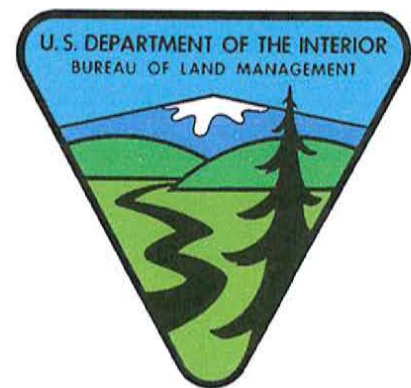



Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritized utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principle. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.			
Leaders Intent:			
Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Professional behavior, conduct timely/effective communications • Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely, and defensively while implementing tactics that offer a high probability of success. • Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines. • All line supervision personnel, including crew and strike team leaders, must attend the morning Operational Briefing. 			
Management Objectives:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public. • Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first. • Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area. • Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, CALFIRE Team 3, as well as the public. • Utilize social media and all other communications tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information. • Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep the fire north of the fire perimeter and Highway 162 and the junction on Highway 70. • Keep the fire south of Harvey Valley Road. • Keep the fire east of Mill Creek drainage. • Keep the fire west of the Genesee Valley Road and Grizzly Ridge to Highway 70 and Highway 395 to limit fire spread.



FUELS: The major fuel types, found in and around the fire area are timber understory and brush.

Ignition Receptiveness: ERC levels are at the 97th percentile. **Probability of Ignition** 90-100%

Dryness: Dead and down fuel moistures: 1 hour – 3% **10 hour- 4%**, 100 hour -5%, and 1000 hour-5%.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Red Flag Warning for the strong Southwest winds. Southwest winds have been a contributing factor to large fire grown and high rates of spread. Topographical features can affect wind speed and direction, be mindful of your location on the landscape. The Evans and Hunt group will most likely be affected in the Antelope Valley, Eisenheimer Peak and Kettle Rock Lake area.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Branch XX

Evans Group: Expect wind driven surface fire, torching and long-range spotting in Antelope Valley. The fire continues to advance to the East towards the Walker fire (2019) burn scar. Wind prone area.

Dyer Group: Moderate activity in the interior from previous firing operation on Dyer Mountain. Fuel driven flanking fire in the Hamilton Mountain area, advancing North at a slow rate of spread.

Hunt Group: Flanking fire in Peters Creek (SW-NE drainage), surface fire, potential for crown runs and spotting with alignment. Anticipate increased activity due to strong winds. Minimal activity, interior smoldering on Keddie Point.

Branch XXV

Division QQ: Minimal activity, interior smoldering in the Hunt Canyon area.

Division RR/WW/XX: Minimal activity, interior smoldering.

Night Branch

Moderate to good RH recovery (up to 65%). Fire behavior should moderate in the late evening. Inversion developing after 2100. The shift will start with a higher probability of ignition as a much warmer Day Shift is forecasted.

Do Basic Things Very Well

- **Fire Behavior:** Follow the Ten Standard Fire Orders in a methodical and thorough way.
- **Hazard/Danger Trees:** Scout work areas, evaluate hazard trees, develop controls, and apply them to mitigate risk.
- **Driving to and from the Line:** Give a briefing on driving hazards prior to every trip.
- **Hydration and Fatigue:** Hydration starts PRIOR to the beginning of shift, drink a 2:1 ratio of water to sports drinks. Monitor fatigue levels, and do not exceed the 2:1 work rest ratio.

Take 5 @ 2pm

It's 1400...you have been working all morning.
How far away have your safety zones become?
Safety zones are only good if you can reach them.
How long will your escape route take?
What is the condition of the crew?
How long will it take your slowest member to get there?
Are your expectations realistic?

Look Up, Look Down, Look Around

- **Fuel Characteristics** – Assess prior to beginning operations.
- **Fuel Moisture** – Read daily shift plan and assess on site.
- **Fuel Temperature** – Varies with exposure to direct sunlight.
- **Terrain & Fuel Accumulations** – Scout prior to beginning operations and continuously during operations.
- **Wind** – Measure, observe, feel and notice changes.
- **Atmospheric Stability** – Observe.
- **Fire Behavior** – Monitor constantly prior to and during operations.
- **Safety** – Ask questions in unfamiliar situations. The only dumb question is the one you did not ask.

Beware of Soft Shoulders

- Many incident roads have **soft shoulders** on the downhill side.
- Wheels may sink into these areas causing the driver to **lose control** of the vehicle.
- **Stay well away** from the downhill side of all roads.
- Allow opposing heavy vehicle traffic to **pass slowly on the uphill side** of narrow access roads, after ensuring there is adequate room.
- Increase following distance to **maintain visibility**.
- **Use a spotter** when backing or turning around your vehicle. Do a walk around if a spotter is not available.

