3. Objective(s):

Strategic Objective

Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritize utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principal. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

Leaders Intent

Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take the appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct timely / effective communications
- Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely and defensively Implementation of tactics that offer a high probability of success
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines
- All line supervision personnel including crew and striketeam leaders must attend the morning Operational Briefing

Management Objectives

- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
- Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
- Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
- Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, California Team 1 as well as the public.
- Utilize social media and all other communications tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

Control Objectives

- Keep the fire north of fire perimeter and Highway 162 and the junction on Highway 70
- Keep the fire south of Harvey Valley Road
- Keep the fire east of Mill Creek drainage
- Keep the fire west of the eastern Lassen County line

General Situational Awareness

Steep and rugged terrain, critically dry and receptive fuel beds, active area for fire history and drought stressed trees.

WEATHER DISCUSSION:

An unseasonably deep upper level low pressure system will move from eastern Nevada to eastern Wyoming during the operational period. This will keep the incident in a predominant northerly flow aloft. As such, north to northeast winds are expected once again. The strongest winds are expected to be across the ridge tops and where the winds line up favorably with topography. These winds and dry air will result in local red flag conditions for branches 9 and 13 through early evening. As the aforementioned upper low moves away, temperatures will be warm slightly and winds will begin to slacken but remain somewhat gusty through mid-evening before laying down. Relative humidity will remain low with very poor recovery along the mid slopes.

WEATHER FORECAST THURSDAY: Smoke and haze in the morning, otherwise mostly sunny.

TEMPERATURES: **Ridge Top:** Highs: 68-73
 Slope/Valley: Highs: 74-79

HUMIDITY: **Ridge Top:** Min: 17-23 %
 Slope/Valley: Min: 14-20 %

20 FT WINDS: **Ridge Top:** North to northeast 5-10 mph in the morning, increasing to 10-20 mph with localized gusts up to 30 mph through late afternoon. Winds will decrease during the late afternoon through early evening.
Slope/Valley: North to northeast 3-6 mph in the morning, increasing to 10-15 mph with gusts of 20 mph in the afternoon. Localized winds may be higher where topography and winds align.

CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS: 0% - LAL: 1 - Haines Index: 3

STABILITY/INVERSION: Weak inversion likely to break by noon. Ventilation will improve dramatically.

WEATHER FORECAST THURSDAY NIGHT: Clear. Areas of smoke and haze.

20 FT WINDS: **Ridge Top:** North to northeast 10-15 mph with gusts of 20 mph in the evening, becoming northeast around 4-8 mph after midnight.
Slope/Valley: North to northeast 10-15 mph with gusts to 20 mph in the evening, possibly slightly higher on exposed slopes and in deeper drainages. Becoming downslope/down valley 3-5 mph by morning.

CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS: 0% - LAL: 1 - Haines Index: 2

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate inversion developing after midnight with poor dispersion

EXTENDED OUTLOOK:

A slow warming trend will start on Friday and carry through the weekend. Winds on Friday will shift back to the southwest in advance of another dry front. This front will bring gusty winds on Saturday with elevated fire weather concerns. Sunday and into next week, warm and dry condition are expected with generally light winds as weak southwest flow gets established.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY: ****RED FLAG WARNING FOR BRANCHES 9 & 13****

Wind direction will continue to be from the Northeast, a major shift from previous days. Temperatures will be in the upper 60's to the upper 70's with minimum humidity dropping to 14 to 23% during the day. Winds will be Northeast in the morning 5-10 mph, increasing to 10-15 gusting to 30 mph. Overnight the temperatures will be in the upper 30's to lower 50's with humidity recovery at 50-65%, except 35-40% in the mid slope thermal belt areas. Winds overnight will continue from the Northeast at 10-15 mph with 20 mph gusts until early morning hours.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: ***FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA***

The Smoke layer will be heaviest in areas of active burning to start the day, but will thin around mid-day. Wind direction will continue to impact the eastern aspects of the topography, a different effect than previous days. Areas that have been sheltered by winds in previous days will now get a push of wind. Expect this change to potentially cause an increase in activity, including single and group tree torching. Exceptionally dry timber stands are very receptive to spotting, and can contribute to large fire growth. The probability of ignition will be around 60% under the smoke cover, and 90% in clear areas. Spotting distances of ¼ to ¾ of a mile are possible in topographic favored areas and any downwind locations.

