## LEADER'S INTENT:

Incident responders have a **DUTY** to safeguard each other and the public we serve from hazards. It is through **RESPECT** for everyone's health and safety that we follow these mitigations identified below. We rely on everyone's **Mutual INTEGRITY** to ensure compliance for the sake of our health and success in our mission.

COVID-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for individuals, regardless of vaccination status, includes: Face coverings: Masks are to be worn in any enclosed incident facility (tent, yurt, building, and vehicle) or common use area regardless of proximity to others. Masks need to cover the nose and mouth securely. Exceptions are a person alone in an enclosed space; outdoors and able to maintain a minimum distance of six feet; or actively engaged in firefighting.



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**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Low pressure moving through the Pacific Northwest will create a changing wind all day, along with weakening wind during the afternoon. Wind shifts on ridges should go clockwise around the compass. Warming and drying also return.

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**WEATHER FORECAST:**

**WEATHER:** Sunny except for smoke, likely worse than it has been for a while.

**TEMPERATURE:** Ridge high 70 to 78. Valley high 76 to 86.

**HUMIDITY:** Minimum 9 to 15 percent.

**20 FT WIND:**

**RIDGETOP** – E 6 to 14 mph gusts to 20 mph, by 1100 becoming E to ENE 4 to 10 mph gusts to 16 mph. By 1600 ridge wind becoming WNW to NE 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph.

**Upper PP Division** E 8 to 12 mph gusts to 20 mph, by 1000 becoming E to NE 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Down valley/downslope 2 to 7 mph gusts to 10 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph. **Upper PP Division** NW 1-3 mph, by 1000 becoming E to NE 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph.

**HAINES INDEX:** 4 Low.

**LIGHTNING ACTIVITY LEVEL:** 1.

**MIXING HEIGHT/TRANSPORT WIND:** Rising to 7100-9100ft AGL, SE 11 mph.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Inversion top near 5800ft elevation, breaking 1300-1400.

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**OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT:** Clear except for smoke. **Low temperature:** Ridges 50 to 60. Valleys 41 to 49, except high elevation basins 34 to 40. **Maximum humidity:** Ridges 24 to 32 percent. Valleys 39 to 49 percent. **Ridge wind** W to NW 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph, by 2200 becoming variable up to 6 mph. By 0300 ridge wind becoming E to SE 5 to 11 mph gusts to 16 mph. **Upper PP Division** NE 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph, by 0200 becoming SE 2 to 6 mph. **Valley wind** up valley/upslope 2 to 5 mph, becoming downslope/down valley 1 to 4 mph. **Upper PP Division** NW 1-4 mph. **Haines Index** 3 Very Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Inversion top near 5900ft elevation, ENE 7 mph.

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**OUTLOOK FOR SATURDAY:** Clear except for smoke. **High temperature:** Ridges 72 to 80. Valleys 79 to 89. **Minimum humidity:** 9 to 16 percent. **Ridge wind** E to SE 4 to 10 mph gusts to 14 mph, by 1200 becoming SW to S 2 to 5 mph. By 1600, ridge wind becoming W to N 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph. **Upper PP Division** ESE 1 to 5 mph, by 1600 becoming NE 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph. **Valley wind** down valley/downslope 1 to 5 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 4 to 8 mph gusts to 14 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Rising to 7400-9400ft AGL. SSW 10 mph.

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**EXTENDED FORECAST:** **Sat Night/Sun:** Clear/Sunny. Low 46 to 60. High 77 to 91. Lower humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW to WSW 8 to 14 mph gusts to 26 mph. **Sun night/Mon:** Clear/Sunny. Low 48 to 62. High 80 to 93. Higher humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 10 to 16 mph gusts to 30 mph. **Mon night/Tue:** Partly cloudy. A slight chance of dry thunderstorms Tue afternoon. Low 52 to 64. High 77 to 90. Higher afternoon humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 14 to 24 mph gusts to 38 mph.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY

Hot, dry and windy conditions persist, winds mainly out of the east until 1600, then variable. Gusts up to 20 mph.

#### Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. Fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**General:** Active to extreme fire behavior expected, flanking, group torching, crown runs and potential for 0.25-0.5-mile spotting. For most of the day winds will be easterly, however by 1600 winds will be variable, pressuring different parts of the line. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain, expect uphill runs. Expect rapid rates of spread in lighter fuels. In several areas of the fire, needle drop is starting to occur creating potential for reburn.

**DIV NN:** Minimal activity continues to provide good opportunity for mop-up. Needle cast continues to drop on hot spots creating potential for reburn.

**DIV PP:** The change in winds today will push the fire to the south and southwest for most of the day. At about 1600 winds will vary, increasing the potential for fire to burn ESE to SW. Battling winds increase potential for spotting. Rapid rates of spread in grass/brush fuels.

**QQ/Davis Group:** Early in the day winds will be favorable. As the day progresses winds will shift multiple times increasing spotting potential. Also due to the shifting winds the fire north of FSR 01 and west of 177 has the potential to impact the Division.

**DIV RR:** Expect moderate fire behavior along Grizzly Ridge. Spotting across the line is possible today due to shift in winds.

**DIV UU/Genesee Group:** Interior pockets of unburned fuels will continue to burn together. Backing, flanking, single tree torching and reburn of any needle drop is expected. The fire north of the Devils Punch Bowl has potential to increase in activity due to the change of winds. Increased spotting potential.

**DIV WW/XX:** Overall, minimal fire activity expected. As needles drop on hot spots there is potential for reburn.

**Night Ops:** Moderate to active fire behavior expected. Winds are to be variable again tonight. This variability will also influence the fire north of the Devils Punch Bowl. Flanking, uphill runs, torching and the potential for short range spotting remains.

**AIR OPERATIONS:** Easterly winds for most of day will push smoke back into the main fires edge.

### SAFETY:

**Watch out Situation #15: Wind increases and/or changes direction. Wind is expected to shift directions several times today. Think about the implications that this could have on your mission, fire spread, fire-weakened trees and visibility.**

## TRASH/FOOD & WILDLIFE

- Be professional, pick up your trash and that of others, you can get trash bags from supply.
- Throwing away and storing food in proper containers can keep wildlife off the line which prevents encounters with firefighters as well as future harm to the animals.

## Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

## Water Drafting Sites

- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

## Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice “Leave No Trace” as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.
