Strategic Objective

A full suppression strategy is to be utilized on the Dixie Incident. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritize utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principal. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

Leaders Intent

Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take the appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct timely / effective communications
- Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely and defensively Implementation of tactics that offer a high probability of success
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines
- All line supervision personnel including crew and striketeam leaders must attend the morning Operational Briefing

Management Objectives

- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
- Develop strategies to protect life, property, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those with the highest consequences first.
- Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
- Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, California Team 4 as well as the public.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

Control Objectives

- Keep the fire north of fire perimeter and Highway 162 and the junction on Highway 70
- Keep the fire south of Harvey Valley Road
- Keep the fire east of Mill Creek drainage
- Keep the fire west of Genesee Valley Road and Grizzly Ridge to Highway 70 and Highway 395 to limit fire spread

General Situational Awareness

Steep and rugged terrain, critically dry and receptive fuel beds, active area for fire history and drought stressed trees.







WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Smoke from this incident and nearby fires continue to moderate the overall weather conditions and will be the determining factor in the forecast moving forward. Upper level high pressure will continue to build across incident through the end of the week with a continuation of warm and dry conditions. Poor humidity recovery is expected. Light winds this morning will turn to the southeast during the afternoon but will average less than 8 mph with a few higher gusts along the ridgetops resulting in generally poor smoke dispersion. The center of the high will be located over the Great Basin by late Thursday with monsoonal moisture rotating into the region on the western periphery of this high. Increasing moisture and instability will bring a slight chance of thunderstorms late in the week.

WEATHER FORECAST TUESDAY: Widespread smoke and haze. Otherwise, continued warm and dry.

High pressure will continue to build over the region through the middle part of the week with a drying and warming trend expected. Humidity recovery will continue to be poor. Winds will primarily be terrain driven but some southeast winds will be possible during the afternoon hours. Isolated thunderstorms will be possible late in the week. Thunderstorms always imply gusty and erratic winds.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY:

The fire area will have heavy smoke in the morning with some thinning expected in the afternoon. Temperatures will warm to the mid to upper 80's with minimum humidity dropping to 11 to 20% during the day. Winds will be light early, shifting to the Southeast 4-8 mph gusting to 15 mph in the afternoon. Overnight the temperatures will be mid-40's to mid-50's with humidity recovery at 32 - 38%. Winds overnight will be downslope/down valley 3-5mph.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: *FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA*****

Thick smoke early over much of the fire will dampen large fire growth. Southeast winds will thin smoke during the afternoon heat of the day and may allow for increases in fire behavior. The probability of ignition will be around 60 percent with smoke cover increasing to above 90 percent with any clearing skies. With the drought conditions and very dry fuels, spotting will be an issue for much of the operational period. The heavy down fuels are very dry and receptive to spots; they continue to consume almost completely. Limiting spots by increasing mop up distances in the heavy fuels will be vital to holding existing control lines.

ERC's at record levels above 97th percentile!!

SPECIFIC:

Butte Sector: Smoldering material will continue to burnout, with the heavy dead and down consuming deep into the root systems. The slight wind shift to Southeast may push against the control in areas. Lighter downcanyon localized winds should limit challenges to the control lines, allowing for greater success in holding the lines.

Lassen Sector: The fire will progress to the North with the change in wind direction. Expect activity in the Lassen Park area and Caribou wilderness to increase with the Southeast wind. The fire progression is mainly ground fire with single and group tree torching possible under the smoke cover in the morning. As the afternoon heats up and smoke begins to thin, expect increased intensity and short range spotting, especially with winds being channeled by topography. Exceptionally dry fuels are very receptive to ember cast and have been resistive to direct control efforts without large control lines. The southeast portions of this sector will be the first to see any thinning skies with resulting increasing activity. The down canyon winds overnight will be light, increasing chances for opportunities of control efforts.

Westwood Sector: This portion of the fire will advance primarily to the North today, expect movement towards Dyer mtn. and Hamilton mtn. area. Fire activity will be primarily driven by topography and fuels, with localized light winds causing short range spotting to be possible. Terrain is much more variable in this sector with ridgetops that will see the gustiest conditions, channeling surface winds that affect fire spread. Potential for increased activity due to thinning smoke with continued smoldering, creeping and ground fire activity in the Lake and Hamilton areas.

