

Red Flag Warning through 9 pm Thursday for shifting winds and instability

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Another critical fire weather day for the Dixie Fire with Red Flag Warnings in effect through 9 pm. Winds will remain from the southwest through about midday. However the critical concern is **winds shifting to a westerly direction starting around 1300 hours in Branch IX**. This will be the first time this portion of the fire will see the effects of a westerly wind. The winds will be gusty in the crowns once again due to the instability of the passing cold front. By around **2100 hours winds will shift again to a northeast direction**, potentially challenging lines in Branch V and VII overnight into Friday morning. Temperatures remain warm and dry today with perhaps slightly better humidity recovery overnight. One wild card in the forecast will be how smoke cover from the Dixie and other fires in the state impacts our weather.

WEATHER FORECAST THURSDAY:

WEATHER: Morning smoke otherwise mostly sunny, becoming breezy to windy in the afternoon.

TEMPERATURES: Lower 80s above 4500 feet with lower 90s lower elevations.

HUMIDITY: 9-18% afternoon hours with direct sunshine on sun exposed slopes.

20 FT WINDS:

**Branch IX: Southwest 5-10 mph gusts 15 mph through midday then West 10-15 gusts 22 mph
After 1300 through sunset.**

Branch V and VII: Southwest 4-8 mph gusts 10-12 mph turning westerly late afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Light through 1000 am then upcanyon 4-7 mph gusts 10-12 mph.

HAINES INDEX: 5+ LAL: 1

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate morning inversion breaking by 1100.

THURSDAY NIGHT: Partly cloudy with shifting winds but moderate humidity recovery.

LOW TEMPERATURES: 45-55 Branch IX and 55-65 Branch V and VII

HUMIDITY: Moderate recovery 35-50% after 0200 hours.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Turning Northeast 5-10 mph gusts 15 mph after 2100.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Northeast downcanyon 4-8 mph gusts 20-25 mph Branch I

HAINES INDEX: 2 LAL: 1 STABILITY/INVERSION: Night time inversion setting up after midnight.

EXTENDED FORECAST: High pressure Friday through the weekend with a return to seasonable weather pattern. Highs in the mid 80s to mid 90s with afternoon humidity mid teens. General winds southwest in the afternoon but light with nighttime downcanyon. Long range remains hot and dry with warming trend by middle of next week.



FIRE BEHAVIOR

General:

****Critical Fire Danger**** Today's behavior will be extremely active. There will be spotting, crown runs, large plume development and rapid surface spread. Dry fuels are creating serious resistance to control. Conditions remain elevated into the night with winds and very low fuel moistures. Probability of Ignition (PIG) is high today (99%) due to higher temperature and sun. Spotting distances could reach ½ mile from mid slope and over 1 mile from ridges or during extreme crown runs

Extreme Fire Behavior:

Extreme behavior will occur in most fuels. The fire will burn with high intensity with group torching and spotting. The potential for crown runs is likely when intensive surface fire occurs and sustained winds are present, regardless of slope. Any stand with branches lower than 10 feet, can transition to crown fire with sustained winds over 5. These runs can develop Pyro cumulus clouds with erratic and unpredictable behavior.

20' winds over 10 mph, RH below 20%, Temp > 85 deg, 10 HR < 5%

Expected Surface Fire Behavior: (assumes 5mph eye level wind and 15% slope)

Timber Understory (TU5) Timber with branches, shrubs: 7-15' flame length and ROS 15-30 ch/hr head

Timber Litter (TL6) Timber with needles and branches: 3-5' flame length and ROS 5-8 ch/hr head

SPECIFIC: West Zone

BRANCH I, V, VII: Smoldering and torching still possible with increase in temperatures, winds and low RH. Expect activity to pick up earlier around 1100. Prepare for NE winds after 2000 as front shifts and general winds and downslope winds combine.

BRANCH IX: Fire will continue to spread into the north towards Fork Feather River pushed by southerly winds early. Spread can reach up to 30 ch/hr on upslope runs in mixed conifer stands. Fire spread will shift towards the east as NW winds begin to develop after 1400. Slope runs and crowning are expected. NE winds expected overnight.

Fire on Butt Mountain, south of HWY 36 will roll out and hook up slope as it progresses down and laterally moves further west towards Carter Meadow and HWY 32/36 intersection. Spotting will be extended up to 1/2 mile as it spots downhill and will spread quickly.

BRANCH X: DIV M will have continued challenge from the southerly and downslope winds through the day. Unburned areas southwest of HWY 89 will remain active. Increased spotting across HWY 89 is still likely. Caribou creek area could still move north with strong winds.

