## **RED FLAG WARNING FOR GUSTY WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITY THROUGH 11 PM**

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Critical fire weather conditions are expected again this afternoon through the late evening. Gusty southwest winds will increase this afternoon and humidity will fall to critical levels of 15% or lower in most locations following poor to moderate overnight recoveries. Winds along the US-395 corridor and ridge to the west will be stronger with ridgetop gusts approaching 35 mph. Slightly cooler temperatures are expected with winds and very low RH the primary concern.

### **TODAY:**

**SKY/WEATHER:** Smoke filled valleys in the morning, clearing from southwest to northeast afternoon.

**WINDS:**      **Valleys:** Downslope wind 2-4 mph in the morning. Southwest 3-5 mph developing late morning increasing to 8-12 mph with gusts around 20 mph in the afternoon.  
**(20 FEET)**      **Ridgetops:** Southwest 7-10 mph in the morning increasing to between 10-20 mph with gusts around 30 mph in the afternoon. Locally higher gusts along and west of the 395 corridor.

**WINDS:**      **Valleys:** Southwest 6-10 mph with gusts to 18 mph in the evening. Downslope/down valley 2-4 mph after 2000.  
**Ridgetops:** West-southwest 15-22 mph with gusts 30-35 mph in the early evening. Diminishing winds after sunset into early Wednesday morning.

**TRANSPORT WIND:** Southwest 10-20 mph steadily decreasing through the night.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Shallow inversion developing, poor ventilation after midnight.


**EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Wednesday through Sunday.** Gusty southwest winds will continue Wednesday but are expected to be below critical levels. A more typical southwest wind from the central valley region is expected each day from Thursday into early next week. Temperatures will fall several degrees into Thursday but humidity will remain quite low with poor to moderate higher elevation recoveries. Dry conditions with limited to no cloud cover will continue into early next week.

### INPUTS

**WEATHER SUMMARY: \*\*\*RED FLAG CONDITIONS FOR GUSTY WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITY\*\*\***

The weather will continue to be warm and dry, with **GUSTY WINDS**. Temperatures will be 72-84 degrees during the day and 38-50 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 9-17 percent during the day and 25-65 percent overnight. The wind will be southwest 10-20 mph with gust to 30 mph in the afternoon. Overnight the winds will be west-southwest 15-22 mph with gust to 30-35 mph. Winds will weaken through the night.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**GENERAL: \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\***

The fire will continue to be influenced by the strong winds. Some areas of the fire will not have the direct effect of the wind on the flaming front but will have the influence on the column. The topography in the area will also funnel winds different directions. If the fire builds enough heat, it will overpower the wind component and build vertically. The winds aloft will continue to push the column to the northeast. When the fuels transition to lighter loading, fewer trees and shorter brush the spotting distances will be reduced to short to mid- range. When the fire is burning in the heavier timber stands the heat will build vertical and can produce long range spotting.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Lassen/Shasta Sector:** The wind will continue to create spotting issues, specifically in Branch 16. The fire will continue towards Highway 44. The fuels along the highway are more spaced with shorter brush which should reduce the amount of fire in the crown. The area to the northeast of the Highway 44 and A21 road is very thick timber and will transition easier in the crown. The area to the west has open meadows with light fuel loading more conducive for control efforts. Branch 9 will continue to burn back into the northern portion and flank slowly towards Highway 44

**Butte Sector:** The wind will not have as much impact in the area but will be stronger than in the previous days. Interior torching could see longer transports of fire brands. The stronger wind will also contribute to more overstory falling to the ground creating more potential for active fire.

**Janesville Branch:** The wind will be increasing over the escarpment and has the potential to surface to the valley to the east. This could create extreme fire spread downslope for any established fire. The main fire continues to actively burn and is nearing the southern portion of the Walker Fire perimeter. Once it is south of the perimeter it will begin to advance to the east towards Highway 395. The fuels have more of an open brush component which will increase the rates of spread and reduce spotting potential.

**Clear/Lake Branch:** The air should start to clear out throughout the day and increase activity of smoldering material. The wind will also contribute to the overstory continuing to fall to the ground creating new ground fuels and increasing activity. Any interior islands will have the potential to increase in activity.

### AIR OPERATIONS

The wind will clear the ridges early, the valley may not clear until midday.

### SAFETY

Weather is a dynamic factor in fire spread, continue to be observant of changes and how it interacts with the terrain and fuels. Have escape routes and safety zones built into your plan for the day.

# Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory

## Northern California

September 1, 2021 to September 15, 2021



**Subject:** Potential for extreme fire behavior due to critically low live and dead fuel moistures, very dry conditions resulting from persistent drought, minimal snowpack and spring precipitation, and elevated fire danger rating values across much of northern California.

**Discussion:** Fires burning in northern California are exhibiting extreme fire growth based on critical fuel conditions. Fire spread is fuel driven and does not depend on wind to spread. Events with wind have led to extreme rates of spread. Surface fuels are very receptive to embers. Long range spotting, area ignition, and group torching is occurring on large fires frequently.

