

### INPUTS

**WEATHER SUMMARY: \*\*\*CRITICAL WEATHER DAY- HIGH WINDS/POTENTIAL THUNDERSTORMS\*\*\***

The weather will remain hot and dry again today with a chance of thunderstorms in the afternoon to overnight. Temperatures will be 80-93 degrees during the day and 45-65 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 15-23 percent during the day and 70-80 percent overnight. The wind will be southwest 6-12 mph with gust to 20 mph in the afternoon with gust to 20 mph in the evening. **Overnight winds will be southwest 10-20 with gust to 40 mph around 0400.**

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**GENERAL: \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\***

The changing weather will have dramatic impacts on the fire behavior for the next 48 hours. The wind in front of the system and behind the system will increase activity as it produces higher winds at ground level. The potential for outflow winds from collapsing cells can dramatically change the fire direction. The spotting distances will increase to ½ to 11 mile or more with developing columns and increased high-level winds. The rates of spread will increase with the higher winds surfacing. The potential for active crown fire in the timber increases with the increased winds. Propagating fire growth from spotting is highly likely.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Lassen Sector:** The fire will continue to spot with the increased wind and heavier timber on the north slopes of Badger Mountain. The wind will flow around Badger Mountain and West Prospect Mountain, producing a more southern wind. This wind will want to continue to move the fire into the Hat Creek Drainage towards Old Station. The Hat Creek Rim will have strong winds prior to and after the front moves through.

**Shasta Sector:** There will be an increased potential for active fire and spotting with higher winds during the operational period. The winds will extend farther into the flats at a higher level. This increase in wind will contribute to increased spotting distance with any flare up.

**Westwood Sector:** The top of the escarpment will have high winds starting in the late afternoon and lasting through the evening. The potential for increased activity in Division OO in the unburned area between the fire and the Walker Burn scar will increase. 1 spot across the line will spread at a rapid rate with the strong ridge winds.

**Butte Sector:** The heavy fuels will continue to smolder and have the potential to create new fire with the cured overstory falling to the ground. Stumps will continue to burn in the root systems. The bogs will also continue to smolder and create problems for extinguishment. The higher winds reaching the valleys will increase the activity of the smoldering material.

### AIR OPERATIONS

Visibility should be good early in the morning for the fire area, there may be some lingering smoke in the deeper valleys.

### SAFETY

Observe the weather throughout the day, look for cumulous buildup and the potential for collapse. Have a plan if lightning starts to strike in your area. Read the IRPG on lighting if LAL>1. Ref the page # 21

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Quiet but hot and dry conditions to start the day. Weather will begin to change midday as a cold front approaches. The front will produce a slight chance for thunderstorms this afternoon with chances increasing tonight as the front passes. Strong southwest winds are expected to increase this afternoon ahead of the front, with winds gaining strength behind the front early tomorrow and lasting into tomorrow afternoon.

**TODAY:**

**\*\*\* CRITICAL WEATHER STARTING THIS AFTERNOON \*\*\***

**SKY/WEATHER:** Slight chance of thunderstorms in the afternoon. Gusty and erratic winds up to 45 mph with storms. Partly sunny, becoming mostly cloudy in the afternoon.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** No inversion present due to mixing from strong winds.

**EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Friday through Tuesday:** Strong southwest winds will continue into Friday afternoon. Temperatures will cool and RH will increase with the passage of the front. Winds will decrease Friday evening but stay elevated with gusts to about 20 mph Saturday. Temperatures will stay cool but conditions will begin to dry again behind the front. Expect continued drying into Tuesday.





### **PERSONNEL WITH COVID-19 SYMPTOMS**

- **Symptoms per CDPH current guidelines include the following:**
  - Cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath
  - Sore throat, new loss of taste or smell
- **Incident Base of Fire Line**
  - Maintain appropriate face covering
  - Notify supervisor and proceed to CALMAT
  - Isolate and assess patient
  - Medical direction to test, return patient to home unit/agency for further testing

### **CONTACTED OR EXPOSED PERSONNEL AND ASYMPTOMATIC**

- Notify supervisor
- Maintain appropriate face covering
- Self-monitor for symptoms

### **PREVENTATIVE MEASURES TO SLOW THE TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19:**

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water or clean them with alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Maintain at least six feet distance between you and people coughing or sneezing
- Avoid touching your face
- Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing
- Stay home if you feel unwell
- Refrain from smoking and other activities that weaken the lungs
- Practice physical distancing by avoid unnecessary travel and staying away from large groups of people

# THUNDERSTORM & LIGHTNING SAFETY

## REMEMBER!

If you can hear thunder or see lightning (the actual strike vs “heat lightning” described below), you are close enough to the storm to be struck by lightning.

Heat lightning is lightning from a thunderstorm too far away for the thunder to be heard. However, the storm may be moving in your direction.

- Maintain **Situational Awareness** at all times and post **Lookouts** as needed to observe thunder cells.
- Approaching thunder cells will affect wind speed and direction.
- Keep the “**30/30 Rule**” in mind. If you see lightning and hear thunder within 30 seconds, seek shelter and/or follow the established **Safety/Disengagement Plan**.
- Take shelter inside vehicles or buildings.
- If caught outdoors, find a low spot and assume a crouched position, limiting contact with the ground.
- Avoid tall trees, wire fences, utility poles, etc.
- Do not stay on ridgetops, wide open areas, near ledges or rock outcroppings.
- Do not group together.
- Handheld radios and cellular telephones can be used.
- Do not use land line telephones, machinery, or electric motors.
- Remain in a safe environment for at least 30 minutes after the thunder cell has passed.






# FUEL-REPAIR-DEMOB MAP




