

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Very dry conditions continue over the region with poor to moderate mid slope recoveries this morning with relative humidity dropping to critical levels this afternoon, despite slightly cooler temperatures. Light drainage winds this morning will transition into a more typical southwest wind this afternoon. Although lighter winds overall are expected, wind gusts from the southwest along ridgetops could still reach around 20 mph, especially across the Janesville branch area and to the southeast along US-395.



**EXTENDED OUTLOOK:** Friday through Tuesday. Light, terrain driven winds are expected Friday before more broad southwest winds, albeit light, return for the weekend. Conditions overall will remain very dry with critically low relative humidity values during the day and poor to moderate mid-slope recoveries until early next week. A few clouds could return Monday with slight chances for showers and isolated thunderstorms returning Tuesday, but the chance of a wetting rain remains low.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY:

The weather will continue to be warm and dry, with high winds. Temperatures will be 70-84 degrees during the day and 36-52 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 9-16 percent during the day and 35-70 percent overnight. The wind will be southwest 7-13 mph with gust to 20 mph in the afternoon. Overnight the winds will be southwest 10 mph with gust to 18 mph. Winds will weaken through the night, and transition to west at 5 mph.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

##### GENERAL: \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\*

The weather will cool again slightly today, however the humidity will continue to be dry with the airmass we have overhead. This will continue to allow for limited recovery in the higher elevations. This will increase the consumption of the burning materials. The fuels and burning conditions will continue to support short range spotting when there is torching near the lines. Fuels will continue to be extremely receptive to ember brands, contributing to spots across the control lines. Interior islands will continue to burn out during the heat of the day. As the winds weaken, they will be more terrain driven which will allow for multiple wind directions in any given area.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Lassen/Shasta Sector:** The wind will continue to create spotting issues, specifically in Branch 16. The transport winds will continue to move the column to the northeast. The fuels along the highway are more spaced with shorter brush which should reduce the amount of fire in the crown. The area to the west has open meadows with light fuel loading more conducive for control efforts. Branch 9 will see little growth as the fuels in the Reading Fire area need higher winds to support fire spread.

**Butte Sector:** The wind will not have as much impact in the area but will be stronger than in the previous days. Interior torching could see longer transports of fire brands. The stronger wind will also contribute to more overstory falling to the ground creating more potential for active fire.

**Janesville Branch:** The winds will continue to be strong on top of the ridge and filter down to the valley in the late afternoon and early evening. The winds will align with several drainages and allow for faster fire progression down slope. The winds in the area be very erratic and will create fire whirls and safety concerns

**Clear/Lake Branch:** The air should start to clear out throughout the day and increase activity of smoldering material. The wind will also contribute to the overstory continuing to fall to the ground creating new ground fuels and increasing activity. Any interior islands will have the potential to increase in activity.

### AIR OPERATIONS

The smoke may settle into some of the deeper valleys but should clear early.


### SAFETY

Snags will continue to create problems, continue to evaluate the area you are working, especially before sunset. The 395 corridor has several examples of erratic fire behavior as it comes down the ridge, continue to pay attention to the wind patterns and how the fire is reacting. Remember the Eagle Fire of 1989 and Beckwourth 2021





### PERSONNEL WITH COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

- Symptoms per CDPH current guidelines include the following:
  - Cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath
  - Sore throat, new loss of taste or smell
- Incident Base of Fire Line
  - Maintain appropriate face covering
  - Notify supervisor and proceed to CALMAT
  - Isolate and assess patient
  - Medical direction to test, return patient to home unit/agency for further testing

### CONTACTED OR EXPOSED PERSONNEL AND ASYMPTOMATIC

- Notify supervisor
- Maintain appropriate face covering
- Self-monitor for symptoms

### PREVENTATIVE MEASURES TO SLOW THE TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water or clean them with alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Maintain at least six feet distance between you and people coughing or sneezing
- Avoid touching your face
- Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing
- Stay home if you feel unwell
- Refrain from smoking and other activities that weaken the lungs
- Practice physical distancing by avoid unnecessary travel and staying away from large groups of people






# FUEL-REPAIR-DEMOB MAP
