

Red Flag Warning 1 pm Weds through 8 pm Thursday for strong winds, low humidity and instability

WEATHER DISCUSSION: A critical weather day as a dry cold front passes through Northern California. A brief period of quiet weather through midday before southwest winds start to increase around 1300 hours. Winds aloft will increase through the afternoon and evening hours with gusts from 30-40 mph in the crowns of branch IX. In addition to the strong winds, very unstable air aloft will promote pyrocumulus. Humidity values will drop into the upper single digits with high temperatures upper 80s and lower 90s. Strong southwest winds will continue well into the evening along with unstable conditions aloft so don't expect columns to fall apart until well after dark. Winds slowly easing overnight but the atmosphere remains unstable into Thursday morning.

WEATHER FORECAST WEDNESDAY:

WEATHER: Morning smoke otherwise sunny, becoming breezy to windy in the afternoon.

TEMPERATURES: Mid 80s above 4500 feet with mid 90s lower elevations.

HUMIDITY: Lowering 7-17% afternoon hours with direct sunshine on sun exposed slopes.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest winds increasing 12-15 mph with frequent afternoon gusts 25-35 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Light through 1000 am then southwesterly upcanyon 6-12 mph gusts 15-20 mph.

HAINES INDEX: 5+ **LAL:** 1

STABILITY/INVERSION: Weak morning inversion breaking by 1000.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT: Windy and unstable through midnight. Otherwise mostly clear with poor humidity.

LOW TEMPERATURES: 58-68

HUMIDITY: Poor recovery 28-38% after midnight through sunrise.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 15 mph evening gusts 35 mph through midnight, slowly decreasing overnite


SLOPE/VALLEY - Evening upcanyon through 2300 then northeast downcanyon 4-8 mph except
Gusts 15-20 mph Branch I

HAINES INDEX: 2 **LAL:** 1

STABILITY/INVERSION: Night time inversion setting up after midnight.

EXTENDED FORECAST: **Red Flag Warning through 8 pm Thursday.** Main concern on Thursday will be winds switching to westerly by Thursday afternoon with continued instability aloft. On Thursday night northeast winds will develop. High pressure Friday through the weekend with a warming and drying trend into next week but with light winds.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

General:

****Critical Fire Danger**** Today's behavior will be extremely active. There will be spotting, crown runs, large plume development and rapid surface spread. Dry fuels are creating serious resistance to control. Conditions remain elevated into the night with winds and very low fuel moistures. Probability of Ignition (PIG) is high today due to higher temperature and sun. Spotting distances could reach ½ mile from mid slope and over 1 mile from ridges or during extreme crown run

Extreme Fire Behavior:

Extreme behavior will occur where there is heavy fuel loadings, high stand density and steep slopes. When this occurs, it will burn with high intensity with group torching and spotting. The potential for crown runs is likely when intensive surface fire occurs where slopes and wind align in thick stands with low branches. These runs can develop Pyro cumulus clouds with erratic and unpredictable behavior.

Local Watchout Thresholds: (bold if present) ALL 4 present today.

20' winds over 10 mph, RH below 20%, Temp > 85 deg, 10 HR < 5%

Expected Surface Fire Behavior: (assumes 5mph eye level wind and 15% slope)

Timber Understory (TU5) Timber with branches, shrubs: 7-15' flame length and ROS 15-30 ch/hr head

Timber Liter (TL6) Timber with needles and branches: 3-5' flame length and ROS 5-8 ch/hr head

SPECIFIC: West Zone

BRANCH I, V, VII: Smoldering and torching still possible with increase in temperatures winds and low RH. Expect activity to pick up earlier around 1100. Winds will push into the black through the day and night.

BRANCH IX: Fire will continue to spread to the north towards Hwy 32 as it moves downslope, pushed by southerly winds. Spread can reach up to 15 ch/hr on upslope runs in Red fir stands. Fire will roll out and hook up slope as it progresses down and laterally from the top of Butt Mountain. Spotting will be extended up to 1/2 mile as it spots downhill and will spread quickly. Transitioning to younger pine stands behind Saint Bernard will increase activity and spread. Soldier Meadow should hold easterly spread of the eastern flank.

Fire east of Soldier Meadow will continue to push towards the northeast with southerly winds. Heavier slash and open stands will allow wind to be more effective at moving the fire. Watch jackpots for spotting. Flame lengths should be low enough for direct attack in flatter terrain.

BRANCH X: DIV M will have continued challenge from the southerly and downslope winds through the day. Increased spotting across 89 is likely. Caribou creek area could still move north with strong winds.

AIR OPERATIONS and SMOKE FORECAST: Visibility will improve for air operations after 1100

SAFETY: Fire Order #10: Fight fire aggressively, having provided for safety first.

