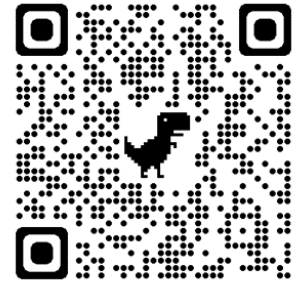

## Thank you for all that you do; you are valued and appreciated.




Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.</li> <li>• Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. 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**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** High pressure centered in central Nevada is locked in over most of California. This will mean continued mostly stagnant air with inversions harder to break and smoke harder to clear, hot temperatures that are near-record for the time of year, continued low humidity, and light but gusty wind. No break in this pattern is seen for the next seven days at least.

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**WEATHER FORECAST:**

**WEATHER:** Clear except for smoke. Smoke partially clearing by 1500.

**TEMPERATURE:** Ridge high 85 to 93. Valley high 91 to 99.

**HUMIDITY:** Minimum 10 to 15 percent.

**20 FT WIND:**

**RIDGETOP** – SSE to SW 2 to 6 mph, by 1300 becoming SW 3 to 8 mph gusts to 14 mph. By 1600 ridge wind becoming WSW to W 4 to 10 mph gusts to 18 mph.

**Escarpment wind** WSW to SW 2 to 5 mph, by 1500 becoming NW to N 2 to 6 mph gusts to 10 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Down valley/downslope 1 to 5 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 4 to 10 mph gusts to 18 mph.

**HAINES INDEX:** 4 Low. **LIGHTNING ACTIVITY LEVEL:** 1.

**MIXING HEIGHT/TRANSPORT WIND:** Rising to 6800 to 8800ft AGL, SSW 12 mph

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Inversion top around 6000ft elevation, breaking around 1300-1400.

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**OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT:** Clear with smoke, by 2300 becoming mostly clear with heavy smoke under the inversion. **Low temperature:** Ridges 58 to 72. Valleys 46 to 56. **Maximum humidity:** 23 to 33 percent. Valleys 43 to 53 percent. **Ridge wind** west 8 to 13 mph gusts to 21 mph, by 0400 becoming S to W 2 to 6 mph. **Escarpment wind** NW 10 to 18 mph gusts to 28 mph, by 0100 becoming NW 6 to 12 mph gusts to 18 mph. By 0300 escarpment wind NW 2 to 6 mph. **Valley wind** up valley/upslope 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph, becoming downslope/down valley 1 to 5 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Inversion top near 5900ft elevation, SE 6 mph.

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**OUTLOOK FOR WEDNESDAY:** Mostly sunny and smoky, by 1000 becoming sunny with partial clearing of smoke. **High temperature:** Ridges 84 to 92. Valleys 90 to 98. **Minimum humidity:** 11 to 17 percent. **Ridge wind** SSE to SW 2 to 5 mph, by 1300 becoming SW to WSW 5 to 13 mph gusts to 24 mph. **Escarpment wind** variable up to 4 mph, by 1300 becoming WNW to NW 2 to 10 mph gusts to 18 mph. **Valley wind** down valley/downslope 1 to 5 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 4 to 11 mph gusts to 20 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** 8200 to 10200ft AGL, SW 15 mph.

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**EXTENDED FORECAST:** **Wed Night/Thu:** Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 49 to 71. High 81 to 94. Higher humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 8 to 14 mph gusts to 26. **Thu night/Fri:** Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 47 to 68. High 77 to 89. Little change in humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 8 to 15 mph gusts to 28 mph. **Fri night/Sat:** Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 42 to 62. High 75 to 87. Little change in humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 6 to 12 mph gusts to 22 mph.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY

Hot and dry weather persists with winds mainly out of the south. Gusts up to 18 mph.

#### Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. Fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**General:** Moderate to active fire behavior expected, group torching, short crown runs and potential for 0.25-0.5-mile spotting. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. Expect rapid rates of spread in lighter fuels. Interior pockets continue to burn out. In several areas of the fire needle drop is creating potential for reburn.

**DIV NN:** Minimal activity expected.

**DIV OO:** Southerly winds increase potential for spotting across line.

**DIV PP:** Fire will continue to back and flank down the escarpment towards Hwy 395. Increased spotting potential. South of FSR 176 winds favorable.

