 2-4 mph will transition to westerly cross slope to gradual upslope flow (more west-southwest on the west aspect and possibly more NNW on the east aspect). Speeds are expected to range between 8 and 12 mph with gusts to near 18 mph. Ridgeline gusts near 22 mph cannot be discounted. Minimum afternoon humidity values between 20% and 25%, values may fall down to near 15% on west aspects.

Round Valley Lake Area: NNE winds will gradually turn more to the west through the day and increase in the afternoon. Speeds should approach 8 to 10 mph with gusts to near 15 mph. Winds may vary between a northerly and southerly direction through the afternoon. Minimum afternoon humidity values between 20% and 25%.

Bucks Lake Area: 4-8 mph ENE downslope flow will transition to more of a westerly wind by 1400. Speeds are expected to increase into the 8 to 12 mph range by 1500. Gusts to near 18 mph can be anticipated, though a few gusts to near 20-22 mph cannot be ruled out. Minimum afternoon humidity falling down into the upper teens.

Stability: Inversion lifting at mid-slope likely by 1000-1100 hours (inversion likely not lifting until 1300-1500 in valleys). Very unstable in the afternoon. Pyro-cumulus and thunderstorms expected.

CHANCE OF RAIN: 40% **LAL:** 3 **TRANSPORT WINDS:** Becoming southerly at 5 to 15 mph

TONIGHT: Showers and isolated storms will diminish by 2200. Gusty and erratic outflow winds can be expected near showers and isolated storms. Dense smoke settling into drainages and valleys.

Min Temperatures: Valley-2000 FT: 52-57° 2000-4000 FT: 57-62° 4000-6000 FT: 57-62°
Relative Humidity Recovery: Valley-2000 FT: 50-60% 2000-4000 FT: 35-45% 4000-6000 FT: 35-45%

Mt. Hough Area: Gusty and erratic winds may begin the period due to diminishing showers and storms. Downslope/down-valley flow will likely commence around 2200 hours with speeds generally less than 5 mph. The north aspect of Mount Hough may see stronger downslope/down-valley flow closer to 8-10mph

Round Valley Lake Area: Gusty and erratic winds may begin the period due to diminishing showers and storms. Largely downslope flow toward the lake is anticipated though brief NW and SE breezes are possible intermittently. Speeds will be below 8 mph.

Bucks Lake Area: Gusty and erratic winds may begin the period due to diminishing showers and storms. E winds are anticipated closer to the Bucks Lake area with SW and W winds likely closer toward Meadow Valley. Speeds are expected to remain below 10 mph.

Stability: Inversion setting in around 2200-2300. Smoke likely becoming trapped beneath inversion in valleys.


CHANCE OF RAIN: 20% **LAL:** 2 **TRANSPORT WINDS:** Becoming calm by 2200-2300 hours.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: There will be a continued risk for showers and isolated storms again Saturday and Sunday afternoon. Gusty and erratic outflow winds can be anticipated near showers and thunderstorms. Outside of showers/storms, patchy dense smoke and pockets of critically dry conditions along with breezy westerly winds will continue this weekend. Lower afternoon RH values are expected next week with overnight recoveries trending poorer.

WEATHER SUMMARY: Warm and Dry, More Clearing and Instability 1100-1300 ***30-40% chance of Isolated T-storms over the fire, approach will be from the south and southeast***
Temps: Day 86-96 Night 50-62
RH: Day 15-25% Night 55-65%
Winds: Day Ridges W/SW 8-15 gusts to 20mph Night Ridges 2200 N/NE/E 6-7mph becoming light variable downslope at 0200
Fuels: ERC's will remain at or above the 97th percentile. All fuels are receptive to burn.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Main fire progression will continue to the north and east and be mainly fuels driven. However, the fire has fallen out of alignment in most areas and fire behavior is likely to be challenging but manageable. Where wind and slope align expect the potential for extreme fire behavior to include sustained crown runs and long-range spotting (1mile+). In general, spotting will be less than ¼ mile and from rollout. Fire will remain active under the smoke. Watch for fire whirl development at intersecting drainages and on the lee side of any large column.
The fire will remain active at night along ridge tops and in canyon bottoms that align with the down canyon winds.
All fuels are available to burn.
Increased clearing and ventilation will increase fire activity in the afternoon.

SPECIFIC:

East Zone:

Branch XX: The fire will continue to impact the HWY 70/89 corridors and threaten structures. Expect rapid rates of spread and long-range spotting with any head fire runs. Fire will continue to back down the north aspect of Hough Mountain with torching and short intense uphill runs in the afternoon. Burnout operations are expected to hold. Unburned areas inside the main perimeter will continue to burn intensely. ***Fire is established on both sides of HWY 89. Winds have been observed to battle up and down canyon making fire whirls and cross canyon spotting probable***.

