LEADER'S INTENT:

Incident responders have a **DUTY** to safeguard each other and the public we serve from hazards. It is through **RESPECT** for everyone's health and safety that we follow these mitigations identified below. We rely on everyone's **Mutual INTEGRITY** to ensure compliance for the sake of our health and success in our mission.

COVID-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for individuals, regardless of vaccination status, includes:

- Face coverings: Masks are to be worn in any enclosed incident facility (tent, yurt, building, vehicle) or common use area regardless of proximity to others. Masks need to cover the nose and mouth securely. Exceptions are a person alone in an enclosed space; outdoors and able to maintain a minimum distance of six feet; or actively engaged in firefighting.
- The **Module as One concept** should be used by crews and modules to the extent practical. This reduces potential exposure to Covid-19 from outside resources and the public.
- All incident personnel are expected to conduct self-screening of their health on a daily basis. Anyone experiencing sickness / illness should contact their supervisor and see MEDL, Frontline or Covid coordinator personnel for assessment.
- Great Basin Team 1 has a zero tolerance policy for bullying, sexual harassment, illegal drug and alcohol use.



WEATHER DISCUSSION: As low pressure moves away from the west coast, it will lose its influence as a second low pressure moves into the eastern Pacific, wind will shift tonight to a more northerly direction, not seen on the incident in a while. Temperatures will be at their coolest for the week, with warming and drying taking over on Friday.

WEATHER FORECAST:

WEATHER: Sunny, except for smoke.

TEMPERATURE: Ridge high 70 to 78. Valley high 74 to 82.

HUMIDITY: Minimum 11 to 17 percent.

20 FT WIND:

RIDGETOP – Southwest to west southwest 4 to 10 mph gusts to 14 mph, by 1300 becoming west southwest to west 7 to 13 mph gusts to 22 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Down valley/downslope 1 to 4 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 5 to 11 mph gusts to 20 mph.

HAINES INDEX: 4 Low.

LIGHTNING ACTIVITY LEVEL: 1.

MIXING HEIGHT/TRANSPORT WIND: Rising to 4200 to 6200ft AGL, WSW 10 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion top near 5700ft elevation, breaking 1200-1300 PDT.

OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT: Clear except for smoke. **Low temperature:** Ridges 48 to 56. Valleys 38 to 48. **Maximum humidity:** Ridges 29 to 35 percent. Valleys 52 to 60 percent. **Ridge wind** west southwest to west 7 to 14 mph gusts to 24 mph, by 2100 becoming west to northwest 4 to 11 mph gusts to 15 mph. By 0200 ridge wind becoming north to northeast 3 to 11 mph gusts to 14 mph. **Valley wind** up valley/upslope 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph, becoming downslope/down valley 2 to 5 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Inversion top developing near 5800ft elevation, ENE 7mph.

OUTLOOK FOR FRIDAY: Sunny except for smoke. **High temperature:** Ridges 74 to 81. Valleys 79 to 87. **Minimum humidity:** 8 to 13 percent. **Ridge wind** east 6 to 12 mph gusts to 18 mph, by 1400 becoming variable up to 5 mph. **Valley wind** down valley/downslope 2 to 6 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** rising to 6800 to 8800ft AGL, S 4 mph.

EXTENDED FORECAST: Clear/Sunny. No precipitation expected. **Fri Night/Sat:** Low 42 to 56. High 77 to 89. Little change in humidity. Afternoon ridge wind west 10 to 16 mph gusts to 28 mph. **Sat night/Sun:** Low 45 to 59. High 80 to 92. Afternoon ridge wind west southwest 10 to 15 mph gusts to 26 mph. **Sun night/Mon:** Low 48 to 62. High 81 to 93. Afternoon ridge wind west southwest 10 to 15 mph gusts to 26 mph.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY

Hot, dry and windy conditions persist, ridgetop winds gusting to 22 mph from the WSW to W by 1300.

Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. Fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

General: Active to extreme fire behavior expected yet again today, flanking, group torching, crown runs and potential for 0.5-1-mile spotting. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. Expect rapid rates of spread in lighter fuels. In several areas of the fire needle drop is starting to occur creating some potential for reburn.

DIV NN: Minimal activity continues to provide good opportunity for mop-up. As needles drop on hot spots expect potential for reburn.

DIV PP: Winds will be even more westerly today. The fire will continue to burn towards Hwy 395 and the Beckwourth fire scar. The Walker Fire scar continues to limit fire spread to the north. Expect rapid rates of spread in lighter fuels. In the western half of the Division minimal fire activity expected.

QQ/Davis Group: Winds will be even more westerly today. The fire will continue to burn along Turner Ridge and towards FSR 177. As the fire moves into lighter fuels expect rapid rates of spread. In areas of heavier timber, the potential for long range spotting increases.

DIV RR: The fire continues to burn actively along Grizzly Ridge; however, winds remain favorable during the day.

DIV UU/Genesee Group: Backing, flanking, single tree torching and reburn of any needle drop is expected. The fire north of the Devils Punch Bowl continues to flank to the west. Interior pockets of unburned fuels will continue to burn together.

DIV WW/XX: Overall, minimal fire activity expected. As needles drop on hot spots there is potential for reburn.

Night Ops: High winds and poor RH recovery continue, resulting in the fire remaining active overnight. Winds are expected to shift to a northerly component by 0200 which will pressure the entire southern perimeter. This shift will also influence the fire north of the Devils Punch Bowl. Flanking, uphill runs, torching and the potential for short range spotting remains.

AIR OPERATIONS: WSW winds should clear smoke out of most of the fire area however, heavy smoke is still expected downwind of the main fire front.

SAFETY:

Anticipate fire behavior before you observe it, anticipate your actions before need to act. Remember fine fuels + wind = rapid rates of spread; timber litter + wind = high intensity fire with torching and spotting.

COVID-19 MESSAGE

- Covid-19 is transmitted primarily by respiratory droplets or mucous. When not wearing a mask, coughs, sneezes, speaking and laughing create considerable unseen droplets in the air that can harbor the virus. It is by inhaling or having the droplets settle in the mucous membranes of the nose or eyes that are the primary means of spread.
- The chances of spread via air droplets can be reduced in the outdoors depending on wind and humidity. However, smoke poses an increased risk of infection. Exposure to smoke irritates the airway and lungs, changing the body's immune response, and can result in more severe illness in persons infected by COVID-19.
- Virus particles on surfaces are far less likely to cause infection unless a person is in a confined space and in immediate contact with an infected person for an extended period of time. Outdoors, the virus cannot survive very long on surfaces due to sun exposure, air currents and changing humidity levels.

Basic measures – wearing masks, social distancing, frequent hand washing and cleaning surfaces shared by others (tables, computers, etc.) - reduces everyone's risk of infection.

RESOURCE ADVISOR MESSAGE

Reporting of Cultural Sites

- Grab a GPS point, bump it up the chain of command or directly inform a Resource Advisor on the line or in camp.

Stay Out!

- **READs will be using flagging for areas to avoid suppression activities. Strip of red/black flagging.**
- **Pay attention to the avoidance areas marked on the map.**
- For more information, please consult with a READ.



Do not disturb cultural resources.

Leave what you find for others to enjoy.

TRASH/FOOD & WILDLIFE

- Be professional, pick up your trash and that of others, you can get trash bags from supply.
- Throwing away and storing food in proper containers can keep wildlife off the line which prevents encounters with firefighters as well as future harm to the animals.

Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

Water Drafting Sites

- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice “Leave No Trace” as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.
