## LEADER'S INTENT:

Incident responders have a **DUTY** to safeguard each other and the public we serve from hazards. It is through **RESPECT** for everyone's health and safety that we follow these mitigations identified below. We rely on everyone's **Mutual INTEGRITY** to ensure compliance for the sake of our health and success in our mission.

COVID-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for individuals, regardless of vaccination status, includes: Face coverings: Masks are to be worn in any enclosed incident facility (tent, yurt, building, and vehicle) or common use area regardless of proximity to others. Masks need to cover the nose and mouth securely. Exceptions are a person alone in an enclosed space; outdoors and able to maintain a minimum distance of six feet; or actively engaged in firefighting.

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**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** High pressure will continue to keep stagnant conditions, with light wind and smoky skies with some afternoon clearing. Wind will increase Labor Day and clouds develop Monday night.

**WEATHER:** Sunny with smoke. Partial clearing in the afternoon.

**TEMPERATURE:** Ridge high 79 to 87. Valley high 85 to 93.

**HUMIDITY:** Minimum 7 to 12 percent.

**RIDGETOP** – E to SE 2 to 6 mph, by 1100 becoming SW 2 to 5 mph. By 1300 ridge wind becoming SW 4 to 10 mph gusts to 18 mph. **Escarpment wind** SE 2-7 gusts to 10 mph, 1300 becoming NW 1 to 4 mph. By 1600 escarpment wind W to NW 6 to 14 mph gusts to 23 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Down valley/downslope 1 to 4 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 3 to 10 mph gusts to 18 mph.

**HAINES INDEX:** 4 Low. **LIGHTNING ACTIVITY LEVEL:** 1.

**MIXING HEIGHT/TRANSPORT WIND:** Rising to 5200 to 7200ft AGL, SSW 13 mph.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Inversion top 5900ft, breaking around 1400.

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**OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT:** Clear with increasing smoke trapped below the inversion. **Low temperature:** Ridges 58 to 68. Valleys 44 to 56. **Maximum humidity:** Ridges 20 to 28 percent. Valleys 29 to 39 percent. **Ridge wind** WSW to WNW 6 to 14 mph gusts to 23 mph, by 0100 becoming SW to NW 2 to 7 mph. By 0400, ridge wind becoming SE to W 1 to 5 mph. **Escarpment wind** NW 8 to 14 mph gusts to 23 mph, by 0100 becoming NW 2 to 7 mph. By 0400, escarpment wind W 2 to 5 mph. **Valley wind** up valley/upslope 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph, becoming downslope/down valley 2 to 5 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Inversion top near 5900ft elevation, SSE 4 mph.

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**OUTLOOK FOR LABOR DAY:** Sunny with smoke. **High temperature:** Ridges 80 to 88. Valleys 86 to 94. **Minimum humidity:** 8 to 13 percent. **Ridge wind** SW 2 to 6 mph, by 1300 becoming SW to W 7 to 13 mph gusts to 24 mph. **Escarpment Wind** WSW 2 to 4 mph, 1500 becoming WNW 10 to 16 mph gusts to 26 mph. **Valley wind** down valley/downslope 2 to 6 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 5 to 12 mph gusts to 22 mph. **Haines Index** 3 Very Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Rising to 6200 to 8200ft AGL, SW 17 mph.

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**EXTENDED FORECAST:** **Mon Night/Tue:** Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 46 to 70. High 80 to 92. Higher humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 10 to 18 mph gusts to 34 mph. **Tue night/Wed:** Low 44 to 68. High 76 to 85. Lower humidity. Afternoon ridge wind 10 to 20 mph gusts to 36 mph. **Wed night/Thu:** Partly cloudy. Low 55 to 67. High 72 to 83. Higher humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 5 to 13 mph gusts to 24 mph.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY

Hot and dry weather persists with lighter winds mainly out of the south. Gusts up to 18 mph.

#### Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. Fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**General:** Moderate to active fire behavior expected, group torching, short crown runs and potential for 0.25-0.5-mile spotting. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. Expect rapid rates of spread in lighter fuels. In several areas of the fire needle drop is creating potential for reburn.

**DIV NN:** Minimal activity.

**DIV PP:** Winds along the escarpment light until 1600. By 1600 winds are expected to be out of the W to NW with Gusts to 23 mph potentially pushing the fire down the escarpment towards Hwy 395. South of FSR 176 winds favorable.

**DIV QQ:** Early morning winds will be favorable, by 1100 they are expected to shift to the SW increasing fire behavior and the potential for it to burn towards Dixie Valley and the Sugar Fire scar. Winds favorable along Turner Ridge.

**DIV RR:** Minimal fire activity along Grizzly Ridge due to favorable winds.

**DIV UU/Genesee Group:** Minimal activity expected in most of the Division. Potential for growth remains north of the Devils Punch Bowl.

**DIV WW/XX:** Minimal fire activity expected.

**Night Ops:** Moderate to active fire behavior expected. Winds expected to be light however variable in direction. Backing, flanking, short uphill runs, torching and the potential for short range spotting remains.

**AIR OPERATIONS:** Light winds and stable air will likely limit air ops until 1400 or when the inversion breaks.

### SAFETY:

**Fuels are critically dry, terrain is unforgiving, and fire behavior may accelerate rapidly. Anticipate fire behavior and plan your actions in advance.**

## TRASH/FOOD & WILDLIFE

- Be professional, pick up your trash and that of others, you can get trash bags from supply.
- Throwing away and storing food in proper containers can keep wildlife off the line which prevents encounters with firefighters as well as future harm to the animals.

## Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

## Water Drafting Sites

- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

## Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice “Leave No Trace” as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.
