Awareness and assessment of how you're feeling can go a long way towards improving your mental state. When something is bothering you, size-up the situation:



- Name it, and be specific: vague words like bad, sad, mad, etc., don't get to the root emotions causing you to feel bad. There are over 3,000 words for emotions in the English language. Source: <https://mhanational.org/owning-your-feelings#1> Expand your emotional vocabulary.
- Allow yourself to feel this way, and don't ignore it. Bottling things up and telling yourself to "shut up and dig" can make it worse. How intense are your feelings? Are they escalating?
- Talk it out with someone you trust. You'll probably find you're not alone. Consider documenting in a journal if you can't talk right away.
- We're never afraid to order more resources on an incident, so why should this be any different? If you need help, talk to a pro via your employee assistance program.

Keep assessing and adjusting:

- Try an online Mental Health Assessment Screening, <https://screening.mhanational.org/screening-tools> People who are good at being specific about identifying and labeling their emotions are less likely to binge drink, be physically aggressive, or self-injure when distressed. WEATHER DISCUSSION: Skies will start to cloud up today in advance of low pressure and its cold front sweeping through northern California tonight and Friday morning. Expect temperatures to cool and wind to be gusty during the afternoon as it approaches today. A very slight chance of thunderstorms develops in the afternoon.

OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT: Partly cloudy, by 2300 becoming mostly cloudy. Showers likely. 40 percent chance of rain exceeding 0.10 inch. **Low temperature:** Ridges 38 to 46. Valleys 42 to 48. **Maximum humidity:** Exceeding 75 percent. **Ridge wind** SW 8 to 14 mph gusts to 22 mph, by 2300 becoming SSW 8 to 16 mph gusts to 24 mph. **Valley wind** SW 2 to 8 mph gusts to 12 mph. **Haines Index** 3 Very Low. **LAL** 2. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** No inversion, 500 to 1000ft AGL, SE 10 mph.

OUTLOOK FOR FRIDAY: Mostly cloudy, by 0800 becoming mostly sunny. A chance of showers until 0900. A slight chance of thunderstorms over the escarpment in the afternoon. Gusts to 45 mph near thunderstorms. **High temperature:** Ridges 64 to 74. Valleys 72 to 80. **Minimum humidity:** Ridges 20 to 26 percent. Valleys 15 to 21 percent. **Ridge wind** S 10 to 18 gusts to 28 mph, by 1100 becoming SW 14 to 24 mph gusts to 38 mph. **Valley wind** S 4 to 10 mph gusts to 14 mph, by 1100 becoming SW 10 to 20 mph gusts to 32 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 2 in the escarpment, 1 elsewhere. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** 3700-5700ft AGL, SW 20 mph.

EXTENDED FORECAST: **Fri Night/Sat:** Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 30 to 40. High 69 to 84. Lower humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 5 to 11 mph gusts to 20 mph. **Sat night/Sun:** Mostly clear/sunny. Low 32 to 44. High 70 to 85. Little change to humidity. Afternoon ridge wind SW 7 to 13 mph gusts to 24 mph. **Sun night/Mon:** Clear/sunny. Low 33 to 47. High 71 to 86. Little change to humidity. Afternoon ridge wind W 7 to 13 mph gusts to 24 mph.

WEATHER SUMMARY

Hot and dry weather continues, winds south in morning, shifting to more westerly in the afternoon.
Gusts up to 24 mph.

Fuels

Grass/Shrub and Timber Understory. Fuels are cured and receptive to ignition.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

General: Moderate to active fire behavior expected, group torching, short crown runs and potential for 0.25-0.5-mile spotting. In areas where wind and fuels align with terrain expect uphill runs. Expect rapid rates of spread in lighter fuels. Interior pockets continue to burn out. In several areas of the fire needle drop is creating potential for reburn.