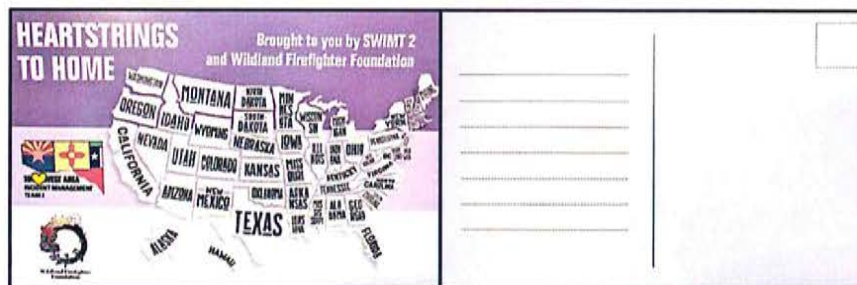

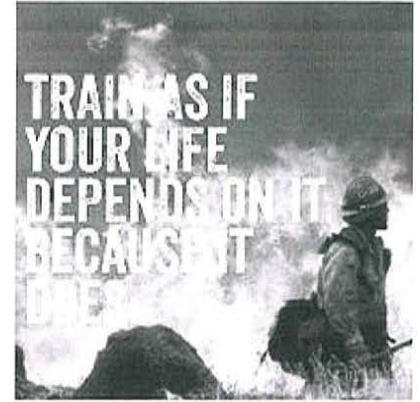

RESOURCE ADVISOR MESSAGE

Reporting of Cultural Sites

- Do not use the radio. Looters listen to our frequencies and will note where you find things.
- Grab a GPS point, bump it up the chain of command or directly inform a Resource Advisor on the line or in camp.

Stay Out!

- **READs will be using flagging for areas to avoid suppression activities. Strip of red/black flagging.**
- For more information, please consult with a READ.

Food & Wildlife

- Throwing away and storing food in proper containers can keep wildlife off the line which prevents encounters with firefighters as well as future harm to the animals.

Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

Water Drafting Sites

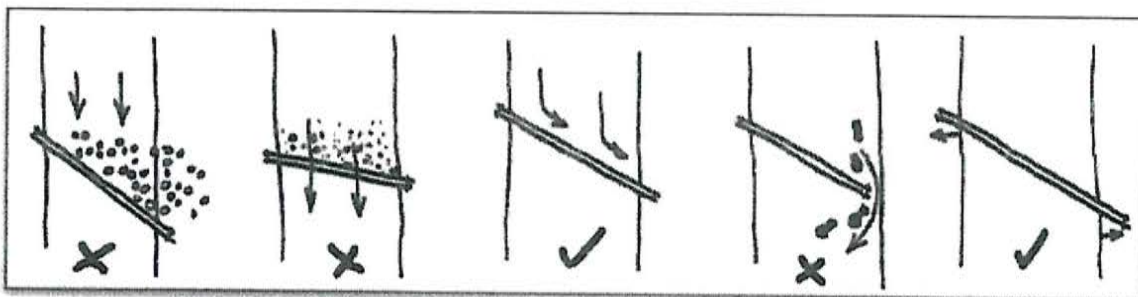
- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Utilize system trails as much as possible for travel and/or handline.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice "Leave No Trace" as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.

Suppression Repair

- Utilize and coordinate with READs when implementing suppression repair plan.
- READs will determine when a line is completed by "approving" the line verbally and/or in ArcGIS Collector.
- Where the use of waterbars are applicable, see visual bird's eye view below. Questions? Ask a READ.

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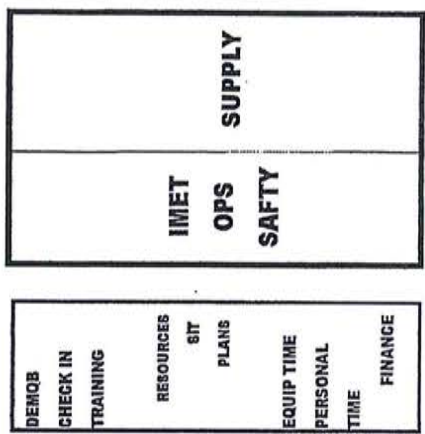

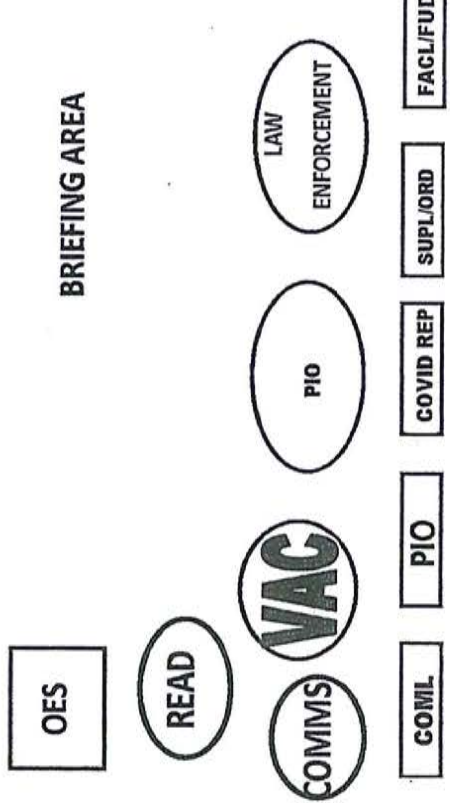

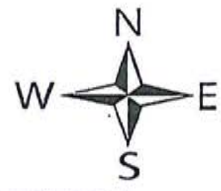