ERC's at record levels above 97th percentile!!

SPECIFIC:

Butte Sector: Smoldering material will continue to burnout, especially in the stump holes and large dead and down. Minimal heat exists in the sector, expect this to continue as mopup and patrol continues.

Lassen Sector: Fire activity should be moderate to start the shift. Fire activity on the eastern aspects will see winds throughout the day. Expect an increase quickly as the wind exposed slopes begins to experience the forecasted increase in winds. Rugged terrain will channel winds and increase the probability of ember cast and spotting, especially in upper elevations or thinner tree stands. Fire activity in Branch 13 will be especially prone to terrain driven winds.

Lake Branch: Fire activity in this branch will be primarily smoldering and isolated ground fire. Control lines should not be challenged by the change of wind direction, but be aware of snag trees coming down.

Clear/Susanville/Janesville Branches: Fire progression is primarily fuel and slope driven, but expect short intense runs and plume development in areas where fuel, winds, and topography align. As the smoke clears in the afternoon and if fire becomes established in heavy pockets of fuel in favored topographic features, expect short intense runs and plume development. Wind will be channeled along the escarpment to the southeast and up the Susan river drainage. Expect the steady Northeast winds to influence fire activity for most of the shift.

AIR OPERATIONS

Air operations should be able to start early today, but smoke may inhibit areas nearest the high activity locations.

SAFETY

- Escape routes and safety zones are a must especially with heavy timber and extremely dry fuels and observed extreme fire behavior!
- Snags and stump holes are likely in timber areas.

Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory

Northern California

August 17, 2021 to August 31, 2021



Subject: Potential for extreme fire behavior due to critically low live and dead fuel moistures, very dry conditions resulting from persistent drought, minimal snowpack and spring precipitation, and elevated fire danger rating values across much of northern California.

Discussion: Fires burning in northern California are exhibiting extreme fire growth based on critical fuel conditions. Fire spread is fuel driven and does not depend on wind to spread. Surface fuels are very receptive to embers. Long range spotting, area ignition, and group torching is occurring on large fires frequently.

Difference from normal conditions: Northern California is in a drought; currently with 90% at Extreme to Exceptional levels. The drought is expected to persist or intensify thorough out the fire season. Deficient rainfall and snowpack with early melt off has resulted in fuels that are below average in dryness, with record setting conditions for most areas.

Concerns to Firefighters and the Public:

- Energy Release Component (ERC) at numerous weather stations set record maximums already this year and are running at or above the 97th percentile in most cases. Expect increased fire intensity and spread rates in these areas. Early season extreme fire behavior has been observed in both light and heavy fuels. **Anticipate increased spread rates, spotting, and active nighttime burning.**
- The combination of persistent drought and record-low rainfall and snowpack amounts has led to very low live and dead fuel moistures. Low 1000-hour fuel moistures have been evidenced by complete consumption of dead fuels on recent fires. Live fuel moistures in grasses, shrubs and trees, have already reached critical levels in many areas of Northern California due to limited green-up this spring. **Expect fires to ignite easier and spread faster. Do not expect fires to exhibit reduced fire behavior when entering areas of live fuels; anticipate increased spread rates and spotting.**
- Direct attack is often not feasible under regular diurnal wind conditions with ground resources. And aviation utilization is often insufficient in moderating rate of spread without immediate heavy ground resource response. **Anticipate higher resistance to control in all fuel types.**
- Already this year, Northern California has experienced large fire activity and multiple team deployments. California will likely experience an extended fire season. It is important to be mindful of and manage fatigue for all resources. **Everyone, every day, returns home safely.**

