

WEATHER DISCUSSION: The low slowly passing to the north will continue the strong wind that will once again get into the valley bottoms and should be stronger than Monday. There will be a sudden decrease during the late night hours. Temperatures will cool, but humidity will stay about the same—very very dry.

WEATHER FORECAST:
...RED FLAG WARNING THROUGH 2300 FOR LOW HUMIDITY, GUSTY WIND...

WEATHER: Sunny, except for smoke.
TEMPERATURE: Ridge high 70 to 78. Valley high 80 to 88.
HUMIDITY: Minimum 8 to 14 percent.

20 FT WIND:

RIDGETOP – Southwest 5 to 13 mph gusts to 18 mph, by 1100 increasing to 10 to 15 mph gusts to 26 mph. By 1400, ridge wind southwest 14 to 22 mph gusts to 38 mph.
SLOPE/VALLEY – Down valley/downslope 1 to 4 mph, by 1100 becoming southwest 8 to 12 mph gusts to 20 mph. By 1400 valley wind becoming southwest 10 to 16 mph gusts to 30 mph.

HAINES INDEX: 5 Moderate. **LIGHTNING ACTIVITY LEVEL:** 1.
MIXING HEIGHT/TRANSPORT WIND: Rising to 4000 to 6000ft AGL, SW 20 mph.
STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion top around 5600ft elevation, breaking around 1100-1200.

OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT: Clear, except for smoke. **Low temperature:** Ridges 56 to 62. Valleys 46 to 54. **Maximum humidity:** Ridges 34 to 40 percent. Valleys 40 to 48 percent. **Ridge wind** southwest 10 to 18 mph gusts to 34 mph, by 2200 decreasing to 5 to 13 mph gusts to 18 mph. By 0200, ridge wind becoming south to west 2 to 6 mph. **Valley wind** southwest 4 to 10 mph gusts to 18 mph, by 2300 becoming down valley/downslope 1 to 5 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Inversion top around 5700ft elevation/E 3 mph.

OUTLOOK FOR WEDNESDAY: Sunny, except for smoke. **High temperature:** Ridges 66 to 74. Valleys 75 to 83. **Minimum humidity:** 10 to 16 percent. **Ridge wind** variable up to 4 mph, by 1300 becoming southwest 4 to 10 mph gusts to 18 mph. By 1700 ridge wind becoming southwest 8 to 14 mph gusts to 26 mph. **Valley wind** down valley/downslope 1 to 5 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 5 to 11 mph gusts to 20 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** 5500 to 7500ft AGL/SW 10 mph.

EXTENDED FORECAST: **Wed Night - Fri:** Clear/sunny. Lows 46 to 56. Highs 67 to 81. Slightly higher humidity. Afternoon ridge wind west southwest 5 to 11 mph gusts to 20 mph on Thu, 8 to 16 mph gusts to 27 mph Fri. **Fri night/Sat:** Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 48 to 58. High 70 to 84. Little change in humidity. Afternoon ridge wind west southwest 10 to 16 mph gusts to 28 mph.

WEATHER SUMMARY

Hot and dry conditions persist, ridgetop winds gusting to 38 mph from the SW by 1400.

Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. All fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

General: Active to extreme fire behavior expected again today, flanking, group torching, crown runs and potential for 0.5-1.5-mile spotting. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. Haines of 5 increases the potential for transition to a plume dominated fire in areas of heavy timber.

DIV NN/OO/PP: Minimal fire activity continues to provide good opportunity for mop-up.

DIV UU/Genesee Group: Backing, flanking and single tree torching. Although the fire north of the Devils Punch Bowl has been relatively inactive it still had potential to grow.

Valley Group: Expect minimal fire activity.

DIV RR: The fire will continue to burn along Grizzly and Turner Ridges. Expect extreme fire behavior. Flanking, uphill runs, torching, and long-range spotting. Increased probability of plume development.

QQ/Davis Group: Fire will continue to burn along Turner Ridge and towards McReynolds(FSR 25N05) and Bagley Spur roads. The Walker Fire scar is expected to limit fire spread to the north. As the fire moves into lighter fuels expect rapid rates of spread.

DIV WW/XX: Minimal fire activity.

Night Ops: Higher gusty winds and poor RH recovery. The fire is expected to remain active overnight. Flanking, uphill runs, torching and the potential for short range spotting remains.

AIR OPERATIONS: Higher winds should clear smoke out of most of the fire area however, heavy smoke is expected downwind of the main fire front.

SAFETY:

Today is a good day to review indicators of extreme fire behavior, the 18 Watch Out Situations, and the 10 Standard Firefighting Orders *prior* to engaging – consider the consequences of your actions.

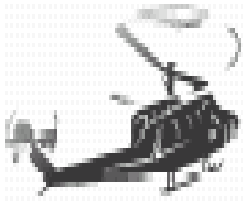

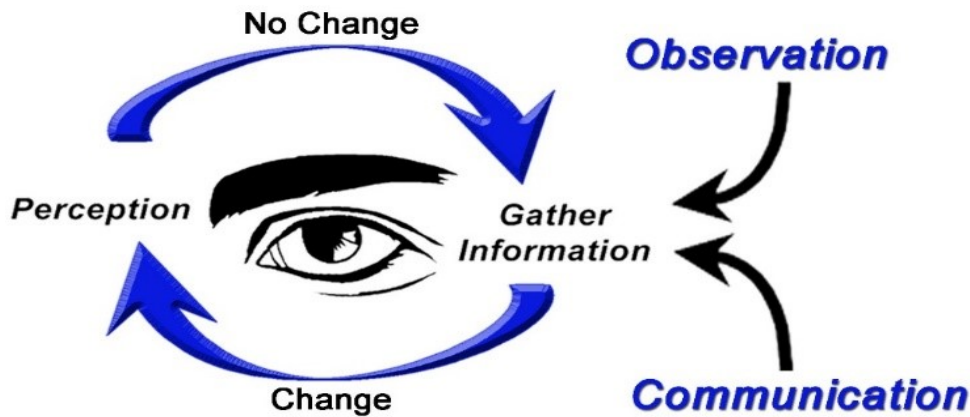

Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

Water Drafting Sites

- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice “Leave No Trace” as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.