****Cold Front expected tonight, it is a good day to scour for any remaining heat along the line.****

DIV NN/RR/WW/XX: Minimal fire activity expected. Hot spots along the line could flare up.

DIV OO: Interior pockets continue to burn together; gusty winds increase potential for spotting across line.

DIV PP: Interior pockets across the division continue to burn together, gusty winds create potential for flare ups. Fire will continue to back and flank down the escarpment towards Hwy 395. Potential for short range spotting remains.

QQ: Interior pockets will continue to burn out. Gusty winds will increase the potential for flare-ups along the line as well as potential for spotting. broken and rocky terrain of Dixie Mountain creates potential for rollout.

DIV UU: Minimal activity expected in most of the Division. Backing and flanking continues in the Devils Punch Bowl.

Night Ops: Moderate fire behavior expected. Gusty and erratic winds increase potential for flare ups and spotting. Stump holes and fuel islands continue to burn out. Rain amounts not expected to influence fire behavior.

AIR OPERATIONS: Over the majority of the fire area, it is expected to be clear and favorable for air ops.

SAFETY:

Standard Firefighting Order # 2 is key today: Know what you fire is doing at all times. Although much of this fire has exhibited little activity in recent days, it is not completely out. Hot stump holes, creeping duff fire, and fire-weakened snags and trees remain. Remain alert for these and other potentially hazardous phenomena.

Exposure to Wildland Fire Smoke – Health Risks

Wildland fire smoke contains a mixture of harmful particles and gases and that are known to cause adverse health outcomes and can potentially impair your performance.

What is in Smoke? What can happen from short-term exposures?

Carbon Monoxide (CO) –

- Higher concentration in closer proximities to the combustion source
- Moderate exposure can lead to shortness of breath and headaches
- High levels of CO can lead to headaches, confusion, and a person collapsing on exertion

Particulate Matter (PM) –

- Particles that are small and can be inhaled into the deeper parts of the lungs
- Can carry toxic gases into the lungs and bloodstream
- Short-term exposure can cause airway distress and irritation that can lead to shortness of breath, coughing and a sore throat

Health Risk - what can happen from long term exposure?

Research assessing smoke exposure and health risks suggests that wildland firefighters may:

- Have a higher risk for lung cancer and cardiovascular disease from career exposures
- Experience decreases lung function across single shifts and over fire seasons
- Have increased inflammation, which can be associated with cardiovascular and other chronic diseases, and possibly the development of cancer

Reducing Exposure to Smoke - Mitigation Strategies

- Mop-up – when conditions allow, mop-up enough to secure line
- Holding – in areas of high smoke and low visibility, use patrols rather than standing directly in smoke
- Firing - Use firing patterns that will produce more heat to result in more complete combustion and less PM

There is no easy way to reduce exposure to smoke, it is part of the wildland fire environment. However, we should continue to discuss strategies to reduce exposure. Small reductions in levels of smoke or the duration of exposure over a career may reduce health impacts.

Current Research

Join UC Berkeley and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention’s National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (CDC/NIOSH) as they conduct a rigorous scientific study to assess wildland firefighters’ exposures to smoke, occupational risk factors for COVID-19 and respiratory health outcomes. You will be asked to complete an initial survey and a short survey each day while on a fire assignment.

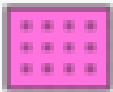

How to recognize them on the OPS MAP

There are avoidance and exclusion zones on the Operations Maps you need to know!

✔ Drafting Avoidance Area



PINK DOTS: These are areas where the water could be contaminated. Drafting water from here and using it could contaminate other areas harming people and animals

✔ Suppression Exclusion Area



RED HASH: These areas where there is an existing hazmat situation, like soil contaminated with a chemical spill. **These are very dangerous areas that should not be entered by anyone.**

✔ Dozer Avoidance Area



TAN SLASH: These are areas where dozing would damage sensitive features on the soil surface or underground, like rare plants, fragile habitat, unstable soils or buried electrical line.