Mitigation Measures:

- Local and inbound fire personnel need to be aware that fire behavior across the state is exceeding normal expectations for this time of the year. **Local briefings need to be thorough and highlight specific fire environment conditions. These include but are not limited to local weather forecasts, Pocket Cards, ERC's, live and dead fuel moistures.**
- Suppression actions need to be based on good anchor points, escape routes, and safety zones. **Remember LCES. Experienced lookouts are essential under these conditions.**
- Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire. **Augment initial attack resources as incident activity dictates.**

Area of Concern: Northern California except for the following Predictive Service Areas: North Coast and Bay Marine, west of Highway 101 in Mid-Coast to Mendocino and Diablo-Santa Cruz, and the north eastern portion of Far Eastside.

Self-Awareness / Screening

- Immediately separate yourself from others.
- Notify supervisor if you or others experience:
 - Cough, more than expected
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Fever
 - Sore throat
 - Chills
 - Muscle pain
- Review and follow crew and division plans to isolate, triage, and transport symptomatic personnel.

Hygiene on the Fireline

- Properly wash or sanitize your hands often, especially before and after eating or entering a public place, and after coughing or sneezing.
- Avoid handshakes and communal use items.
- Maintain a supply of hand sanitizer and hand wipes. Inform supervisor of needed resupply.
- Disinfect high touch surfaces often:
 - Radios, phones, doors, pumps, fuel cans, etc.

Social Distancing and Protective Equipment

- Initiate, practice, and remind others of social distancing.
- Conduct briefings and conversations outdoors and at least 6 feet apart.
- Utilize face coverings as a tool when practical.
- Clean or replace dirty face coverings, equipment, and PPE.

Communications

- Face coverings and social distancing complicate communications. Ensure effective sender/receiver messaging.

Properly identified members of the news media should not be restricted from entering locations specified within the code. However, this does not include crime scenes, private property and does not imply that the news media may interfere with incident operations while they are in the areas of concern. Social media posts can reflect on the professionalism of your crew, your agency, and Wildland Firefighting Community. The U.S. Forest Service has enjoyed a reputation as the world leader in wildland firefighting for over 100 years. Protect our legacy with good conduct on the fireline and online. When assigned to a federal fire you are considered a federal employee under the delegation of authority. Even if you are a contractor, AD or from a partner agency we recommend you follow these ethics guidelines which apply to federal employees all the time.

PHOTOGRAPHS AND VIDEOS OF INCIDENT

The Public Information Office would like copies of the video and pictures that you safely took while not in an emergency, fire suppression activity or in an overhead assignment. Bring your video and pictures to the Public Information trailer; they will be reviewed and possibly uploaded to our many CAL FIRE social media sites. Remember, we don't want photographs or videos that depict unsafe, unprofessional, or embarrassing circumstances, which are a serious breach of ethics. 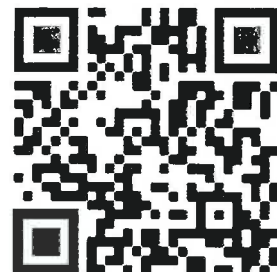

