

Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.</p> <p><b>Leaders Intent</b></p> <p>Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. **WEATHER DISCUSSION:** High pressure will weaken some today. As a result, high temperatures will decrease slightly. Expect mostly terrain driven winds again today. Light downslope and drainage winds this morning will transition to southwest winds along ridgetops, increasing in speed late this afternoon and evening. Lighter terrain driven winds will remain in the sheltered valleys. Very dry conditions remain with relative humidity dropping to critical levels again this afternoon. Smoke will continue to hamper visibility throughout the day, though some clearing will happen this afternoon.

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## TODAY:

**SKY/WEATHER:** Smoke throughout the day. Some lifting of smoke will occur this afternoon.

**EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Monday through Saturday:** Temperatures will begin to decrease slightly Tuesday into the mid to upper 80s, but RH values will still remain at critical levels. Late in the day Tuesday a weak weather system will approach the West Coast and increase wind speeds Tuesday evening. This will begin a more active weather pattern through Friday, with elevated wind speeds but dry conditions continuing until at least Thursday. An increase in moisture is possible late in the week.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY:

The high pressure will begin to weaken today, with humidity remaining low and temperatures cooling slightly. Temperatures will be 83-91 degrees during the day and 35-55 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 8-12 percent during the day and 20-35 percent overnight. The wind will be southwest 5-10 mph with gust to 15 mph in the afternoon with gust to 20 mph in the evening. Overnight winds will be southwest 5-10 mph.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

##### GENERAL: \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\*

The low humidity and poor recovery overnight will extend active burning into the evening and reduce the effect of smoke shading on the fire. Spotting potential is still high and increases when the smoke clears in the late morning and afternoon. The interior islands will continue to actively burn in the afternoon and can potentially cast embers across the control lines if close enough. The high pressure will reduce the vertical build if a column when there is minimal heat.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Lassen Sector:** The fire will continue to burn actively in the late morning and afternoon. The timber will be more conducive for fire spread compared to the snow brush. Spotting across the line along the southern portion of Badger Mountain will continue to be an issue with any increase of fire activity near the control line. If the fire spread onto or past Badger Mountain the fuel loading increases and will have higher potential for spotting issues.

**Shasta Sector:** The spotting issues will continue in the timber, however the potential reduces as the fire moves closer to Highway 44. The terrain flattens with increased spacing in the timber reducing the potential for fire on the crowns. The large areas of grass will aid in fire suppression efforts when spotting does occur.

**Westwood Sector:** The interior heavy fuels will continue to smolder and create issues, along with the bogs. The clear afternoons will increase the visibility and activity of the smoldering material. The Highway 395 corridor will continue to back down to the highway. Smoke production from above the ridge will begin to reduce as the fire has burned into the Beckwourth Fire. This could result in less shading over the Honey Lake area and increase the intensity of the downslope winds in the late afternoon and early evening.

**Butte Sector:** The heavy fuels will continue to smolder and have the potential to create new fire with the cured overstory falling to the ground. Stumps will continue to burn in the root systems. The bogs will also continue to smolder and create problems for extinguishment.

### AIR OPERATIONS


The inversion will hold the smoke in the area until late morning. Visibility will be good earlier on the west portion of the fire.

# FUEL-REPAIR-DEMOB MAP



When assigned to a federal fire you are considered a federal employee under the delegation of authority. Even if you are a contractor, AD or from a partner agency we recommend you follow these ethics guidelines which apply to federal employees all the time.

#### PHOTOGRAPHS AND VIDEOS OF INCIDENT

The Public Information Office would like copies of the video and pictures that you safely took while not in an emergency, fire suppression activity or in an overhead assignment. Bring your video and pictures to the Public Information trailer; they will be reviewed and possibly uploaded to our many CAL FIRE social media sites. Remember, we don't want photographs or videos that depict unsafe, unprofessional, or embarrassing circumstances, which are a serious breach of ethics.