AIR OPERATIONS

Air operations will be limited today, with a chance for some operations if the smoke thins enough

SAFETY

- Snags/ trees can burn in the upper portions. Look up! Just because there is no fire in the lower trunk doesn't mean it safe.
- Limited visibility may give you a false sense of security. Use LCES to ensure you know what the fires are doing around you

Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory

Northern California

July 17, 2021



Subject: Potential for extreme fire behavior due to critically low live and dead fuel moistures, very dry conditions resulting from persistent drought, minimal snowpack and spring precipitation, and elevated fire danger rating values across much of northern California.

Discussion: Fires burning in northern California are exhibiting extreme fire growth based on critical fuel conditions. Fire spread is fuel driven and does not depend on wind to spread. Surface fuels are very receptive to embers. Long range spotting, area ignition, and group torching is occurring on large fires frequently.

Difference from normal conditions: Northern California is in a drought; currently with 90% at Extreme to Exceptional levels. The drought is expected to persist or intensify through out the fire season. Deficient rainfall and snowpack with early melt off has resulted in fuels that are 4-6 weeks ahead of normal drying/curing rates.

Concerns to Firefighters and the Public:

- Energy Release Component (ERC) at numerous weather stations set record maximums already this year and are running at or above the 97th percentile in most cases. Expect increased fire intensity and spread rates in these areas. Early season extreme fire behavior has been observed in both light and heavy fuels. **Anticipate increased spread rates, spotting, and active nighttime burning.**
- The combination of persistent drought and record-low rainfall and snowpack amounts has led to very low live and dead fuel moistures. Low 1000-hour fuel moistures have been evidenced by complete consumption of dead fuels on recent fires. Live fuel moistures in grasses, shrubs and trees, have already reached critical levels in many areas of Northern California due to limited green-up this spring. **Expect fires to ignite easier and spread faster. Do not expect fires to exhibit reduced fire behavior when entering areas of live fuels; anticipate increased spread rates and spotting.**
- Direct attack is often not feasible under regular diurnal wind conditions with ground resources. And aviation utilization is often insufficient in moderating rate of spread without immediate heavy ground resource response. **Anticipate higher resistance to control in all fuel types.**
- Already this year, Northern California has experienced large fire activity and multiple team deployments. California will likely experience an extended fire season. It is important to be mindful of and manage fatigue for all resources. **Everyone, every day, returns home safely.**

Mitigation Measures:

- Local and inbound fire personnel need to be aware that fire behavior across the state is exceeding normal expectations for this time of the year. **Local briefings need to be thorough and highlight specific fire environment conditions. These include but are not limited to local weather forecasts, Pocket Cards, ERC's, live and dead fuel moistures.**
- Suppression actions need to be based on good anchor points, escape routes, and safety zones. **Remember LCES. Experienced lookouts are essential under these conditions.**
- Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire. **Augment initial attack resources as incident activity dictates.**

Area of Concern: Northern California except for the following Predictive Service Areas: North Coast and Bay Marine, west of Highway 101 in Mid-Coast to Mendocino and Diablo-Santa Cruz, and the north eastern portion of Far Eastside.

Com·pla·cen·cy

1. A feeling of quiet pleasure or security, often while unaware of some potential danger or defect.

- Maintain social distance when applicable.
- All types of heavy equipment are working on the incident. Give them space.
- Hazardous trees will react to helicopter drops and rotor wash
- Drink water before, during and after each shift.
- Long range spotting of over 1 mile has been observed on this incident.
- Drive defensively and expect the unexpected.
- Be aware that civilians continue to occupy the fire area.

Hazard Tree Indicators

- Numerous down trees.
- Leaning trees.
- Dead or broken tops and / or limbs hanging in the trees.
- Absences of needles, bark, or limbs.
- Possible of rot indicated by conks, broken tops, basal scars, cat faces, numerous down limbs, ants, abundance of woodpecker holes.
- Stump holes burning in the area.
- Smoke or fire burning in the base or tops of either dead or live trees may indicate rot and / or weakening of tree.

ALL	DRIVING HAZARDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Watch your speeds. Drive defensively! Expect the unexpected. Watch for road degradation, smokey and dusty conditions. Be aware of debris in the roadways from rollout and suppression operations.