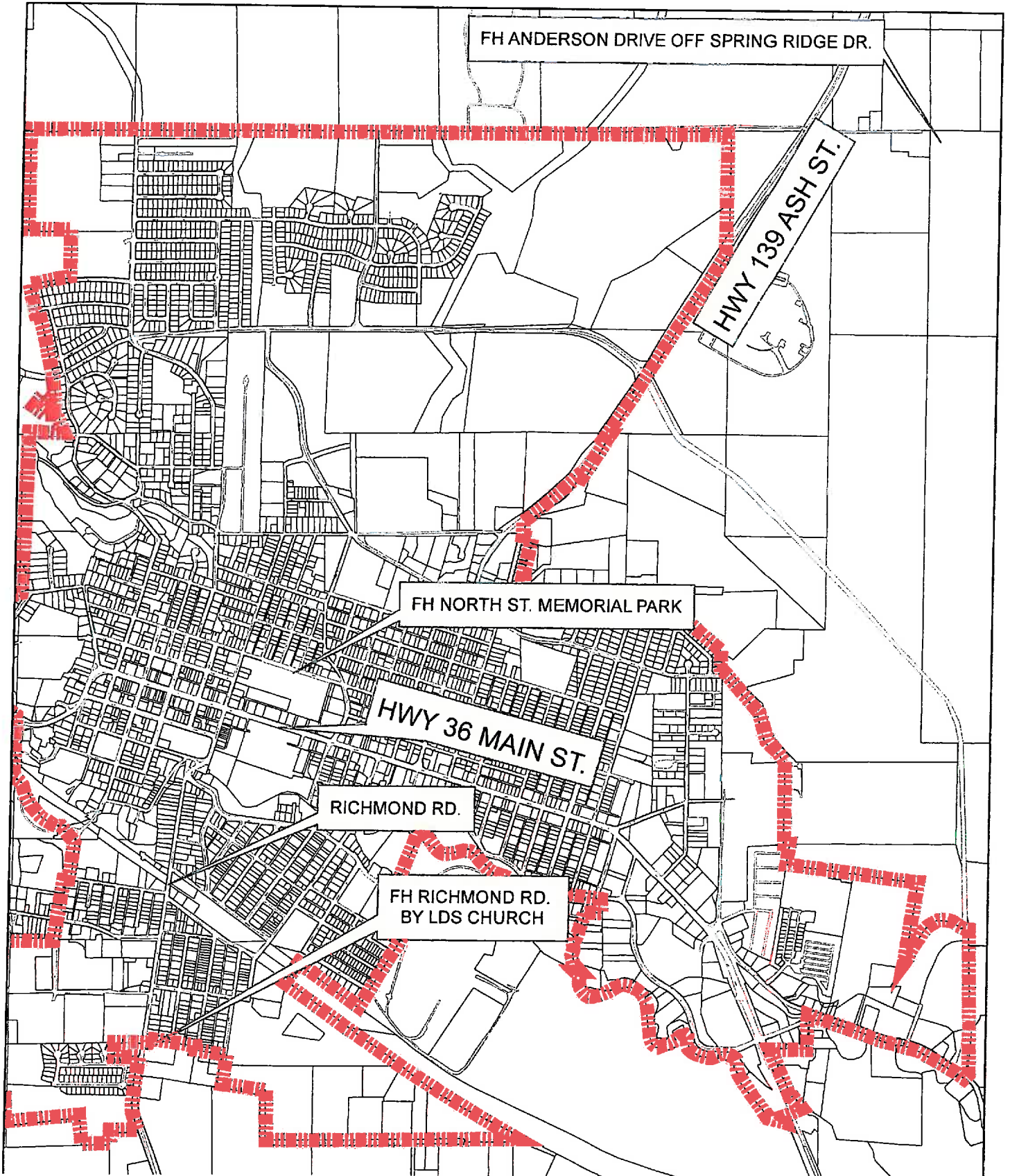

Today's Feature: Whitebark Pine (*Pinus albicaulis*)

- Whitebark pine: found in high elevations in Lassen Volcanic NP
 - High-energy food source for wildlife.
 - Dependent on Clark's nutcracker, which have specialized beaks unique to pry open whitebark pine cones.
- Up to 90% of population in Northern parts of range have been wiped out.
- Main threats: mountain pine beetle, non-native blister rust fungus, warming temperatures, and crowding by other tree species due to elimination of fire.
- Multiple agencies are involved with efforts to find individuals resistant to blister rust and plant seedlings from those trees that are resistant.
- This tree is proposed for listing as Threatened under Endangered Species Act.
- **PARK PROTECTION MEASURE: AVOID CUTTING!**

How to identify:

- 5 needle bundles with 1.5 – 3 inch long, thin, and bluish needles. Light colored bark.
- Round, purpleish cones often pointing up when attached to the tree.
- Up to 60 ft tall and live for 1000 years or more.