AIR OPERATIONS and SMOKE FORECAST: Visibility will improve for air operations after 1100

SAFETY: Fire Order #6: Be alert. Keep calm. Think clearly. Act decisively.

Prepare ahead what you will do if something goes wrong. Constantly reevaluate through the day YOUR situation.

Extreme Fire Behavior:

Expect intense fire runs with plume dominated fire behavior. Take weather regularly. Maintain situational awareness specific to wind direction changes and increased fire spread. Long range spotting of one mile plus has been observed. Beware of pyro-cumulus development and the potential for rapid changes in conditions and weather/lightning associated. Prepare for possible deterioration of pyro-cumulus which will cause severe out flow winds in all directions.

Physical and Mental Wellness:

Continually monitor yourself and your crew. Hydrate and increase your caloric intake when performing arduous work during long shifts. Monitor work / rest cycle.

Safety Zones/TRA:

Locations where the threatened firefighter may find refuge from danger. Safety zones should be large enough and planned as a location where no shelter is needed. Utilize temporary refuge areas when appropriate.

Entrapment Avoidance:

Adhere to the 10 Standard Firefighting orders. Consider the 18 Situations that Shout Watch Out. Consider the Common Denominators of Fire Behavior on Tragedy Fires. Maintain LCES. Establish your decision point(s). Conduct risk management.

Driving:

Steep, narrow, or dusty roads throughout fire area. Maintain safe following distances and appropriate speed when traversing roads. SLOW DOWN! Flag unstable roads and other hazards that may be encountered while driving. Follow posted speed limits while driving in base camp. Drive with your vehicle headlights on. Pay extra attention while driving on Highway 70, there are several areas where rocks have fallen onto the roadway and closures maybe in effect. Limit your exposure time while in the Highway 70 fire area. Reduce speed on Hwy 32 and always maintain control of your vehicle.

Communications:

There are areas on the fire that Command Channels have limited reception. Use human repeaters to relay messages. Make sure your radios are cloned with the correct frequencies. Review the ICS 205 for both zones. Monitor neighboring Tac channels.

Wildlife:

Rattlesnakes, bears, and other potentially dangerous animals have been spotted in the fire area. Be aware of where you are stepping and placing your hands especially around rock piles. If you come across a potentially dangerous animal, let it be known and leave the area.

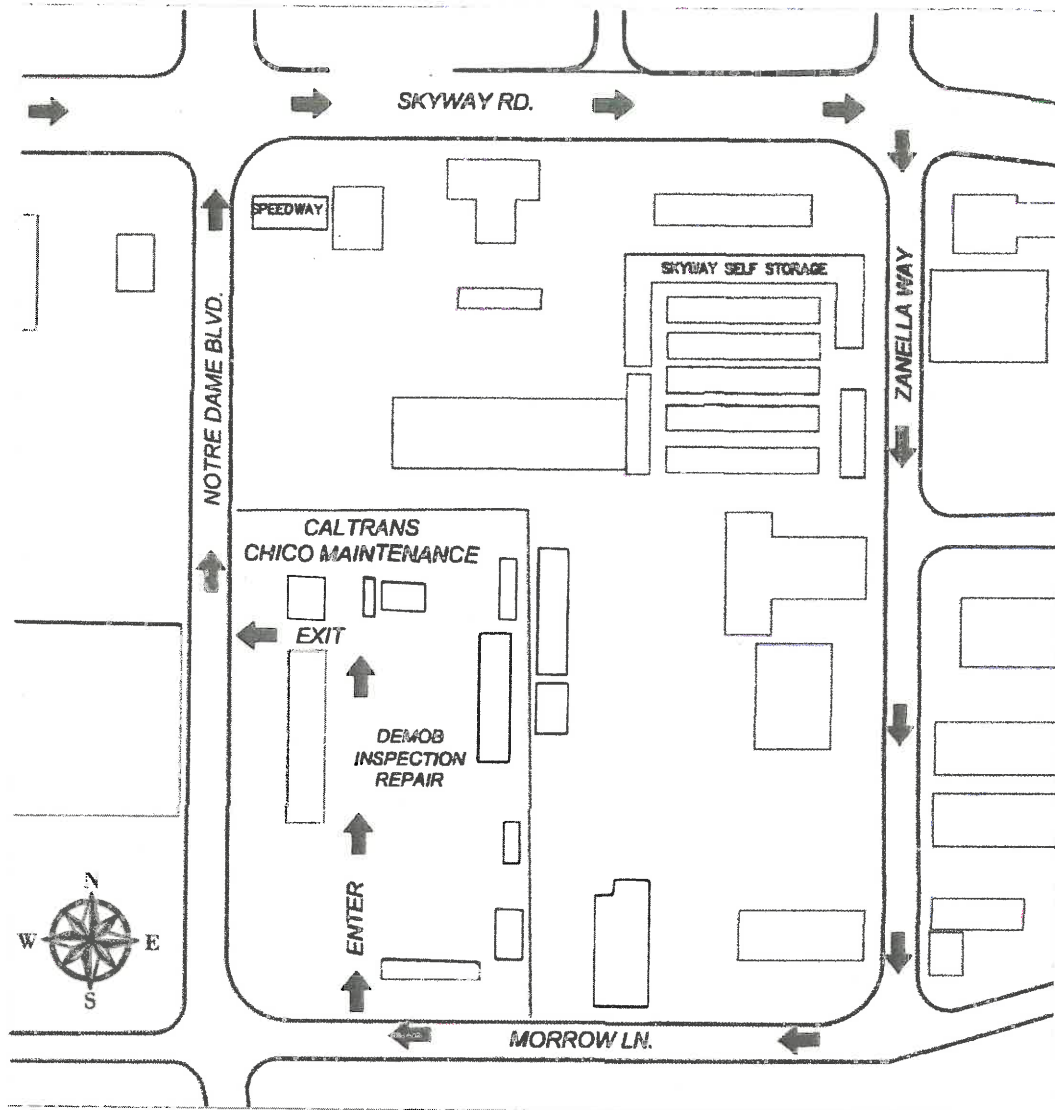

