LEADER'S INTENT:

Incident responders have a **DUTY** to safeguard each other and the public we serve from hazards. It is through **RESPECT** for everyone's health and safety that we follow these mitigations identified below. We rely on everyone's **Mutual INTEGRITY** to ensure compliance for the sake of our health and success in our mission.

COVID-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for individuals, regardless of vaccination status, includes: Face coverings: Masks are to be worn in any enclosed incident facility (tent, yurt, building, and vehicle) or common use area regardless of proximity to others. Masks need to cover the nose and mouth securely. Exceptions are a person alone in an enclosed space; outdoors and able to maintain a minimum distance of six feet; or actively engaged in firefighting.

Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.			
<u>Leaders Intent:</u> Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely, and defensively while implementing tactics that offer a high probability of success. Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines. Ensure all personnel have been briefed in operational strategies and tactics. 			
<u>Management Objectives:</u>			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public. Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first. Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area. Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, CALFIRE Team 1, as well as the public. WEATHER DISCUSSION: Weak easterly wind during the morning will be overcome by slope-valley winds in the lower elevations, with wind shifting to the west and southwest for the afternoon. The warming and drying trend continues.

WEATHER SUMMARY

Another hot and dry day with lighter winds mainly out of the south. Gusts up to 18 mph.

Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. Fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

General: Moderate to active fire behavior expected, flanking, group torching, short crown runs and potential for 0.25-0.5-mile spotting. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. Expect rapid rates of spread in lighter fuels. In several areas of the fire needle drop is creating potential for reburn.

DIV NN: Minimal activity, interior pockets continue to burn up.

DIV PP: Winds are shifting again today. Early morning, fire is expected to back into the winds. The winds are expected to be out the WSW by 1100 pushing the fire towards the Sugar fire scar. Rapid rates of spread in grass/brush fuels expected due to extremely dry fuels.

QQ/Davis Group: Early morning winds will be favorable, by 1100 they are expected to shift to the WSW putting some pressure on FSR 01. Winds favorable along Turner Ridge.

DIV RR: Expect low to moderate fire behavior along Grizzly Ridge due to favorable winds.

DIV UU/Genesee Group: Winds favorable providing good opportunities to continue securing line. Interior pockets of unburned fuels will burn together. Needle drop will still be a problem.

DIV WW/XX: Minimal fire activity expected.

Night Ops: Moderate to active fire behavior expected. Winds expected to be light however variable in direction. Backing, flanking, short uphill runs, torching and the potential for short range spotting remains.

AIR OPERATIONS: Light winds and stable air mass will likely limit air ops until 1300 or when the inversion breaks.

SAFETY:

Accurate situational awareness (SA) requires constant reassessment of conditions (existing or potential) that may impact the safety and effectiveness of tactics.



COMMUNITY HEALTH & SAFETY

As we proceed through each operational period on a fire, staying on task while maintaining situational awareness can become more of an effort. Fatigue and routine can combine to slow both our physical and mental responses and our situational awareness.

To compensate, we rely on our training and repetition. An integral part of that training is that we learn to look out for one another. This applies out on the line, in camp, and when we're in the communities we serve. In this era of COVID-19, it also extends beyond fuel types, weather, terrain and equipment.

Look to your Safety Officer, Medical Unit and COVID coordinators for any questions or concerns regarding COVID-19 or any health / safety issues.

Communicate with your supervisor and the Medical Unit promptly if you are feeling ill (or have any injury or medical issue).

Escape from illness includes frequent handwashing or use of sanitizer, maintaining social distancing and wearing a face mask. Vaccination is an important component – all three approved vaccines are available free at the ICP on Thursdays from 1800 -2000 hours.

Safety for yourself and those around you can be optimized by staying within your module and avoiding potential contact with infected persons.

RESOURCE ADVISOR MESSAGE

Reporting of Cultural Sites

- Grab a GPS point, bump it up the chain of command or directly inform a Resource Advisor on the line or in camp.

Stay Out!

- **READs will be using flagging for areas to avoid suppression activities. Strip of red/black flagging.**
- **Pay attention to the avoidance areas marked on the map.**
- For more information, please consult with a READ.



Do not disturb cultural resources.

Leave what you find for others to enjoy.

TRASH/FOOD & WILDLIFE

- Be professional, pick up your trash and that of others, you can get trash bags from supply.
- Throwing away and storing food in proper containers can keep wildlife off the line which prevents encounters with firefighters as well as future harm to the animals.

Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

Water Drafting Sites

- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice “Leave No Trace” as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.