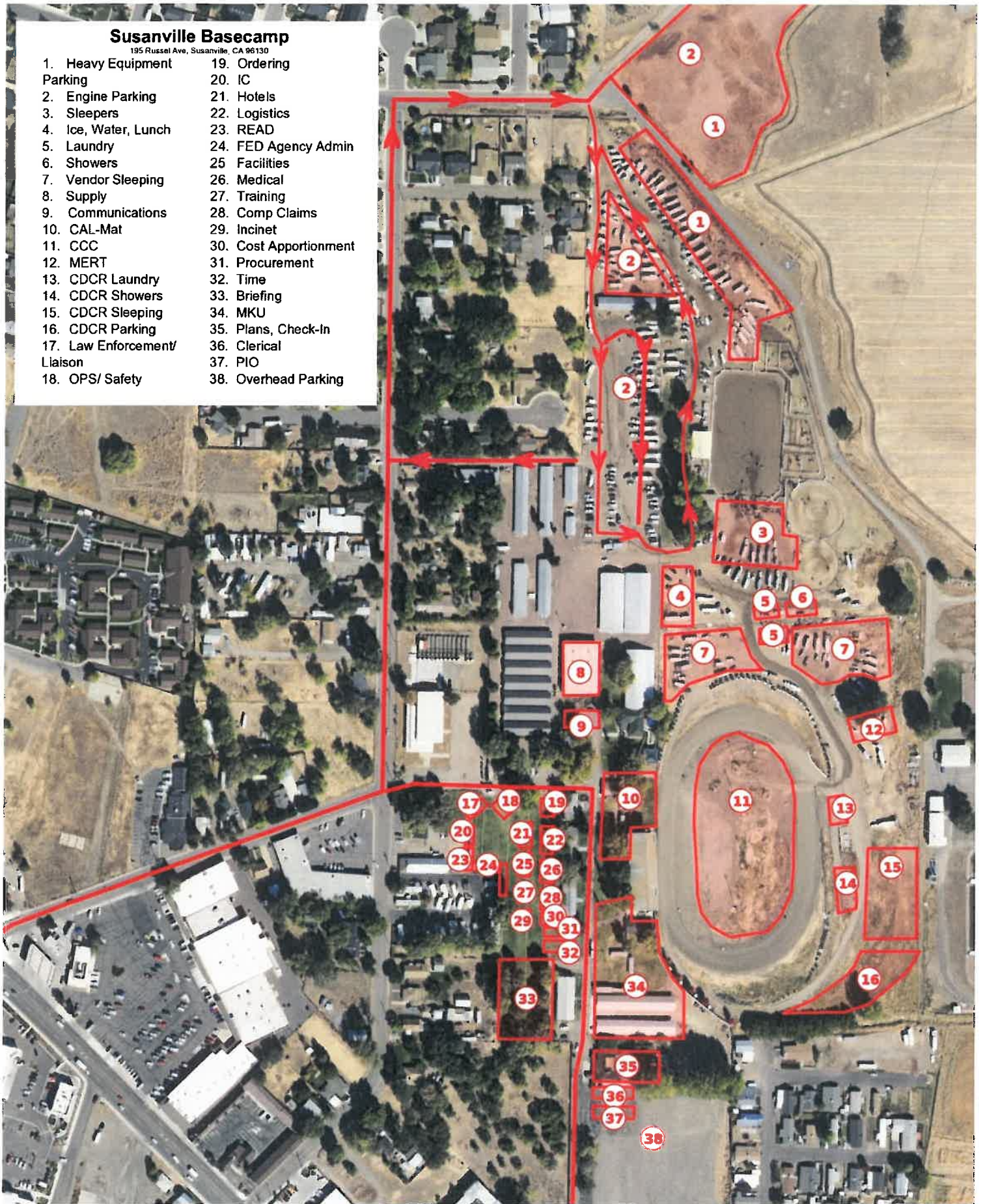

