WEATHER DISCUSSION:

The dry cold front that moved across the incident Sunday is now located well to the east and smoke has settled back in. Smoke from this incident and nearby fires will be the determining factor in the forecast moving forward. Guidance continues to show high pressure building over the incident through the middle of the week with a drying and warming trend expected. Poor humidity recovery is expected. Mainly light northeast winds this morning will turn to the southwest during the afternoon but will average less than 8 mph with a few higher gusts, resulting in generally poor smoke dispersion. This overall pattern does favor the upper level flow becoming more south to southeast with increasing mid to high level moisture and possible thunderstorm development late in the week.

WEATHER FORECAST MONDAY: Widespread smoke and haze. Otherwise, continued warm and dry.

Winds will primarily be terrain driven but some southwest winds will be possible during the afternoon hours. Isolated thunderstorms will be possible from the middle to the end of the week. Thunderstorms always imply gusty and erratic winds.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY:

The fire area will have heavy smoke in the morning with some thinning expected in the afternoon. Temperatures will be warmer, in the mid 80's with minimum humidity dropping slightly to 11 to 20% during the day. Winds will be light early, picking from the Southwest 4-8 mph gusting to 12 mph in the afternoon. Overnight the temperatures will be mid-40's to mid-50's with minimal humidity recovery at 30 - 38%. Winds overnight will be downslope/down valley 2-5mph.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: ****FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA****

The smoke will be slow to thin over much of the fire area today, reducing fire intensity somewhat. The smoke may lessen in the mid afternoon with a chance for increased activity. The probability of ignition will be around 60 percent with smoke cover increasing to above 90 percent with any clearing skies. With the drought conditions and very dry fuels, spotting will be an issue for much of the operational period. The heavy down fuels are very dry and are receptive to fire brands. Small flare ups can contribute to short range spotting which will potentially travel far enough to cross control lines, limiting these spots by increasing mop up distances will be vital to holding existing control lines.

ERC's at record levels above 97th percentile!!

SPECIFIC:

Butte Sector: Smoldering material will continue to burnout, with ember cast potential from the heavy dead and down. Lighter downcanyon localized winds should limit challenges to the control lines, allowing for greater success in holding the lines.

Lassen Sector: The fire will continue to progress East and Northeast towards Mooney road and Hwy 44. The fire progression will burn steadily under the smoke cover in the morning, with single and group tree torching possible. As the afternoon heats up and dries out, expect increased intensity and short range spotting, especially when aligned with any topographic driven winds. Exceptionally dry fuels are very receptive to ember cast and have been resistive to direct control efforts without large control lines. The west portions of the fire would be the first to see any thinning skies with resulting increasing activity. The down canyon winds overnight will be light, increasing chances for opportunities of control efforts.

Westwood Sector: This portion of the fire will continue to advance towards the Northeast. Fire activity will be primarily driven by topography and fuels, with localized light winds causing short range spotting to be possible. Terrain is much more variable in this sector, channeling surface winds that affect fire spread. Clearcut blocks are very receptive fuel beds and provide limited barriers to spread, the Moonlight and Sheep fire scar also does not limit fire growth. Expect smoldering, creeping and ground fire activity in the Lake and Hamilton areas, as smoke should remain thick over these portions.

AIR OPERATIONS

Air operations will be limited today, with a chance for some operations in the mid-afternoon if the smoke thins enough

SAFETY

- In the heavy timber and in old fire areas safety zones are limited, if the hard black is used for safety zones watch out for snags
- Limited visibility may give you a false sense of security. Use LCES to ensure you know what the fires are doing around you

Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory

Northern California

July 17, 2021



Subject: Potential for extreme fire behavior due to critically low live and dead fuel moistures, very dry conditions resulting from persistent drought, minimal snowpack and spring precipitation, and elevated fire danger rating values across much of northern California.

Discussion: Fires burning in northern California are exhibiting extreme fire growth based on critical fuel conditions. Fire spread is fuel driven and does not depend on wind to spread. Surface fuels are very receptive to embers. Long range spotting, area ignition, and group torching is occurring on large fires frequently.

Difference from normal conditions: Northern California is in a drought; currently with 90% at Extreme to Exceptional levels. The drought is expected to persist or intensify through out the fire season. Deficient rainfall and snowpack with early melt off has resulted in fuels that are 4-6 weeks ahead of normal drying/curing rates.

