

WEATHER DISCUSSION: East to southeast winds in the wake of a dry cold front will continue this morning, before diminishing and becoming west-southwest this afternoon. Temperatures continue to climb and could reach the lower 90s in valley areas this afternoon. A dry air mass aiding poor overnight slope recoveries will also allow for critically low relative humidity values this afternoon below 15% in many locations. Lingering smoke around the area could delay the rise in temperatures through the morning hours along with poor visibility in valleys.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Sunday through Thursday. Very dry and warm conditions expected Sunday with southwest winds returning to the area as another trough pattern emerges. A very dry air mass will lead to poor overnight slope recoveries and single digit daytime humidity with stronger southwest winds expected Monday resulting in elevated fire weather conditions. A southwest wind pattern will continue into midweek but temperatures will cool a bit and humidity will rise slightly. The area will remain dry with little to no clouds.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY:

The weather will be warm and dry, with temperatures in the high 70's to 80's. The relative humidity will continue to be low, 10 to 17%, with poor recovery in the mid and upper slopes. Winds will be variable throughout the fire and during the day, refer to the Weather Forecast for specifics. Overnight temperatures will be in the 40's to low 50's and relative humidity 30 to 65%. Winds overnight will be south-southwest 4 to 6 mph on the ridges.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: ****FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA****

The winds will be the strongest in the morning hours turning to more terrain driven in the afternoon. The terrain will create a variable wind pattern around the fire perimeter. The fire will have multiple influences around the isolated peaks and can funnel between close peaks. Observing the weather in the area you are working will be critical. Fire progression will generally be slow with isolated and some group torching. Spotting distances will short range, around a ¼ or less without large column build-up. Ground fuels will be the main carriers in the open understory. The taller brush will contribute to fire in the tree canopy. Smoke cover will be shifting over the fire as the winds transition through the day.

SPECIFIC:

Lassen/Shasta Sector: The fire will be the least active in the valleys in the afternoon with the light variable winds. Ridgetops will carry fire early in the morning with the higher winds and become less active in the afternoon. The flatter terrain will allow for more funneling around the buttes causing changing and converging wind patterns. The general fire progression will be a slow rate of spread until it moves into the ridges or drainages with wind alignment.

Butte Sector: The low humidity will aid in the larger fuels to consume and burn out. Due to the longevity of the fire the remaining overstory is beginning to drop to the ground creating a new receptive fuel bed. Standing trees with smoldering material at the base have potential to reignite creating ember cast, especially on ridgetops.

Janesville Branch: The wind will have a complete switch in direction during the operational period. The smoke may clear out in the morning but will most likely return in the afternoon when the wind shifts. The early morning winds will be the strongest and will be across the line on the western portion. Be aware of the wind shift and the activity of the main fire to the southwest.

Clear/Lake Branch: The fire will continue to smolder throughout the area. The remaining overstory will continue to fall to the ground and create a new receptive fuel bed. Trees with smoldering material at the base will continue to burn and will become more active especially on the ridge tops, creating possible spotting issues.

AIR OPERATIONS

The shifting winds may create visibility over different sections of the fire throughout the day. The northern portion may be the clear in the morning and smoked out in the afternoon.

SAFETY

Evaluate the terrain you are working in and how it will affect the wind patterns which will affect the fire behavior.

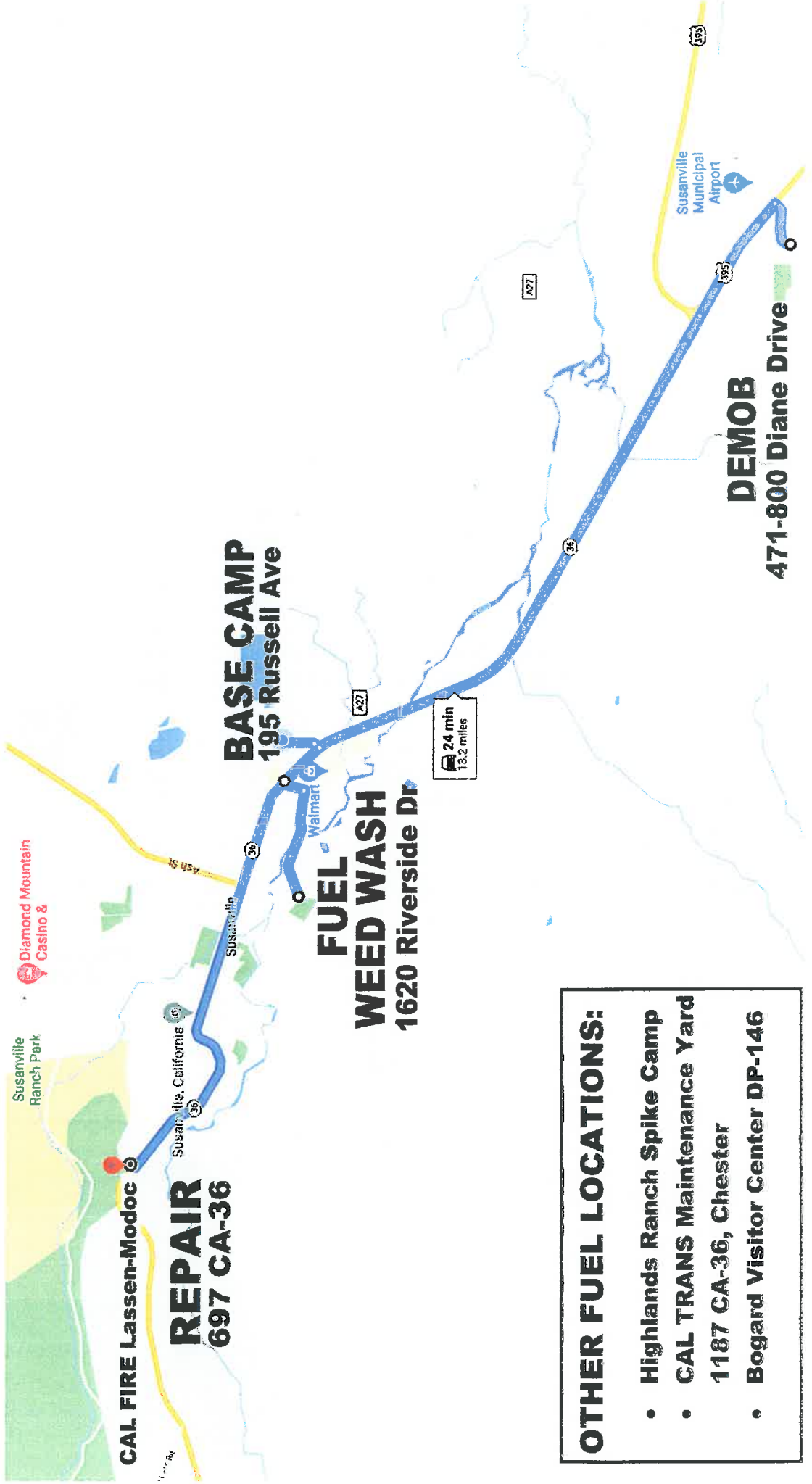

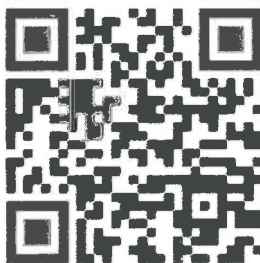