XXIII: Expect the fire to continue burning northeast and east. The fire will exhibit extreme rates of spread when burning along aligned ridges and when established at the bottom of any slope. Spotting will be about a quarter mile and from rollout. Fire will continue to flank to the south in the area of Gilson Creek and Tollgate Creek. Burnout operations are expected to hold. Active patrol for spot fires is necessary. *** Line construction in Montgomery Creek has been successful, however be on the look out for spots.***

Branch XXV: Expect active flanking and head fire runs along the ridges. The fire will continue to back and flank into the valley. If fire becomes established east of the Buck's Lake expect wind aligned runs with rapid rates of spread to the east. As the fire moves east it will burn into difficult terrain and align with west facing slopes. Direct attack has been challenging, expect this to continue. General westerly flow will challenge north/south running containment lines. ***Smoke is forecasted to clear a bit more, increasing potential fire behavior***.

All Branches: Firing operations will be affected by increasing RH's around 0300. However, in heavier pockets of continuous dead and down, fire will still carry. Take local weather obs.

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke will limit air operations to the north and east sides of the fire area.

SAFETY

- Heavy smoke will impair visibility for lookouts.
- Roads will be impacted by roll out debris and falling snags in any burn area.
- Smoke impacts to powerlines, review powerline safety in the IRPG.
- Unburned fuel between you and the fire.

COMMON DENOMINATORS OF FIRE BEHAVIOR ON TRAGEDY FIRES

There are four major common denominators of fire behavior on fatal and near-fatal fires. Such fire often occur:

- On relatively small fires or deceptively quiet areas of large fires.
- In relatively light fuels, such as grass, herbs, and light brush.
- When there is an unexpected shift in wind direction or wind speed.
- When fire responds to topographic conditions and runs uphill.

Alignment of topography and wind during the Burning Period should be considered a trigger point to re-evaluate tactics.

