## **3. Objective(s):**

### **Strategic Objective**

Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritize utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principal. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

### **Leaders Intent**

Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take the appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct timely / effective communications
- Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely and defensively Implementation of tactics that offer a high probability of success
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines
- All line supervision personnel including crew and striketeam leaders must attend the morning Operational Briefing

### **Management Objectives**

- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
- Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
- Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
- Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, Great Basin Team 1 as well as the public.
- Utilize social media and all other communications tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

### **Control Objectives**

- Keep the fire north of Grizzly Ridge and Lake Davis
- Keep the fire south of Harvey Valley Road
- Keep the fire east of Ponderosa Way and within established control lines
- Keep the fire west of the eastern Lassen County line while ensuring infrastructure defense in the communities of Janesville, Milford and Herlong

### **General Situational Awareness**

Steep and rugged terrain, critically dry and receptive fuel beds, active area for fire history and drought stressed trees.

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** A light east to southeast wind is expected through much of the day with a return to a light southwest wind across the western portions of the fire area by late afternoon. Terrain driven winds for the most part are expected in valley locations. These lighter winds will allow smoke to linger across the area with poor morning visibility in many lower elevations. Very dry conditions continue over the region with poor to moderate mid slope recoveries this morning with relative humidity dropping to critical levels this afternoon, with warmer temperatures expected as well.

## TODAY:

**SKY/WEATHER:** Dense smoke in some locations in the morning. Haze continuing this afternoon.

**CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS:** 0%      **LAL:** 1.

**WINDS:** **Valleys:** Downslope 2-4 mph in the morning. Upslope/upvalley 3-6 mph in the afternoon.

**Ridgetops:** East-southeast 5-10 mph in the morning, a west wind 5-10 mph developing across the western portions of the fire area.

**HAINES:** 4 (low)

**MIXING HEIGHT:** Rising to 8,900 feet by 1700.

**TRANSPORT WIND:** Variable 5 mph in the morning, Southwest around 5 mph in the afternoon.

**VISIBILITY:** One mile in valleys in the morning gradually increasing to 5-7 miles in the afternoon.

**INVERSION:** Inversion lifting between 1230 and 1330. Poor ventilation through the day.

**WINDS:** **Valleys:** Downslope/down valley 2-4 mph developing after 2000.

**Ridgetops:** Light and variable through midnight, becoming southwest at 5-9 mph after midnight.

**TRANSPORT WIND:** Light winds.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Developing inversion, poor ventilation through the night.

**EXTENDED OUTLOOK:** Saturday through Wednesday. A typical light southwest afternoon wind will return for the weekend with downslope winds each night. Conditions overall will remain very dry with critically low relative humidity values during the day and poor to moderate mid-slope recoveries until early next week. Temperatures will rise through the weekend as a high pressure system builds over the region. A few clouds could return Monday with slight chances for showers and isolated thunderstorms returning Tuesday and Wednesday, but the chance of a wetting rain remains very low.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY:

Today will be the last cooler day as it begins to heat up the rest of the week. The relative humidity will remain low, and the winds will be more terrain driven than the past several days. Temperatures will be 73-87 degrees during the day and 39-55 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 10-17 percent during the day and 35-70 percent overnight. The wind will be east-southeast or west 5-10 mph with gust to 20 mph in the afternoon, depending on which portion of the fire you are on. Overnight the winds will be light and variable through midnight, turning southwest 5-9 mph.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

##### GENERAL: \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\*

The humidity will remain low today, combined with the dry fuels, will contribute to the potential for spot fires to be a concern on all portions of the fire. The winds will be more terrain driven cause adverse winds in more portions of the fire. The winds will have effects on areas which have been sheltered over the past several days, which could lead to some increased activity. Fire spread will be more terrain and fuels dependent. The flats will have a slower progression unless in open meadows or open stands of timber and brush. The smoke will linger longer over the fire to start the day and settle in faster in the evening, shading the fire, and decreasing fire activity. Spotting distances will be short range.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Lassen/Shasta Sector:** The winds will be more variable with the varied terrain, expect battling winds in the afternoon. The smoke will hold over the fire longer shading the fuels, which will limit the solar heating and reduce the fire activity until the afternoon, when there should be more clearing. The fire activity will be ground fire with isolated torching, until wind and slope align, which could present in short crown runs in the thicker timber.

**Butte Sector:** The heavy materials will continue to burn out, and interior islands will continue to burn with low intensity. Stumps will continue to hold heat as the root systems continue to burn and may create new fires when the overstory falls to the ground.

**Janesville Branch:** The winds will be light and coming from the opposite direction than the past several days. There will be a more southeast to east component to the wind which slow the progression on portions of the slope. The fire on top of the ridge will progress more towards the Janesville spot, with the change in winds.

**Clear/Lake Branch:** The air should start to clear out throughout the day and increase activity of smoldering material. The wind will also contribute to the overstory continuing to fall to the ground creating new ground fuels and increasing activity. Any interior islands will have the potential to increase in activity.

### AIR OPERATIONS


The smoke will be in the fire area longer and may limit operations throughout the day.

The weather will be changing but do be lured into a false sense of security, the fire still has the potential to create spot fire and active runs. Continue to be observant to your surroundings and potential hazards.



### PERSONNEL WITH COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

- **Symptoms per CDPH current guidelines include the following:**
  - Cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath
  - Sore throat, new loss of taste or smell
- **Incident Base of Fire Line**
  - Maintain appropriate face covering
  - Notify supervisor and proceed to CALMAT
  - Isolate and assess patient
  - Medical direction to test, return patient to home unit/agency for further testing

### CONTACTED OR EXPOSED PERSONNEL AND ASYMPTOMATIC

- Notify supervisor
- Maintain appropriate face covering
- Self-monitor for symptoms

### PREVENTATIVE MEASURES TO SLOW THE TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water or clean them with alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Maintain at least six feet distance between you and people coughing or sneezing
- Avoid touching your face
- Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing
- Stay home if you feel unwell
- Refrain from smoking and other activities that weaken the lungs
- Practice physical distancing by avoid unnecessary travel and staying away from large groups of people



# FUEL-REPAIR-DEMOB MAP