ALL	HYDRATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Drink water before, during and after each shift. Be alert for signs of heat stress in yourself and others.
ALL	FIRE AND DROUGHT WEAKENED TREES/SNAG HAZARDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follow Hazard Tree Safety Guidelines (IRPG p. 22). Many of the trees within the fire area and along roadways are stressed due to drought conditions and burn times.
ALL	CIVILIAN PRESENCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Watch for civilian traffic. Be aware that civilians continue to occupy the fire area. Watch for residents in and around the area.
ALL	COMMUNICATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check the communication plan for frequency assignments. Be clear and concise when talking on the radio. Use human repeaters as needed.

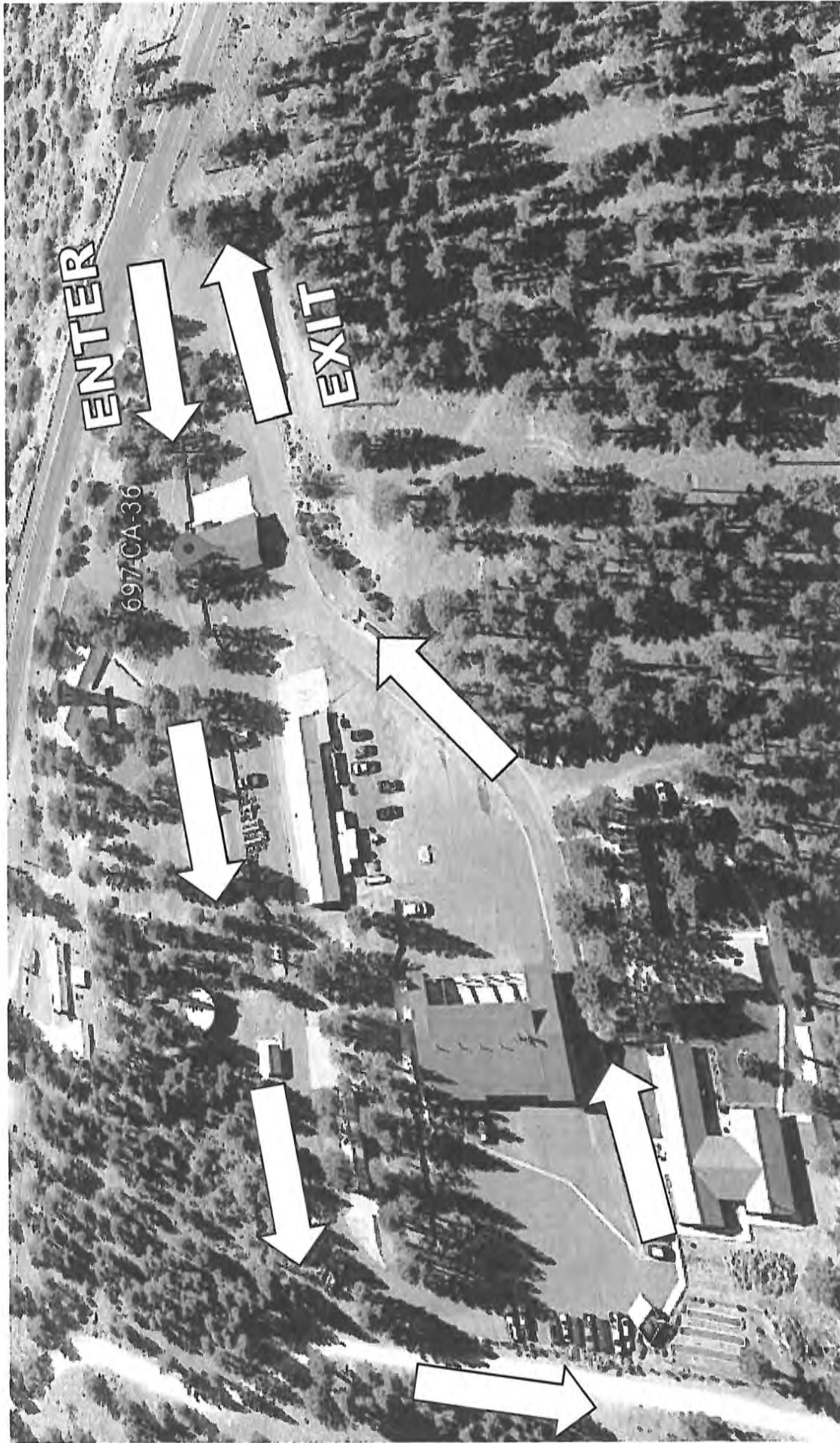

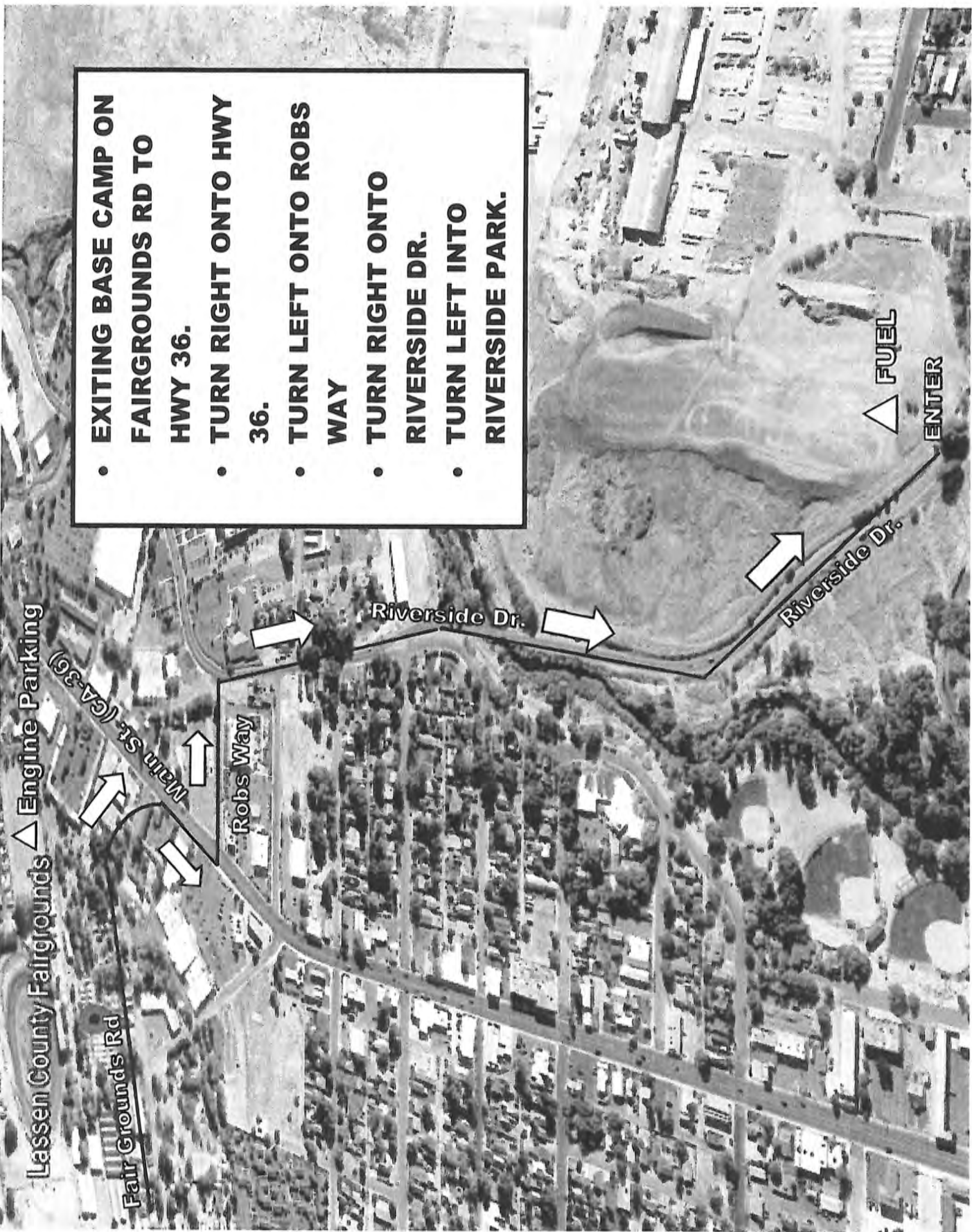
