Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

- Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take the appropriate actions regarding:
- Professional behavior, conduct timely / effective communications
 - Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely and defensively Implementation of tactics that offer a high probability of success
 - Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines
 - All line supervision personnel including crew and striketeam leaders must attend the morning Operational Briefing

- Management Objectives**
- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
 - Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
 - Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
 - Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, Great Basin Team 1 as well as the public.
 - Utilize social media and all other communications tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
 - Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

 - Keep the fire south of Harvey Valley Road
 - Keep the fire east of Mill Creek drainage
 - Keep the fire west of the eastern Lassen County line



RED FLAG WARNING FOR GUSTY WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITY THIS AFTERNOON

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Critical fire weather conditions are expected this afternoon and early evening as gusty west-southwest winds develop and humidity drops below 15% following poor overnight recoveries. Winds along the US-395 corridor and ridge to the west will be particularly strong. Temperatures will cool slightly but will still be quite warm generally in the upper 70s to 80s for highs.

TODAY:

SKY/WEATHER: Smoke filled valleys in the morning, clearing from southwest to northeast afternoon.

MAX TEMP: Valleys: 82-87° **MIN HUMIDITY:** Valleys: 9-14%
Ridgetops: 75-79° Ridgetops: 11-16%

CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS: 0% **LAL:** 1.

WINDS: Valleys: Downslope wind 2-4 mph in the morning. West-southwest 3-5 mph developing late morning increasing to 8-12 mph with gusts around 20 mph in the afternoon.
(20 FEET) Ridgetops: West-southwest 8-13 mph with gusts to 16 mph in the morning increasing to between 14-22 mph with gusts approaching 35 mph in the afternoon.

HAINES: 5 (moderate)

MIXING HEIGHT: Rising to 7,500 feet by 1700. **TRANSPORT WIND:** Southwest 17-22 mph

VISIBILITY: One mile in valleys in the morning increasing to 6-9 miles in the afternoon.

INVERSION: Inversion mixing out earlier between 1130 and 1200.

TONIGHT:

SKY/WEATHER: Smoke and haze.

MIN TEMP: Valleys: 42-47° **MAX HUMIDITY:** Valleys: 40-50%
Ridgetops: 47-52° Mid Slopes: 25-30%
Ridgetops: 30-35%

CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS: 0% **LAL:** 1

WINDS: Valleys: West-southwest 6-10 mph with gusts to 18 mph in the evening. Downslope/down valley 3-5 mph after 2000.
Ridgetops: West-southwest 15-22 mph with gusts 30-35 mph in the evening. Southwest winds after midnight 10-15 mph with gusts to 20 mph.

TRANSPORT WIND: Southwest 10-20 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Shallow inversion developing, poor ventilation developing in sheltered valleys.


EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Tuesday through Saturday. A critical fire weather pattern will persist into Tuesday with a Red Flag Warning in effect for gusty southwest winds and very low, in some cases single digit, relative humidity during the daytime hours. This weather pattern can contribute to extreme fire behavior and winds on Tuesday could be slightly higher than today. Elevated winds and poor overnight recoveries will exist through midweek. Winds remain elevated Wednesday with somewhat lighter southwest winds persisting through next weekend. Temperatures will gradually fall through midweek with humidity only improving slightly. Dry conditions with limited to no cloud cover will continue through the weekend.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY: *RED FLAG CONDITIONS FOR GUSTY WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITY*****
The weather will continue to be warm and dry, with **INCREASING WINDS**. Temperatures will be 75-87 degrees during the day and 42-52 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 9-16 percent during the day and 25-50 percent overnight. The wind will be west-southwest 14-22 mph with gust to 35 mph in the afternoon. Overnight the winds will be west-southwest changing to southwest 10-15 mph with gust to 20 mph.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: *FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA*****

The wind will continue through the day increasing in the afternoon, then weaken slightly overnight. The atmosphere is also unstable allowing for vertical build of the column when enough heat is produced from the fire to override the wind. This will happen if the fire becomes established and can grow uncontrolled. The combination of vertical column growth and stronger winds will lead to long range spotting as the column becomes pushed by the wind. Without good column growth spotting will stay short to mid-range, ¼ to ½ mile. Probability of ignition will be in the 90's during the afternoon. The fuels are critical, and the weather is at red flag conditions, expect rapid growth in unsheltered areas and light fuels.

SPECIFIC:

Lassen/Shasta Sector: The wind will continue to create spotting issues, specifically in Branch 16. The fire will continue towards Highway 44. The fuels along the highway are more spaced with shorter brush which should reduce the amount of fire in the crown. The area to the northeast of the Highway 44 and A21 road is very thick timber and will transition easier in the crown.

Butte Sector: The wind will not have as much impact in the area but will be stronger than in the previous days. Interior torching could see longer transports of fire brands. The stronger wind will also contribute to more overstory falling to the ground creating more potential for active fire.

Janesville Branch: The wind will be increasing over the escarpment and has the potential to surface to the valley to the east. This could create extreme fire spread downslope for any established fire. The main fire continues to actively burn and is nearing the southern portion of the Walker Fire perimeter. Once it is south of the perimeter it will begin to advance to the east towards Highway 395, continue to be diligent in knowing how the fire is burning and its location.

Clear/Lake Branch: The air should start to clear out throughout the day and increase activity of smoldering material. The wind will also contribute to the overstory continuing to fall to the ground creating new ground fuels and increasing activity. Any interior islands will have the potential to increase in activity.

AIR OPERATIONS

The wind will clear the ridges early, the valley may not clear until midday.

SAFETY

Be observant of the fire column and how it can affect the fire. Know where your safety zones and escape routes are, and how long it takes to travel to reach them.