Extreme behavior through out the day and night. Be prepared to disengage when necessary. Take care of each other.

Extreme Fire Behavior:
Expect intense fire runs with plume dominated fire behavior. Take weather regularly. Maintain situational awareness specific to wind direction changes and increased fire spread. Long range spotting of one mile plus has been observed. Beware of pyro-cumulus development and the potential for rapid changes in conditions and weather/lightning associated. Prepare for possible deterioration of pyro-cumulus which will cause severe out flow winds in all directions.

Safety Zones/TRA:
Locations where the threatened firefighter may find refuge from danger. Safety zones should be large enough and planned as a location where no shelter is needed. Utilize temporary refuge areas when appropriate.

Entrapment Avoidance:
Adhere to the 10 Standard Firefighting orders. Consider the 18 Situations that Shout Watch Out. Consider the Common Denominators of Fire Behavior on Tragedy Fires. Maintain LCES. Establish your decision point(s). Conduct risk management.

Driving:
Steep, narrow, or dusty roads throughout fire area. Maintain safe following distances and appropriate speed when traversing roads. SLOW DOWN! Flag unstable roads and other hazards that may be encountered while driving. Follow posted speed limits while driving in base camp. Drive with your vehicle headlights on. Pay extra attention while driving on Highway 70, there are several areas where rocks have fallen onto the roadway and closures maybe in effect. Limit your exposure time while in the Highway 70 fire area. Reduce speed on Hwy 32 and always maintain control of your vehicle.

Physical and Mental Wellness:
Continually monitor yourself and your crew. Hydrate and increase your caloric intake when performing arduous work during long shifts. Monitor work / rest cycle.

Communications:
There are areas on the fire that Command Channels have limited reception. Use human repeaters to relay messages. Make sure your radios are cloned with the correct frequencies. Review the ICS 205 for both zones. Monitor neighboring Tac channels.

The Westwood and Quincy base camps are in areas that personnel have not been to before. Please make sure you are driving safely, increase following distances, and maintain situational awareness.

Wildlife:

Rattlesnakes, bears, and other potentially dangerous animals have been spotted in the fire area. Be aware of where you are stepping and placing your hands especially around rock piles. If you come across a potentially dangerous animal, let it be known and leave the area.

