

Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritized utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principle. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.			
<b><u>Leaders Intent:</u></b>			
Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Professional behavior, conduct timely/effective communications.</li> <li>• Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely, and defensively while implementing tactics that offer a high probability of success.</li> <li>• Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines.</li> <li>• Ensure all personnel have been briefed in operational strategies and tactics.</li> </ul>			
<b><u>Management Objectives:</u></b>			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.</li> <li>• Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. **WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Low pressure moving through the Pacific Northwest will affect northern California during the afternoon today, increasing wind and cooling temperatures slightly, but will not bring rain or even clouds. The moderate to strong wind continues through Tuesday.

WEATHER: Sunny except for smoke.

TEMPERATURE: Ridge high 78 to 84. Valley high 84 to 92.  
HUMIDITY: 8 to 14 percent.

### 20 FT WIND:

**RIDGETOP** – South southwest 6 to 12 mph gusts to 18 mph, by 1300 increasing to 12 to 20 mph gusts to 32 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Down valley/downslope 1 to 4 mph, by 1100 becoming southwest 4 to 10 mph gusts to 16 mph. By 1400, valley wind becoming southwest 10 to 16 mph gusts to 28 mph.

SW 25 mph.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY

Another hot and dry day and ridgetop winds gusting to 32 mph from the SSW after 1300.

#### Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. All fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**General:** Active to extreme fire behavior expected today, flanking, group torching, short uphill runs and potential for ¼-1 mile spotting. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. Haines of 5 increases the potential to transition to a plume dominated fire in areas of heavy timber.

**DIV NN/OO/PP:** Minimal fire activity providing good opportunity for patrol and mop-up.

**DIV UU/Genesee Group:** Backing, flanking and single tree torching.

**Valley Group:** Expect minimal fire activity. Patrol and mop-up.

**DIV RR:** The fire will continue to burn along Grizzly and Turner Ridges. Expect active to extreme fire behavior. Flanking, uphill runs, torching, and spotting. Increased probability of plume development.

**QQ/Davis Group:** Fire will continue to burn along Turner Ridge and towards Red Clover Creek. As the fire moves closer to Mt. Ingalls there is an increased probability that wind could align with Coldwater Creek and channel fire spread. The Walker Fire scar is expected to limit fire spread to the north.

**DIV WW/XX:** Minimal fire activity.

**Night Ops:** Sustained winds and continued poor RH recovery is expected to keep fire behavior active overnight. Flanking, short uphill runs, torching and potential for short range spotting.

**AIR OPERATIONS:** Higher winds should clear smoke out of most of the fire area however, heavy smoke is expected downwind of the main fire front.

### SAFETY:

Conditions requiring good decision making should be anticipated well in advance, better to be an hour ahead rather than a minute behind. Critical to know what your fire is doing at all times – better to know what it is going to do.

## Reporting of Cultural Sites

- Grab a GPS point, bump it up the chain of command or directly inform a Resource Advisor on the line or in camp.

## TRASH/FOOD & WILDLIFE

- Be professional, pick up your trash and that of others, you can get trash bags from supply.
- Throwing away and storing food in proper containers can keep wildlife off the line which prevents encounters with firefighters as well as future harm to the animals.

## Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

## Water Drafting Sites

- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

## Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice “Leave No Trace” as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.