Concerns to Firefighters and the Public:

- Energy Release Component (ERC) at numerous weather stations set record maximums already this year and are running at or above the 97th percentile in most cases. Expect increased fire intensity and spread rates in these areas. Early season extreme fire behavior has been observed in both light and heavy fuels. **Anticipate increased spread rates, spotting, and active nighttime burning.**
- The combination of persistent drought and record-low rainfall and snowpack amounts has led to very low live and dead fuel moistures. Low 1000-hour fuel moistures have been evidenced by complete consumption of dead fuels on recent fires. Live fuel moistures in grasses, shrubs and trees, have already reached critical levels in many areas of Northern California due to limited green-up this spring. **Expect fires to ignite easier and spread faster. Do not expect fires to exhibit reduced fire behavior when entering areas of live fuels; anticipate increased spread rates and spotting.**
- Direct attack is often not feasible under regular diurnal wind conditions with ground resources. And aviation utilization is often insufficient in moderating rate of spread without immediate heavy ground resource response. **Anticipate higher resistance to control in all fuel types.**
- Already this year, Northern California has experienced large fire activity and multiple team deployments. California will likely experience an extended fire season. It is important to be mindful of and manage fatigue for all resources. **Everyone, every day, returns home safely.**

Mitigation Measures:

- Local and inbound fire personnel need to be aware that fire behavior across the state is exceeding normal expectations for this time of the year. **Local briefings need to be thorough and highlight specific fire environment conditions. These include but are not limited to local weather forecasts, Pocket Cards, ERC's, live and dead fuel moistures.**
- Suppression actions need to be based on good anchor points, escape routes, and safety zones. **Remember LCES. Experienced lookouts are essential under these conditions.**
- Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire. **Augment initial attack resources as incident activity dictates.**

Area of Concern: Northern California except for the following Predictive Service Areas: North Coast and Bay Marine, west of Highway 101 in Mid-Coast to Mendocino and Diablo-Santa Cruz, and the north eastern portion of Far Eastside.

ALL	COVID 19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Masks are required indoors in Nevada. Wash/sanitize hands often. Maintain social distancing when applicable. Complete daily COVID screening process.
ALL	EXTREME FIRE BEHAVIOR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Expect intense fire runs with plume dominated fire behavior. Long range spotting of one mile plus has been observed. Prepare for pyro-cumulus collapse with sever out flow winds in all directions.
ALL	DRIVING HAZARDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Watch your speeds. Drive defensively! Expect the unexpected. Watch for road degradation, smokey and dusty conditions. Be aware of debris in the roadways from rollout and suppression operations.
ALL	WEATHER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be aware of changing wind conditions. Watch for changing weather conditions.
ALL	PERSONNEL SAFETY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All personnel are responsible for their personal safety. Immediately report any suspicious activity. Be sure to wear all required PPE while on the fire line.
ALL	ACTIVE TRAIN TRACKS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consider all train tracks in the fire areas as active. Give notice to adjoining Divisions when a train is encountered.
ALL	HYDRATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Drink water before, during and after each shift. Be alert for signs of heat stress in yourself and others.
ALL	FIRE AND DROUGHT WEAKENED TREES/SNAG HAZARDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follow Hazard Tree Safety Guidelines (IRPG p. 22). Many of the trees within the fire area and along roadways are stressed due to drought conditions and burn times.
ALL	CIVILIAN PRESENCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Watch for civilian traffic. Be aware that civilians continue to occupy the fire area. Watch for residents in and around the area.
ALL	COMMUNICATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check the communication plan for frequency assignments. Be clear and concise when talking on the radio. Use human repeaters as needed.
ALL	BRIEFINGS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make sure everyone gets a briefing on the plan for the day. Document this on your ICS 214.
ALL	LCES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure that LCES is being utilized.

Fire and COVID-19 Briefing Checklist

Self-Awareness / Screening

- Immediately separate yourself from others.
- Notify supervisor if you or others experience:
 - Cough, more than expected
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Fever
 - Sore throat
 - Chills
 - Muscle pain
- Review and follow crew and division plans to isolate, triage, and transport symptomatic personnel.

Hygiene on the Fireline

- Properly wash or sanitize your hands often, especially before and after eating or entering a public place, and after coughing or sneezing.
- Avoid handshakes and communal use items.
- Maintain a supply of hand sanitizer and hand wipes. Inform supervisor of needed resupply.
- Disinfect high touch surfaces often:
 - Radios, phones, doors, pumps, fuel cans, etc.