**QQ:** The fire will continue to burn in the complex terrain of Horton Ridge and towards the Sugar Fire scar. Backing, flanking, terrain/wind alignment all possible today. As fire burns through timber, spotting of ¼-1/2 mi. possible.

**DIV RR:** Minimal fire activity expected.

**DIV UU:** Minimal activity expected in most of the Division. Potential for activity remains north of the Devils Punch Bowl.

**DIV WW/XX:** Minimal fire activity expected.

**Night Ops:** Moderate to active fire behavior expected. Backing, flanking, short uphill runs, torching and the potential for short range spotting remains.

**AIR OPERATIONS:** Light winds and stable air will likely limit air ops until 1300 or when the inversion breaks. Horton Ridge and the south end of Dixie Valley likely clear early with SW winds.

### SAFETY:

**Fatigue is building, don't let your guard down; maintain your situational awareness and utilize the risk management process.**



State law requires all vehicles to stop should the stop sign be extended and flashing lights occurring. Watch for signed school zones and maintain posted speed limits through zones.**

Fire Order – Retain control at all times

Narrative:

A Heat Advisory continues through most of this week. Firefighters should continue to consume plenty of fluids, take frequent breaks and increase awareness to prevent heat related illness. Hazardous trees are everywhere, keep your S.A. at a high level in your work area, lunch spot or your break areas.

You may encounter hazardous material around homes during your work shift. See the hazardous materials procedures below, to help you out. Go slow and stay aware of your surroundings. While driving to and from the incident keep to the right, make sure head lights are on and keep within the posted speed limits. We really appreciate all your hard, safe work that you all are accomplishing!!

## **KNOW YOUR LIMITATIONS**

- Most fires are innocent in appearance before unexpected shifts in wind direction and/or speed results in “flare-ups” or “extreme fire behavior.”
- Employ your subordinates in accordance with their capabilities.....set them up to succeed
- Know yourself and your limitations.....seek feedback from peers and upper management if in doubt
  - Know your surroundings, the hazards and mitigation measures to accomplish all assignments safely.

## **Hazardous Materials Procedures**

If you encounter outbuildings, vehicles and/or homes being threatened or destroyed by fire – remember: Hazardous materials may be stored, including agricultural or industrial chemicals, explosive substances, propane and other fuel tanks, plastics, etc.

If you encounter what you may suspect may be hazardous materials, generally:

- Stay upwind, uphill and avoid smoke;
- Isolate the area;
- Warn others in the immediate area;
- Notify your supervisor of the potential problem so trained specialists can evaluate and mitigate the situation;
- If not properly trained and equipped – **do not** get involved.

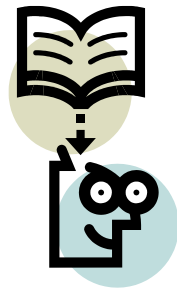

# RESOURCE ADVISOR MESSAGE

## Reporting of Cultural Sites

## TRASH/FOOD & WILDLIFE

- Be professional, pick up your trash and that of others, you can get trash bags from supply.
- Throwing away and storing food in proper containers can keep wildlife off the line which prevents encounters with firefighters as well as future harm to the animals.

## Riparian Areas

- Meadows are natural barriers. Tie the line to them, not through them. If line is needed, go around and outside of the meadow to avoid damage.
- Stream and creeks will not be used as line. If needing to cross, minimize damage (i.e. on a dozer lift the blade and only track over) to prevent post-fire stability issues. Do not push or cut line through or along them.

## Water Drafting Sites

- Access the water source while trying your best to minimize damage to the soil and vegetation.
- If using a portable pump, make sure there is a spill kit and absorption pads to catch any accidental spills.
- Place portable pumps as far away as you can from the water source. Use screens on the intakes.
- Store fuel cans away from the water source and on a flat surface.

## Working in the Wilderness

- Follow MIST for suppression actions.
- Consult with READs for spike camps, helispots, and sling sites locations.
- Practice “Leave No Trace” as much as possible.
- Work with READs to minimize visual impacts to wilderness areas when possible.
