## In Memory of US Forest Service Assistant Fire Engine Operator *MARCUS D. PACHECO*

It is with deep sorrow to inform you of the passing of US Forest Service Assistant Fire Engine Operator Marcus Pacheco. Marcus passed away on September 2, 2021 due to an illness.

Marcus has served in his current role in the Almanor Ranger District as an Assistant Fire Engine Operator and Water Tender Operator since 2017 and has served in many capacities for over 30 years with the Wildland and Structural Fire Services. He has worked for the US Forest Service since 2001 with the Plumas, Modoc and Lassen National Forests.

Prior to his work with the Forest Service, Marcus worked for CAL FIRE for 13 seasons (1988 – 2000) with the Lassen-Modoc, Butte and Almanor-Eldorado Units.



# Dixie West Zone Fire Weather Forecast

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** High pressure will continue, with today being its most influential day. As a result, high temperatures will peak today, reaching the upper 80's in higher elevations areas and low 90s in valleys. Expect mostly terrain driven winds again today. Light downslope and drainage winds this morning will transition to a light west-southwest wind along ridgetops this afternoon with lighter terrain driven winds in the sheltered valleys. Very dry conditions remain with relative humidity dropping to critical levels again this afternoon. Heavy smoke will continue to hamper visibility throughout the day as it is trapped under this high pressure.

**TODAY:**

**SKY/WEATHER:** Heavy smoke throughout the day. Some lifting of smoke will occur this afternoon.

**MAX TEMP: Valleys: 87-94°      MIN HUMIDITY: Valleys: 08-12%**  
**Ridgetops: 84-88°                      Ridgetops: 08-12%**

**CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS: 0%      LAL: 1.**

**WINDS: Valleys:** Downslope 2-4 mph in the morning. Upslope/upvalley 4-8 mph in the afternoon.

**TRANSPORT WIND:** Light winds.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Developing inversion, poor to no ventilation through the night.

**EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Monday through Saturday:** High pressure will bring temperatures with some lower valleys reaching the 90s Monday along with a very dry air mass remaining in place, resulting in critically low afternoon minimum RH values and poor to moderate mid-slope recoveries through Tuesday. Temperatures will begin to decrease slightly Tuesday into the mid 80s. Light west to southwest wind is expected until a weather disturbance moves into the area Tuesday, when a more active weather pattern is possible starting midweek with increasing gusty winds. An increase in moisture is possible late in the week

### INPUTS

#### **WEATHER SUMMARY:**

This will be the strongest day of the high pressure over the incident. The relative humidity will remain low, and high temperatures. Temperatures will be 84-94 degrees during the day and 35-55 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 8-12 percent during the day and 20-35 percent overnight. The wind will be southwest 5-10 mph with gust to 15 mph in the afternoon. Overnight winds will be southwest 4-8 mph, becoming light and variable after midnight.

### OUTPUTS

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

**GENERAL: \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\***

The weather combined with the dry fuels will continue to promote fire spread and spotting. The fire will continue to progress in the understory with the potential for crown run in heavier timber. The limited humidity recovery will increase the burning period into the night. The smoke will provide some shading in the morning and remain in the area until the winds can move it out. Spotting will be seen in the timber with short to potential mid-range. Column development will determine the spotting distance. The fire activity will increase in the afternoon when the smoke clears, and sun reaches the fuels. The fire will increase rates of spread as it transitions from timber to brush. The open stands of timber will also see an increase in rates of spread.

#### **SPECIFIC:**

**Lassen Sector:** The fire will continue to burn in the Reading Fire scar towards Badger Mountain, and potentially onto or past the mountain. The fire will have limited spotting when burning in the snow brush, however spotting will increase when entering timber stands and burning standing snags. The fire wants to continue to the north most of the day with the wind pattern in the area.

**Shasta Sector:** Spotting is going to continue to be the issue. The islands and any vegetation near the containment lines will continue the spotting problem. Areas where the overstory is still intact without active fire can still create problems. Heat sources at the base of trees can eventually burn up the tree into the canopy creating spotting concerns. The wind will continue to be adverse to many of the lines throughout the shift.

**Westwood Sector:** Most of the sector is in the mop up phase with limited activity. The main activity will be in the dozer piles and log piles. The overstory will continue fall and create new potential for ground fires. The section in the East Zone will have the more active fire in the Highway 395 corridor. The shading of the valley will reduce the potential of wind coming down the escarpment as strong. The shading will allow the fire to continue to back down the slope slowly.

**Butte Sector:** The areas with incomplete consumption of the overstory will continue to have potential for reburn as the needles and leaves create a new ground fuel. Stumps will continue to burn through the root systems. Large dozer piles or piled trees will continue to smolder unless pulled apart and moped up.

### AIR OPERATIONS

The inversion will keep the smoke in the area into the late more and should mix out as the winds increase throughout the day.

### SAFETY

The fire has been burning for over 50 days with some working on it for multiple weeks. The fire is still actively burning and has potential, make sure you understand the assignment for the day and observe the fire behavior.

### PREVENTATIVE MEASURES TO SLOW THE TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19:
