LEADER'S INTENT:

Incident responders have a **DUTY** to safeguard each other and the public we serve from hazards. It is through **RESPECT** for everyone's health and safety that we follow these mitigations identified below. We rely on everyone's **Mutual INTEGRITY** to ensure compliance for the sake of our health and success in our mission.

COVID-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for individuals, regardless of vaccination status, includes:

- Face coverings: Masks are to be worn in any enclosed incident facility (tent, yurt, building, vehicle) or common use area regardless of proximity to others. Masks need to cover the nose and mouth securely. Exceptions are a person alone in an enclosed space; outdoors and able to maintain a minimum distance of six feet; or actively engaged in firefighting.
- The **Module as One concept** should be used by crews and modules to the extent practical. This reduces potential exposure to Covid-19 from outside resources and the public.
- All incident personnel are expected to conduct self-screening of their health on a daily basis. Anyone experiencing sickness / illness should contact their supervisor and see MEDL, Frontline or Covid coordinator personnel for assessment.
- Great Basin Team 1 has a zero tolerance policy for bullying, sexual harassment, illegal drug and alcohol use.

3. Objective(s):
Strategic Objectives:
 Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics Implemented on the incident are to be prioritized utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principle. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

Leaders Intent:
 Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct timely/effective communications.
- Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely, and defensively while implementing tactics that offer a high probability of success.
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines.
- Ensure all personnel have been briefed in operational strategies and tactics.

Management Objectives:

- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
- Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
- Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
- Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, CALFIRE Team 1, as well as the public.
- Utilize social media and all other communication tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

Control Objectives:


- Keep the fire north of Grizzly Ridge and Davis Lake.
- Keep the fire south of Harvey Valley Road.
- Keep the fire east of Ponderosa Way and within established control lines.
- Keep the fire west of Highway 395 while ensuring infrastructure defense in the communities of Janesville and Milford.

4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:
 Utilize IRPG checklists to support management decision making. Provide clear concise directions, ask clarifying questions.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: The low pressure that brought the wind the last two days will continue and eastward track and will slowly have less effect on the incident area. The cooler temperatures will allow a slight humidity increase, with only some locations getting below 10 percent. Wednesday and Thursday nights will be cold in spike camps as temperatures lower to near 40 degrees.

WEATHER FORECAST:
WEATHER: Sunny except for smoke.

TEMPERATURE: Ridge high 72 to 78. Valley high 77 to 85.
HUMIDITY: Ridge minimum 11 to 17 percent. Valley minimum 8 to 14 percent.

20 FT WIND:
RIDGETOP – South to southwest 3 to 8 mph gusts to 11 mph, by 1300 becoming southwest to west southwest 10 to 16 mph gusts to 28 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Down valley/downslope 2 to 7 mph gusts to 10 mph, by 1300 becoming southwest to west southwest 7 to 13 mph gusts to 22 mph.

HAINES INDEX: 5 Moderate. LIGHTNING ACTIVITY LEVEL: 1.
MIXING HEIGHT/TRANSPORT WIND: Rising to 4200 to 6200ft AGL, SW 11 mph.
STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion top near 5600ft elevation, breaking between 1100 and 1200.

OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT: Clear except for smoke. **Low temperature:** Ridges 54 to 62. Valleys 40 to 54. **Maximum humidity:** Ridges 23 to 31 percent. Valleys 32 to 42 percent. **Ridge wind** southwest to west southwest 8 to 16 mph gusts to 24 mph, by 0100 becoming south to west 2 to 10 mph. **Valley wind** west southwest 2 to 8 mph, by 2100 becoming downslope/down valley 1 to 4 mph. **Haines Index** 5 Moderate. **LAL:** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Inversion top around 5700ft elevation, Variable to 3 mph.

OUTLOOK FOR THURSDAY: Sunny, except for smoke. **High temperature:** Ridges 71 to 77. Valleys 76 to 84. **Minimum humidity:** Ridges 12 to 18 percent. Valleys 10 to 16 percent. **Ridge wind** south to southwest 2 to 10 mph gusts to 15 mph, by 1300 becoming west southwest 8 to 15 mph gusts to 26 mph. **Valley wind** down valley/downslope 1 to 4 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 6 to 12 mph gusts to 20 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL:** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** 4600 to 6600ft AGL, SW 12 mph.

EXTENDED FORECAST: Clear/Sunny. No precipitation expected. **Thu Night/Fri:** Low 44 to 56. High 76 to 86. Lower humidity. Afternoon ridge wind west 6 to 12 mph gusts to 20 mph. **Fri night/Sat:** Low 48 to 60. High 78 to 88. Little change in humidity. Afternoon ridge wind west 8 to 14 mph gusts to 24 mph. **Sat night/Sun:** Low 50 to 62. High 82 to 92. Lower humidity. Afternoon ridge wind west southwest 10 to 16 mph gusts to 28 mph.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY

Hot, dry and windy conditions persist, ridgetop winds gusting to 28 mph from the WSW by 1300.

Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. Fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

General: Active to extreme fire behavior expected yet again today, flanking, group torching, crown runs and potential for 0.5-1-mile spotting. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. Haines of 5 increases the potential for transition to a plume dominated fire in areas of heavy timber. In several areas of the fire needle drop is starting to occur creating some potential for reburn.

DIV NN: Overall, minimal activity expected. As needles drop on hot spots expect potential for reburn.

DIV PP: Slight wind shift to the WSW today. The fire will continue to burn towards FSR 176 and FSR 177. The Walker Fire scar continues to limit fire spread to the north. Expect rapid rates of spread in lighter fuels. In the western half of the Division minimal fire activity continues to provide good opportunity for mop-up.

DIV UU/Genesee Group: Backing, flanking, single tree torching and reburn of any needle drop is expected. The fire north of the Devils Punch Bowl continues to have potential to grow. Interior pockets of unburned fuels will continue to burn together.

DIV RR: The fire continues to burn actively along Grizzly Ridge; however, winds remain favorable. Flanking, uphill runs, and torching.

QQ/Davis Group: Winds are expected to be out of the WSW today. The fire will continue to burn along Turner Ridge and towards FSR 177. As the fire moves into lighter fuels expect rapid rates of spread. In areas of heavier timber, the potential for long range spotting increases.

DIV WW/XX: Minimal fire activity.

Night Ops: High winds and poor RH recovery continue, resulting in the fire remaining active overnight. Flanking, uphill runs, torching and the potential for short range spotting remains.

AIR OPERATIONS: High winds should clear smoke out of most of the fire area however, heavy smoke is still expected downwind of the main fire front.

SAFETY:

New acres, new fuel influences, new spot fires, new folks, new supervisors, new travel routes...lots of new stuff – same old fire, same old hazards. Ensure LCES is in place and the Standard Firefighting Orders are communicated and understood.



Reporting of Cultural Sites

- Grab a GPS point, bump it up the chain of command or directly inform a Resource Advisor on the line or in camp.

Stay Out!

- **READs will be using flagging for areas to avoid suppression activities. Strip of red/black flagging.**
- **Pay attention to the avoidance areas marked on the map.**
- For more information, please consult with a READ.



Do not disturb cultural resources.

Leave what you find for others to enjoy.

TRASH/FOOD & WILDLIFE

- Be professional, pick up your trash and that of others, you can get trash bags from supply.
- Throwing away and storing food in proper containers can keep wildlife off the line which prevents encounters with firefighters as well as future harm to the animals.

Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

Water Drafting Sites

- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice “Leave No Trace” as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.