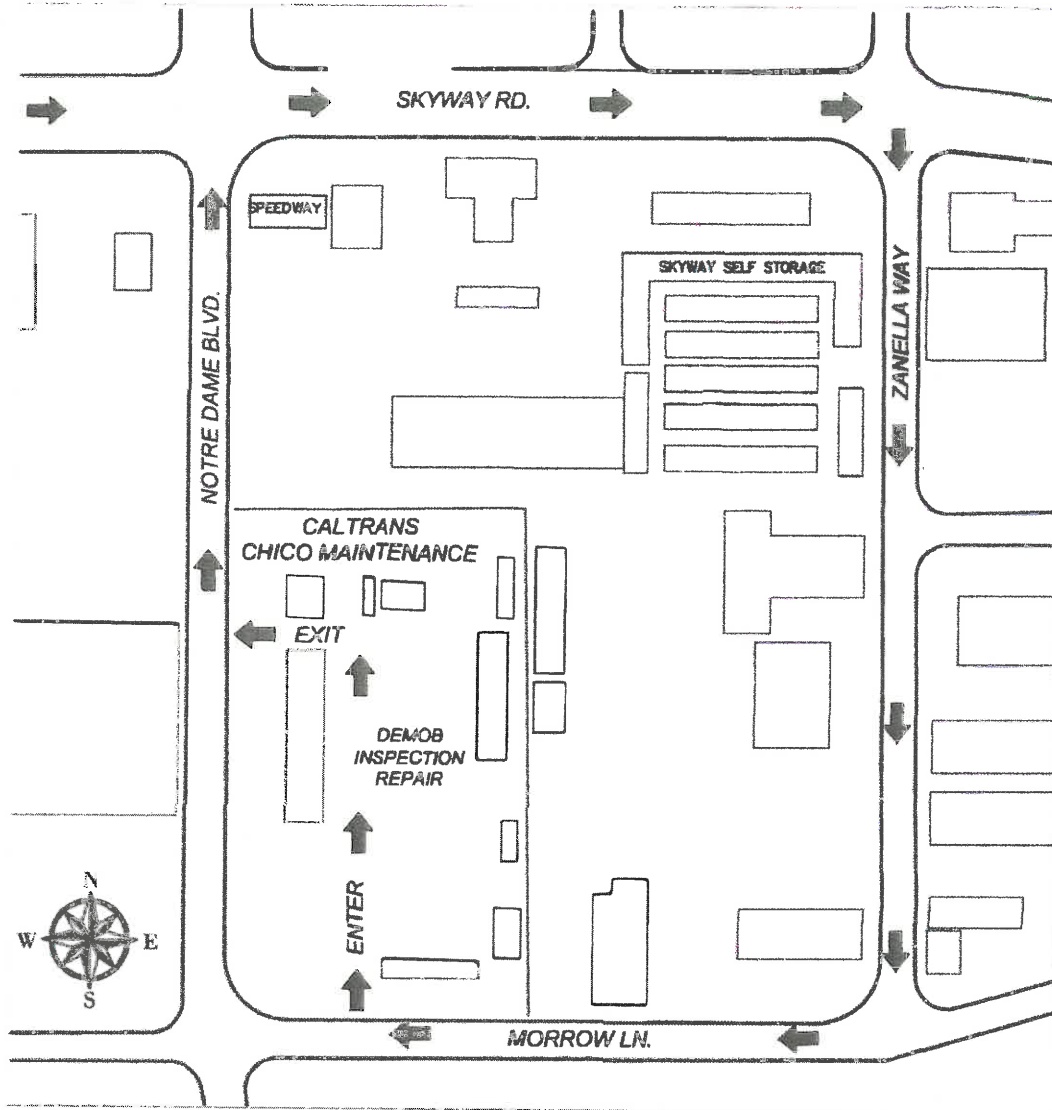