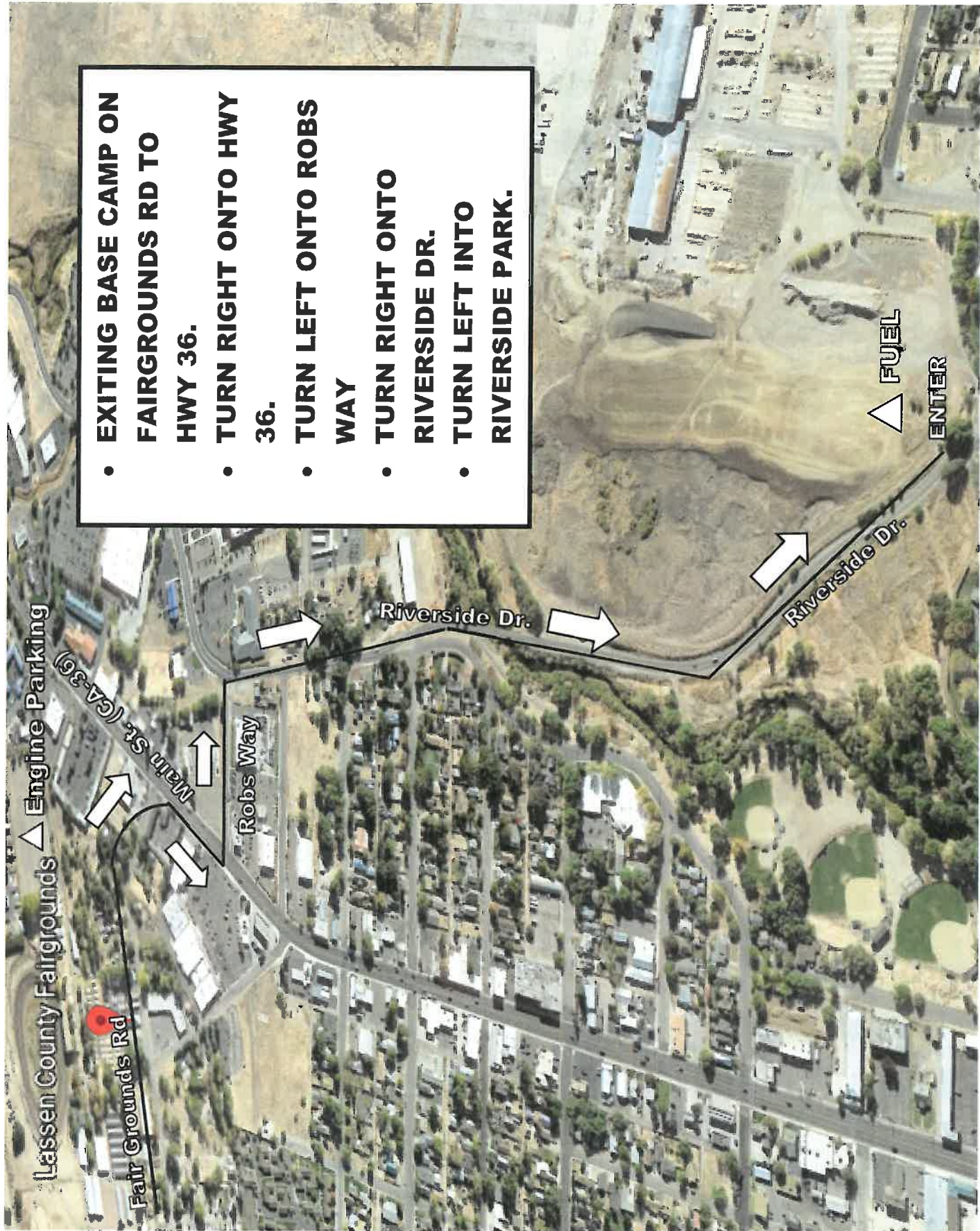