**Difference from normal conditions:** Northern California is in a drought; currently with 90% at Extreme to Exceptional levels. The drought is expected to persist or intensify through out the fire season. Deficient rainfall and snowpack with early melt off has resulted in fuels that are below average in dryness, with record setting conditions for most areas.

### Concerns to Firefighters and the Public:

- Energy Release Component (ERC) at numerous weather stations set record maximums already this year and are running at or above the 97<sup>th</sup> percentile in most cases. Expect increased fire intensity and spread rates in these areas. Early season extreme fire behavior has been observed in both light and heavy fuels. **Anticipate increased spread rates, spotting, and active nighttime burning.**
- The combination of persistent drought and record-low rainfall and snowpack amounts has led to very low live and dead fuel moistures. Low 1000-hour fuel moistures have been evidenced by complete consumption of dead fuels on recent fires. Live fuel moistures in grasses, shrubs and trees, have already reached critical levels in many areas of Northern California due to limited green-up this spring. **Expect fires to ignite easier and spread faster. Do not expect fires to exhibit reduced fire behavior when entering areas of live fuels; anticipate increased spread rates and spotting.**
- Direct attack is often not feasible under regular diurnal wind conditions with ground resources. And aviation utilization is often insufficient in moderating rate of spread without immediate heavy ground resource response. **Anticipate higher resistance to control in all fuel types.**
- Already this year, Northern California has experienced large fire activity and multiple team deployments. California will likely experience an extended fire season. It is important to be mindful of and manage fatigue for all resources. **Everyone, every day, returns home safely.**

### Mitigation Measures:

- Local and inbound fire personnel need to be aware that fire behavior across the state is exceeding normal expectations for this time of the year. **Local briefings need to be thorough and highlight specific fire environment conditions. These include but are not limited to local weather forecasts, Pocket Cards, ERC's, live and dead fuel moistures.**
- Suppression actions need to be based on good anchor points, escape routes, and safety zones. **Remember LCES. Experienced lookouts are essential under these conditions.**
- Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire. **Augment initial attack resources as incident activity dictates.**

**Area of Concern:** Northern California except for the following Predictive Service Areas: North Coast and Bay Marine, west of Highway 101 in Mid-Coast to Mendocino and Diablo-Santa Cruz, and the north eastern portion of Far Eastside.

### PREVENTATIVE MEASURES TO SLOW THE TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water or clean them with alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Maintain at least six feet distance between you and people coughing or sneezing
- Avoid touching your face

