## LEADER'S INTENT:

Incident responders have a **DUTY** to safeguard each other and the public we serve from hazards. It is through **RESPECT** for everyone's health and safety that we follow these mitigations identified below. We rely on everyone's **Mutual INTEGRITY** to ensure compliance for the sake of our health and success in our mission.

COVID-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for individuals, regardless of vaccination status, includes: Face coverings: Masks are to be worn in any enclosed incident facility (tent, yurt, building, and vehicle) or common use area regardless of proximity to others. Masks need to cover the nose and mouth securely. Exceptions are a person alone in an enclosed space; outdoors and able to maintain a minimum distance of six feet; or actively engaged in firefighting.

- The Module as One concept should be used by crews and modules to the extent practical. This reduces potential exposure to Covid-19 from outside resources and the public.

**3. Objective(s):**

**Strategic Objectives:**

Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritized utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principle. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

**Leaders Intent:**

Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct timely/effective communications.
- Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely, and defensively while implementing tactics that offer a high probability of success.
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines.
- Ensure all personnel have been briefed in operational strategies and tactics.

**Management Objectives:**

- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
- Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
- Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
- Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, CALFIRE Team 1, as well as the public.
- Utilize social media and all other communication tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

**Control Objectives:**

- Keep the fire north of Grizzly Ridge and Davis Lake.
- Keep the fire south of Harvey Valley Road.
- Keep the fire east of Ponderosa Way and within established control lines.
- Keep the fire west of Highway 395 while ensuring infrastructure defense in the communities of Janesville and Milford.



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**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Another hot day with near record temperatures and very low humidity. The cold front expected on Tuesday is now expected to stay offshore and only increase wind slightly on Wednesday.

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### **WEATHER FORECAST:**

**WEATHER:** Sunny but smoky, partially clearing after 1400.

**TEMPERATURE:** Ridge high 80 to 88. Valley high 85 to 93.

**HUMIDITY:** Minimum 7 to 12 percent.

### **20 FT WIND:**

**RIDGETOP** – Variable up to 3 mph, by 1000 becoming SSW 2 to 5 mph. By 1300, ridge wind becoming SW 7 to 13 mph gusts to 24 mph. **Escarpment wind** NW 2 to 5 mph, by 1100 becoming S 1 to 4 mph. By 1300 escarpment wind SW 5 to 12 mph gusts to 22 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Down valley/downslope 1 to 3 mph, becoming upslope/upvalley 6 to 11 mph gusts to 20 mph.

**HAINES INDEX:** 4 Low. **LIGHTNING ACTIVITY LEVEL:** 1.

**MIXING HEIGHT/TRANSPORT WIND:** Rising to 4300 to 6300ft AGL, SSW 19 mph.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Inversion top near 5900ft elevation, breaking 1300-1400.

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**OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT:** Clear except for smoke, mainly in valleys. **Low temperature:** Ridges 55 to 65. Valleys 42 to 54. **Maximum humidity:** Ridges 25 to 35 percent. Valleys 47 to 67 percent. **Ridge wind** WSW 6 to 12 mph gusts to 20 mph, by 0300 becoming S to SW 3 to 7 mph. **Valley wind** up valley/upslope 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph, becoming downslope/down valley 1 to 4 mph. **Haines Index** 3 Very Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Inversion top around 6000ft elevation, SSE 5 mph.

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**OUTLOOK FOR TUESDAY:** Sunny except for smoke. **High temperature:** Ridges 81 to 89. Valleys 86 to 94. **Minimum humidity:** 10 to 16 percent. **Ridge wind** SE to SW 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph, by 1500 becoming W to WSW 6 to 12 mph gusts to 22 mph. **Valley wind** down valley/down slope 1 to 3 mph, becoming 2 to 8 mph gusts to 14 mph. **Escarpment wind** SW to SE 1 to 3 mph, by 1400 becoming NE 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph. **Haines Index** 3 Very Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Rising to 6800-8800ft AGL, SW 13 mph.

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**EXTENDED FORECAST:** **Tue Night/Wed:** Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 44 to 66. High 79 to 93. Higher humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 5 to 11 mph gusts to 20 mph. **Wed night/Thu:** Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 43 to 63. High 76 to 90. Little change in humidity. Afternoon ridge wind W 4 to 8 mph gusts to 14 mph. **Thu night/Fri:** Partly cloudy/mostly sunny. Low 44 to 60. High 72 to 84. Higher humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 7 to 13 mph gusts to 24 mph.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY

Hot and dry weather persists with winds mainly out of the south. Gusts up to 24 mph.

#### Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. Fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**General:** Moderate to active fire behavior expected, group torching, short crown runs and potential for 0.25-0.5-mile spotting. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. Expect rapid rates of spread in lighter fuels. Interior pockets continue to burn out. In several areas of the fire needle drop is creating potential for reburn.

**DIV NN:** Minimal activity expected.

**DIV OO:** Expect active fire behavior in and around Squaw Peak, increased potential for spotting.

**DIV PP:** Winds along the escarpment light until 1300. By 1300 winds are expected to be out of the SW with Gusts to 22 mph potentially pushing the fire down the escarpment towards Hwy 395. Increased spotting potential. South of FSR 176 winds favorable.

**QQ:** SW winds will pressure the Dixie Valley today. The fire will continue to burn in the complex terrain of Horton Ridge and towards the Sugar Fire scar. Backing, flanking, terrain/wind alignment all possible today.

**DIV RR:** Minimal fire activity.

**DIV UU:** Minimal activity expected in most of the Division. Potential for growth remains north of the Devils Punch Bowl.

**DIV WW/XX:** Minimal fire activity expected.

**Night Ops:** Moderate to active fire behavior expected. Backing, flanking, short uphill runs, torching and the potential for short range spotting remains.

**AIR OPERATIONS:** Light winds and stable air will likely limit air ops until 1400 or when the inversion breaks. Horton Ridge and the south end of Dixie Valley likely clear early with SW winds.

### SAFETY:

**The best tactical decisions and planning effort can only be made if fire weather conditions and subsequent fire behavior are taken into account.**

# RESOURCE ADVISOR MESSAGE

## Reporting of Cultural Sites

## TRASH/FOOD & WILDLIFE

- Be professional, pick up your trash and that of others, you can get trash bags from supply.
- Throwing away and storing food in proper containers can keep wildlife off the line which prevents encounters with firefighters as well as future harm to the animals.

## Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

## Water Drafting Sites

- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

## Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice “Leave No Trace” as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.

**7. CONTINGENCY: Considerations:** If primary options fail, what actions can be implemented in conjunction with primary evacuation method? Be thinking ahead.

**8. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** Updates/Changes, etc.