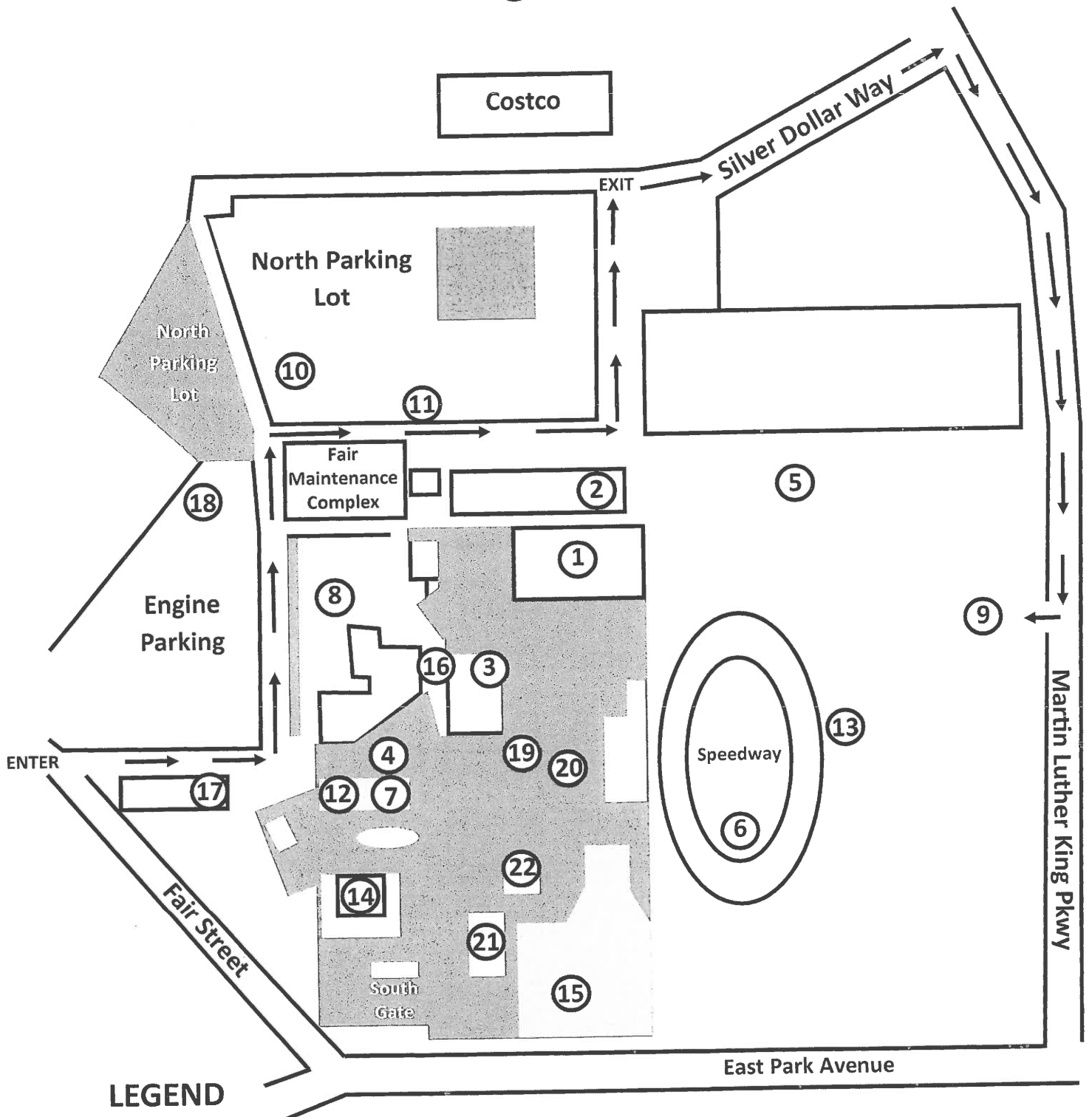

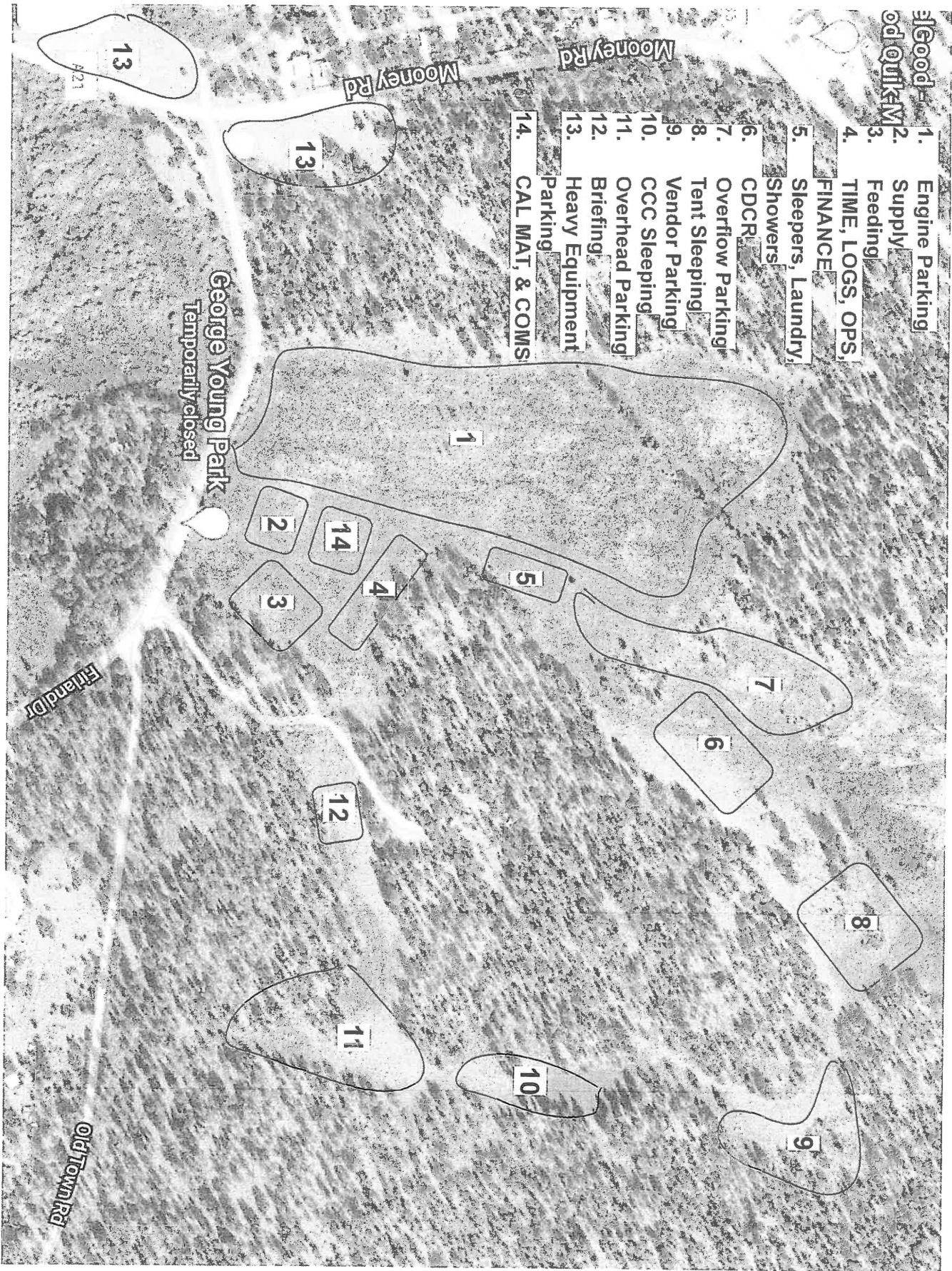