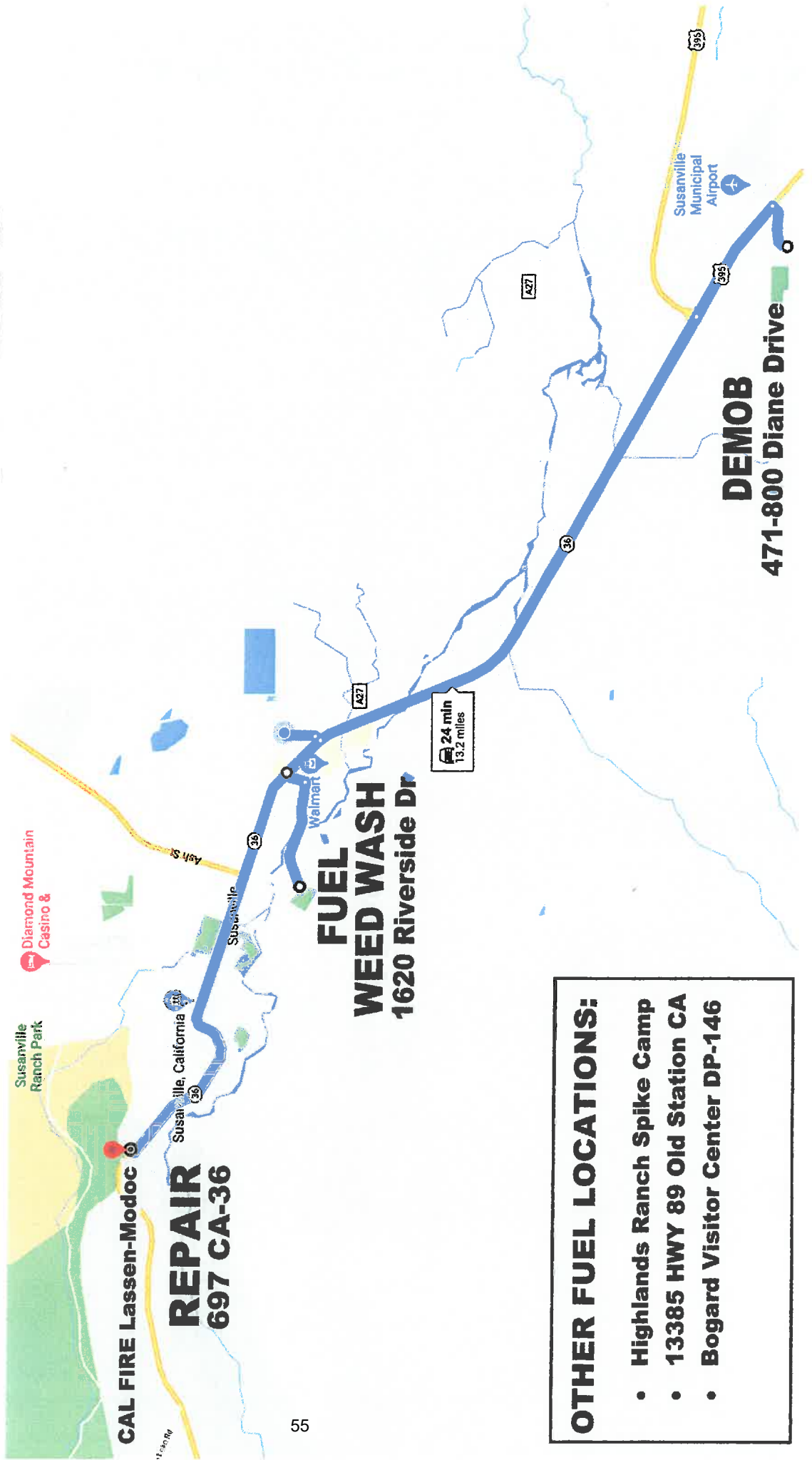

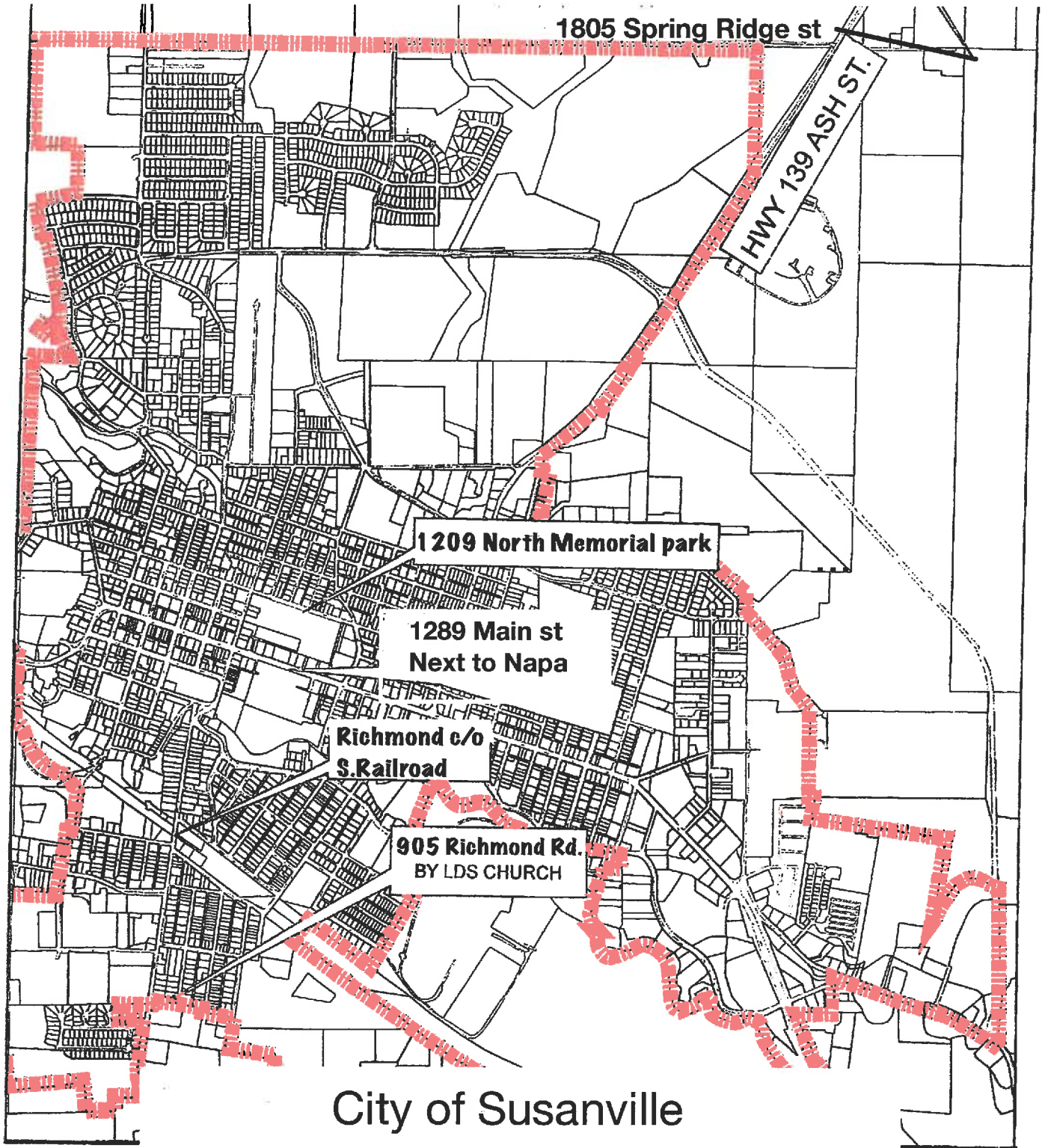




# FUEL-REPAIR-DEMOB MAP