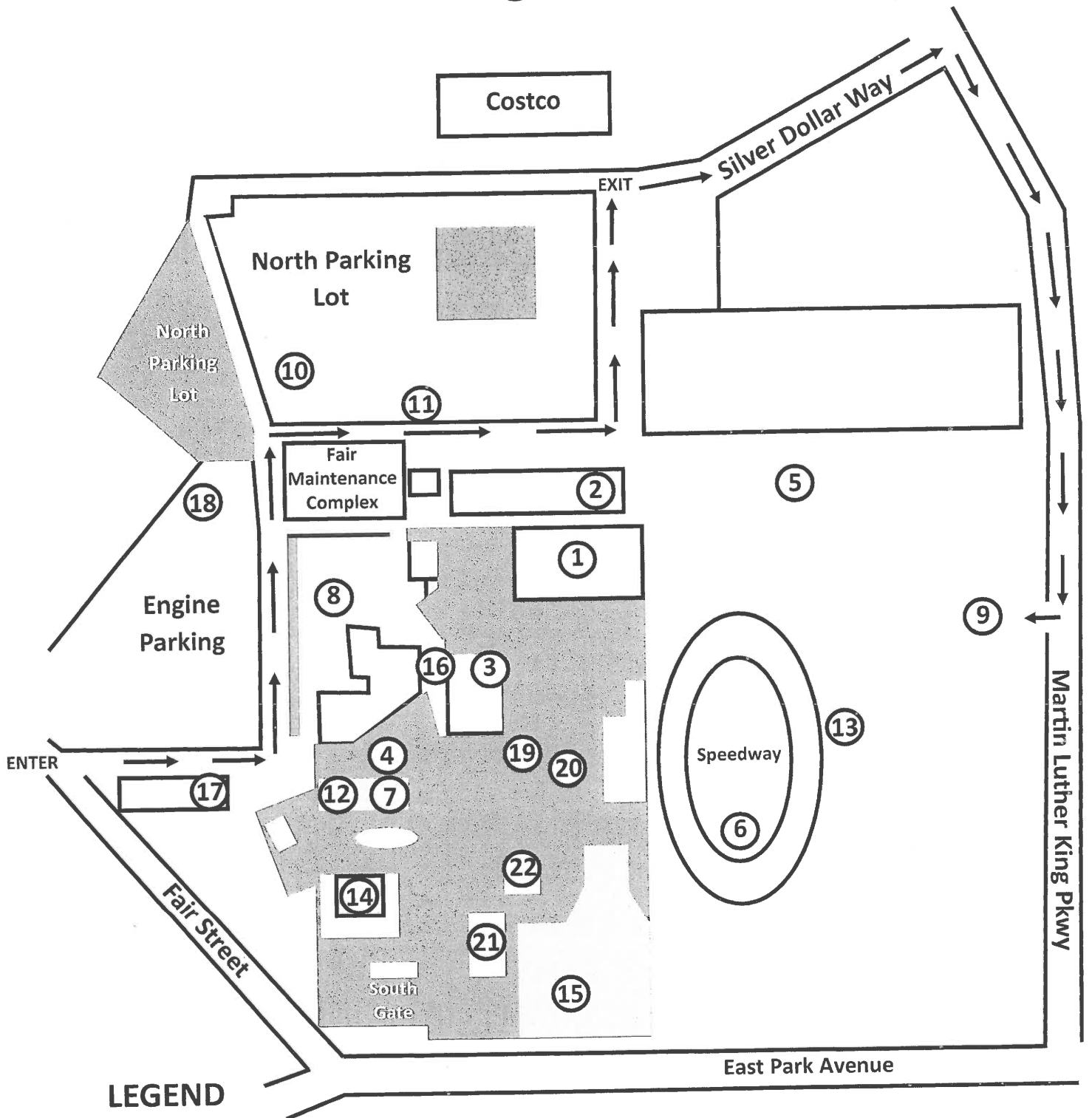

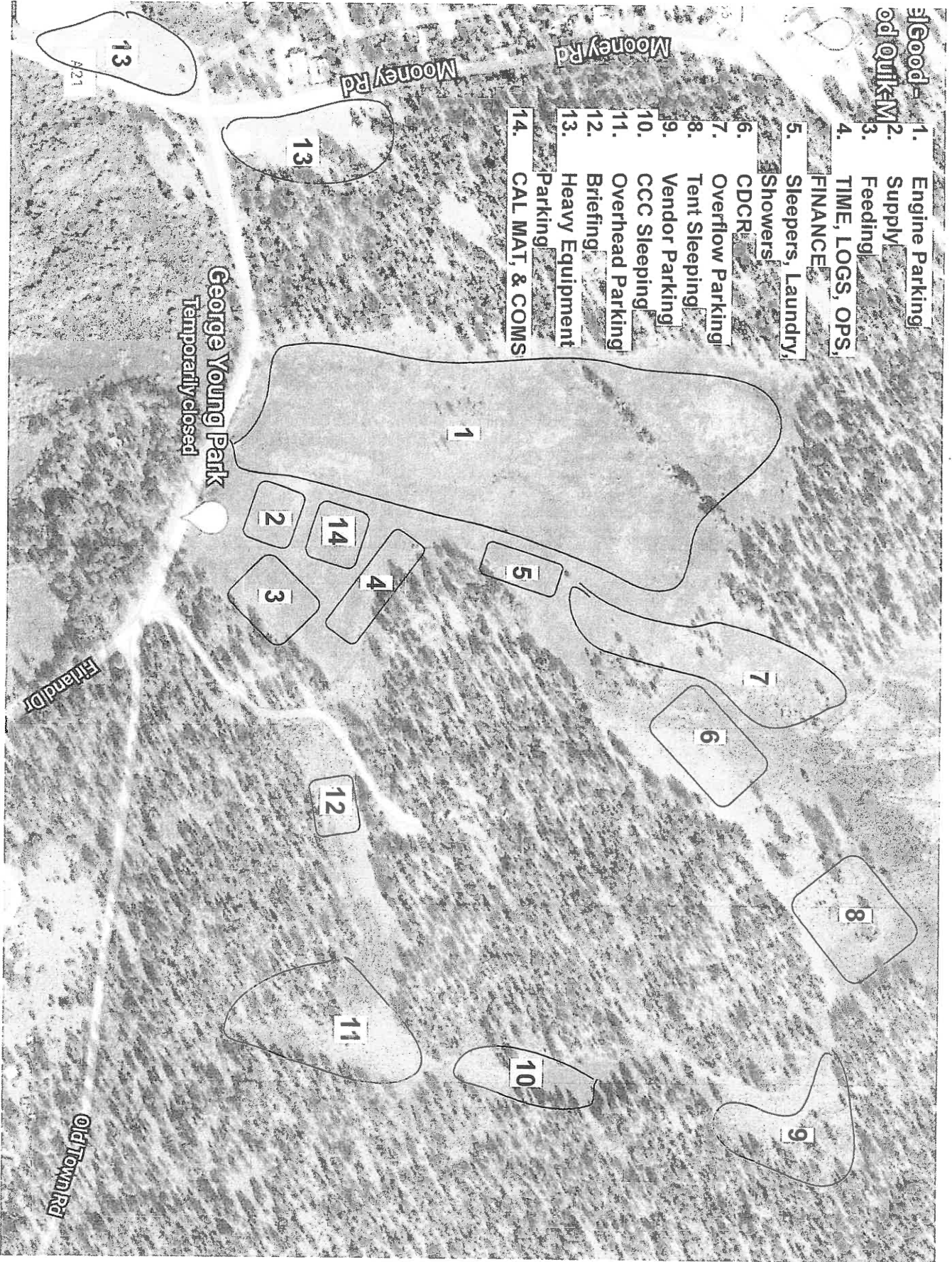