HARASSMENT FREE WORKPLACE POLICY

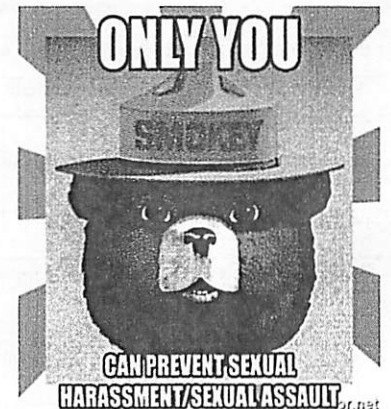

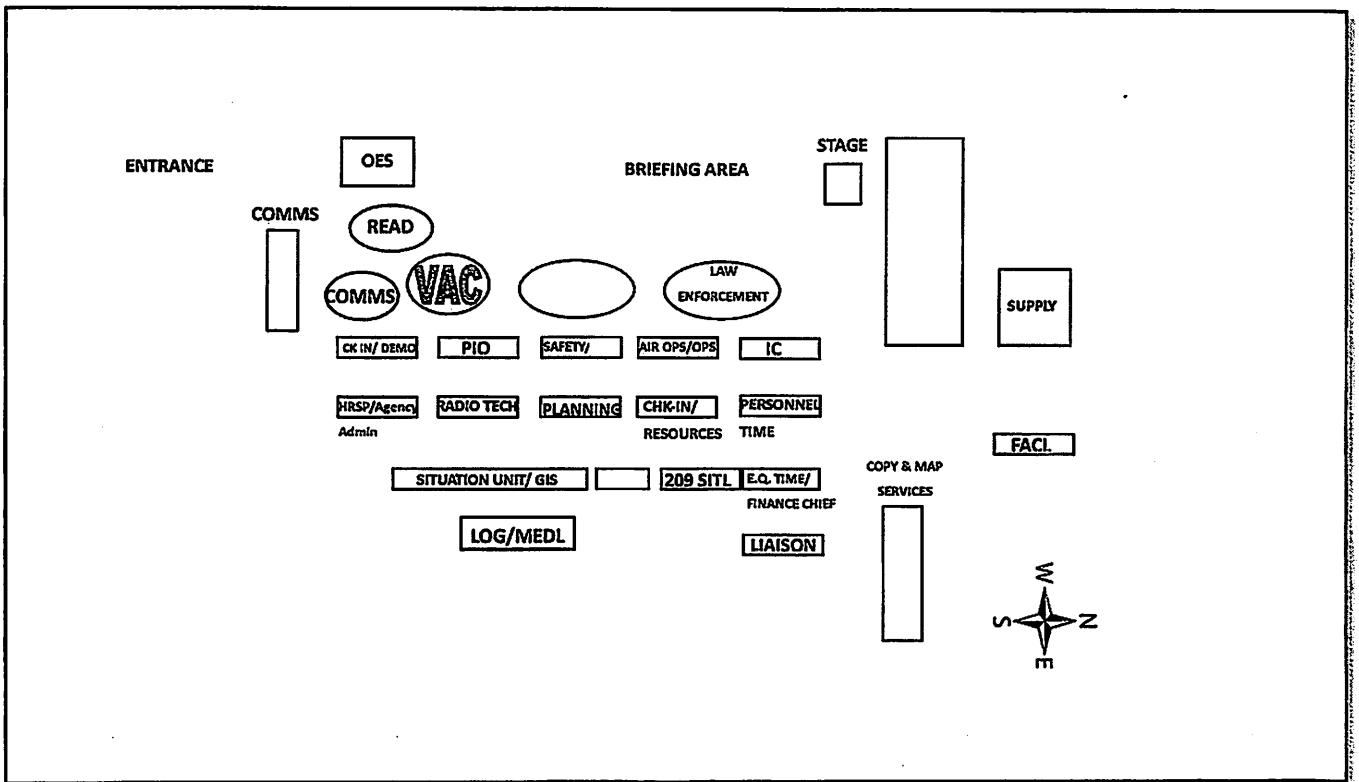
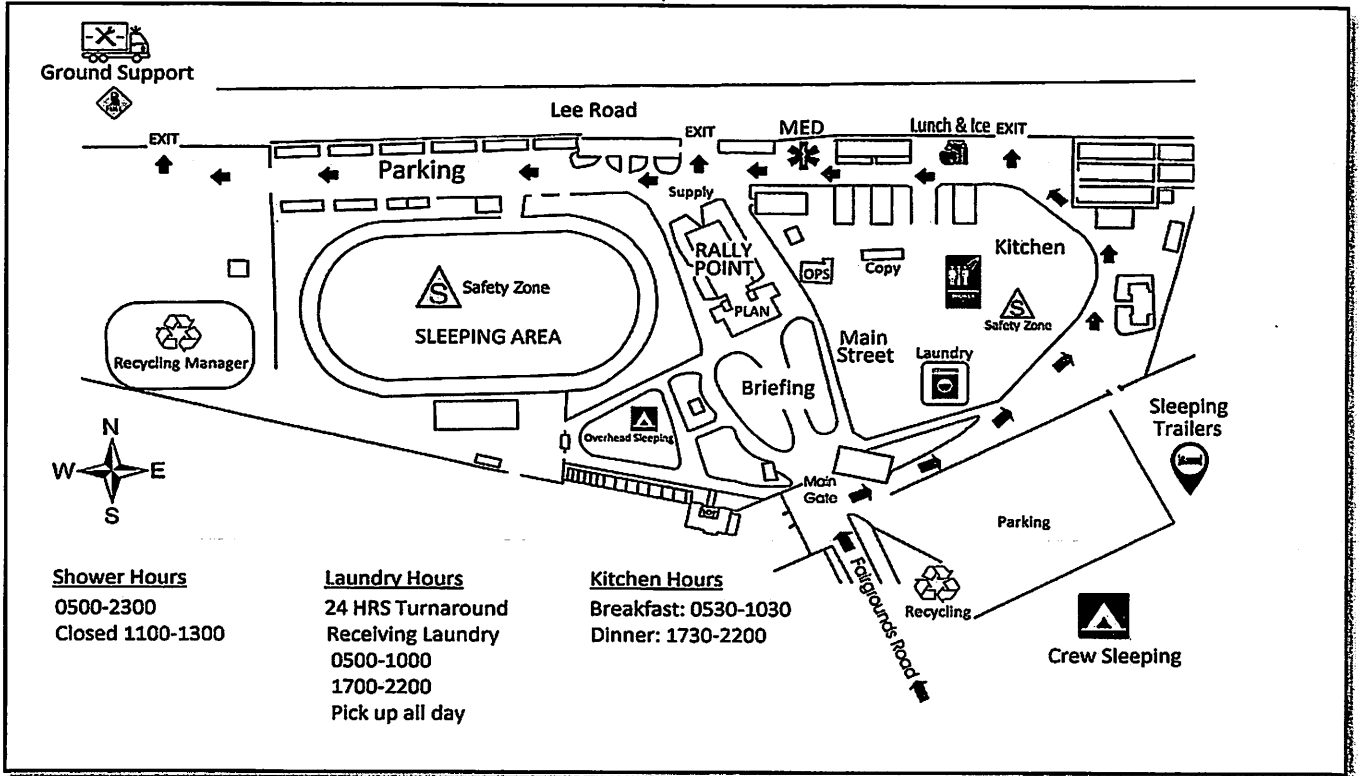