Social Distancing and Protective Equipment

- Initiate, practice, and remind others of social distancing.
- Conduct briefings and conversations outdoors and at least 6 feet apart.
- Utilize face coverings as a tool when practical.
- Clean or replace dirty face coverings, equipment, and PPE.

Communications

- Face coverings and social distancing complicate communications. Ensure effective sender/receiver messaging.

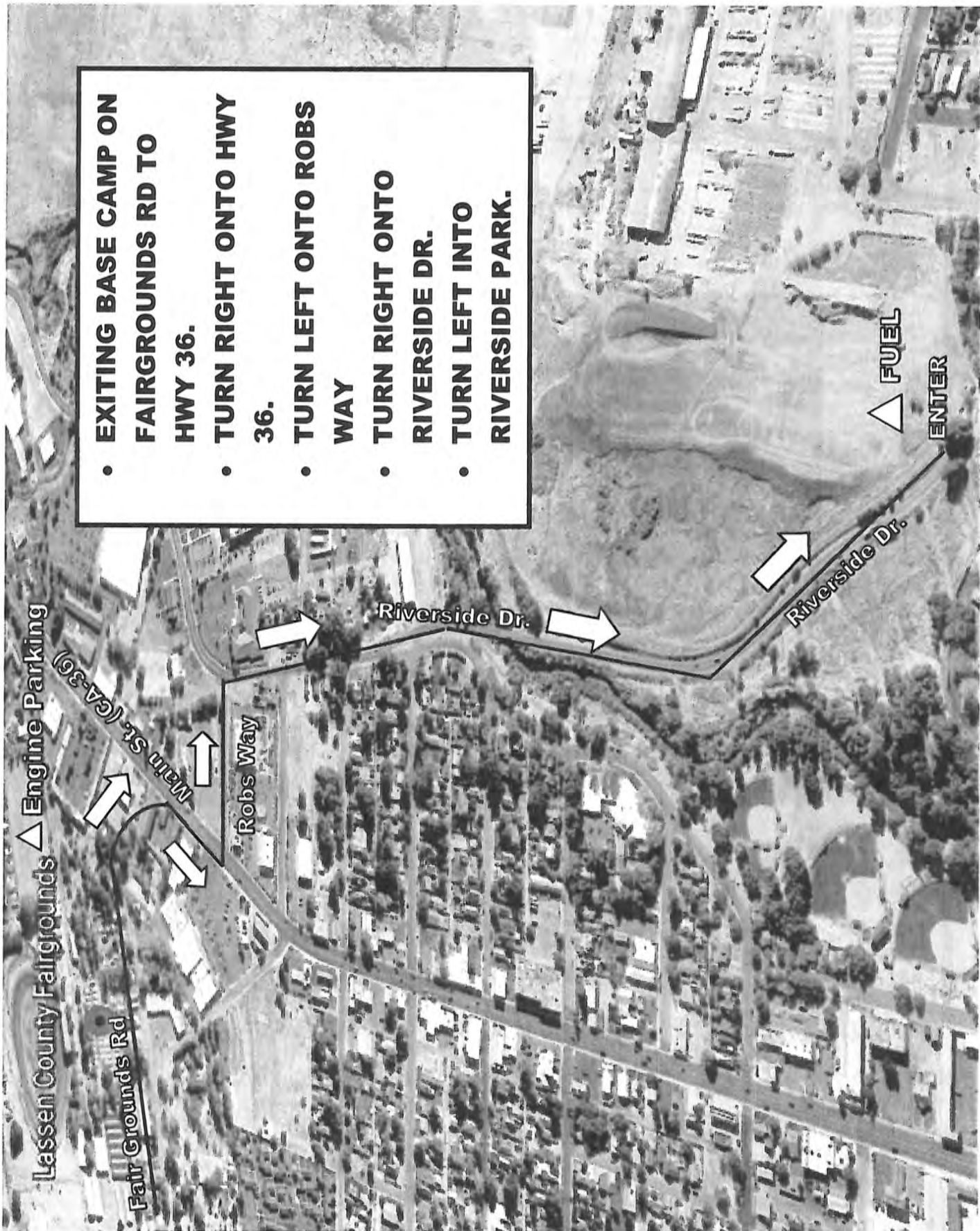


GROUND SUPPORT DEMOB TRAFFIC PLAN
