

Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.</p> <p><b>Leaders Intent</b></p> <p>Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. ### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY:

The temperatures will continue to rise through the weekend. The relative humidity will remain low, and the winds will return to a general southwest flow. Temperatures will be 75-89 degrees during the day and 39-57 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 10-17 percent during the day and 35-65 percent overnight. The wind will be west-southwest 6-10 mph with gust to 18 mph in the afternoon. Overnight winds will be southwest 4-6 mph, becoming light and variable after midnight.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

##### GENERAL: \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\*

The inversion will begin to set in stronger keeping more smoke in the fire area and decreasing humidity recovery. The shading will depend on the smoke production from the fire, which will be decreasing, especially in the northern portion of the fire. Interior islands will continue to burn out and create short range spotting if near the control lines. The portions of the fire which burned over 30 days ago are dropping needles and leaves to the ground creating a new continues fuel bed in areas without canopy consumption. These areas will continue to smoke and become active. The heavy fuel loading in areas of the fire will continue to smolder, specifically in dozer piles and log decks until they are pulled apart and moped up.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Lassen/Shasta Sector:** The wind will return to a southwest flow, it should be light enough to have little impact on the fire, especially in the valleys and the flats. The smoke will shade the Lassen Sector most of the day, with lingering smoke in all areas at the start of the operational period. The fire activity will be ground fire with isolated torching, until wind and slope align, which could present in short crown runs in the thicker timber.

**Butte Sector:** The heavy materials will continue to burn out, and interior islands will continue to burn with low intensity. Stumps will continue to hold heat as the root systems continue to burn and may create new fires when the overstory falls to the ground.

**Janesville Branch:** The wind will return to a southwest flow, however the smoke will shade the valley to the northeast. This will limit the draw down the slope. If the valley clears and warms up, you will see increased winds down the slope in the late afternoon.

**Clear/Lake Branch:** The air should start to clear out throughout the day and increase activity of smoldering material. The wind will also contribute to the overstory continuing to fall to the ground creating new ground fuels and increasing activity. Any interior islands will have the potential to increase in activity.

### AIR OPERATIONS

The smoke will be in the fire area longer and may limit operations throughout the day.

### SAFETY

The fire burned through most areas weeks ago, allowing root systems to burn and create unstable ground with hot ash. Watch your footing, especially around burned-out stump holes.

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Light downslope and drainage winds this morning will transition to a light west-southwest wind along ridgetops this afternoon with lighter terrain driven winds still in the sheltered valleys. A warming trend continues over the area with highs in the 80s in most valleys as high pressure builds over the region. Very dry conditions remain with relative humidity dropping to critical levels again this afternoon. Smoke will continue to hamper visibility mainly in the morning hours improving this afternoon.

**EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Sunday through Thursday.** High pressure building over the region will allow for increasing temperatures to above normal levels with some lower valleys reaching the 90s Sunday and Monday. A very dry air mass will remain in place resulting in critically low RH values in the afternoon and poor mid-slope recoveries. A typical west-southwest wind is expected through Monday before the weather disturbance moves into the area Tuesday. Gusty southwest winds and an outside chance for a shower or thunderstorm is expected Tuesday but the chances for a wetting rain remain very low. Relative humidity will improve slightly as this weather feature moves through northern California Tuesday and Wednesday. A breezier pattern sets up for the middle of next week with gusty southwest winds and dry conditions continuing.



### CONTACTED OR EXPOSED PERSONNEL AND ASYMPTOMATIC

- Notify supervisor
- Maintain appropriate face covering
- Self-monitor for symptoms

### PREVENTATIVE MEASURES TO SLOW THE TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water or clean them with alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Maintain at least six feet distance between you and people coughing or sneezing






# FUEL-REPAIR-DEMOB MAP