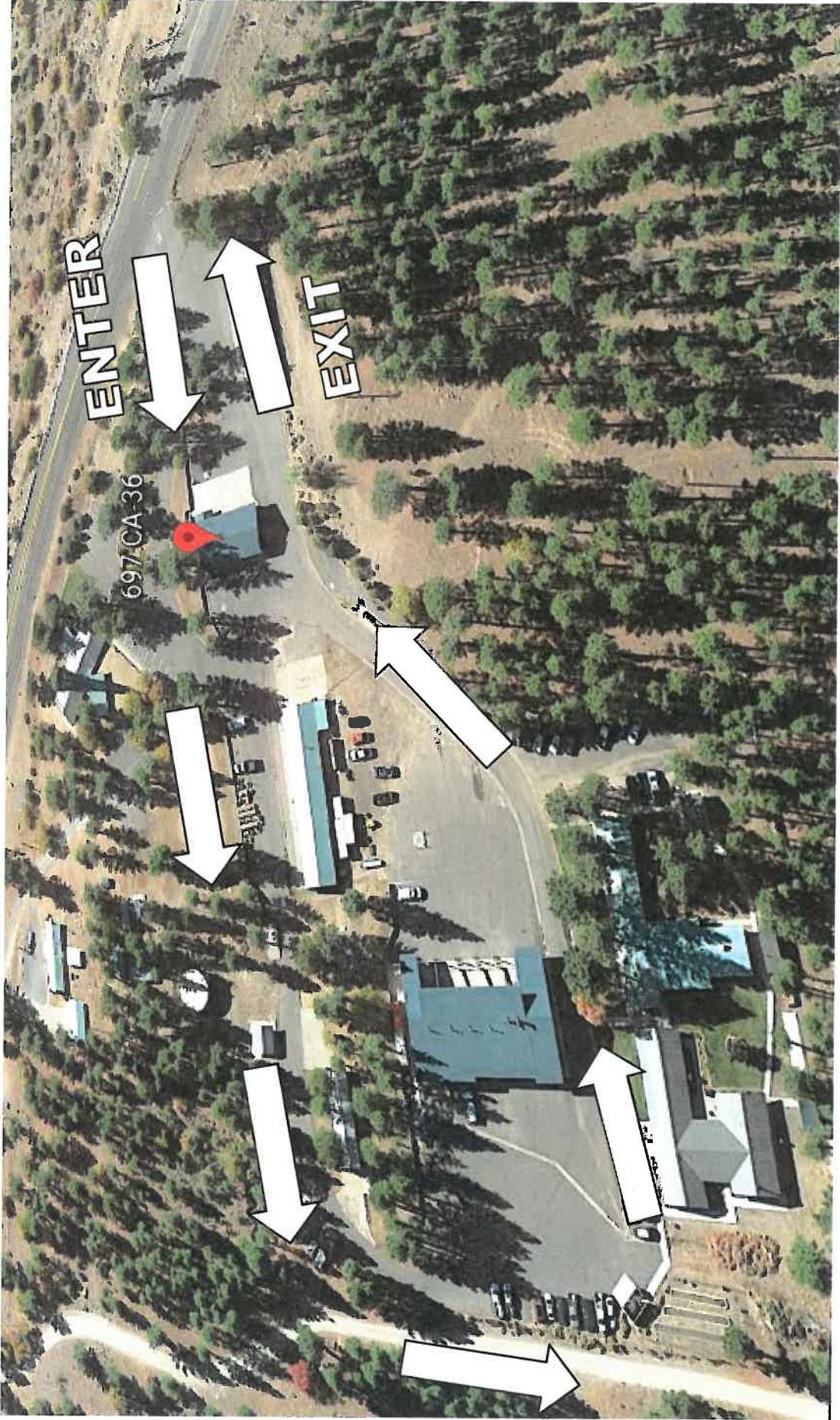
