## Strategic Objective

Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritize utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principal. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

## Leaders Intent

Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take the appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct timely / effective communications
- Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely and defensively Implementation of tactics that offer a high probability of success
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines
- All line supervision personnel including crew and striketeam leaders must attend the morning Operational Briefing

## Management Objectives

- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
- Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
- Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
- Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, Great Basin Team 1 as well as the public.
- Utilize social media and all other communications tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

## Control Objectives

- Keep the fire north of Grizzly Ridge and Lake Davis
- Keep the fire south of Highway 299
- Keep the fire east of Ponderosa Way and within established control lines
- Keep the fire west of Highway 395 while ensuring infrastructure defense in the communities of Janesville and Milford

## General Situational Awareness

Steep and rugged terrain, critically dry and receptive fuel beds, active area for fire history and drought stressed trees.



## \*\*\*CRITICAL WEATHER DAY - RED FLAG WARNING TILL 11PM TONIGHT\*\*\*

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** A cold front that passed overnight is still producing isolated thunderstorms and showers in the area that will last until mid morning. Gusty winds behind this front will peak this morning and last through midday and then begin to decrease this afternoon. Winds will finally taper this evening but some gusts can still be expected. Weather and winds will clear tonight.

### TODAY:

#### \*\*\* CRITICAL WEATHER INTO TONIGHT\*\*\*

**SKY/WEATHER:** Slight chance of thunderstorms with scattered showers early in the morning. Gusty and erratic winds up to 45 mph with storms. Mostly cloudy becoming mostly sunny in the afternoon.

**MAX TEMP:** Valleys: 75-80°      **MIN HUMIDITY:** Valleys: 15-20%  
Ridgetops: 70-76°      Ridgetops: 17-23%

**CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS:** 20%

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY: \*\*\*CRITICAL WEATHER DAY- RED FLAG WARNING TILL 11PM TONIGHT\*\*\*

The weather will remain hot and dry again today with a slight chance of thunderstorms early in the morning. Temperatures will be 70-80 degrees during the day and 35-52 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 15-23 percent during the day and 50-75 percent overnight. The wind will be southwest 25-30 mph with gust to 40 mph in the morning decreasing slightly in the afternoon. Overnight winds will be southwest 15 mph with gust to 30 mph decreasing 10-20 mph.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

##### GENERAL: \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\*

The wind will continue this morning from the southwest and surfacing even into the lower valleys. The fire will be extremely active in the morning, with wind driven runs and spotting potential ½ to 1 mile. Spot fires in open timber stands and brush fields will grow rapidly in the morning. The increased winds will keep the column bent over and limit vertical growth in the morning. In the afternoon the wind will begin to subside which will allow for more vertical growth. The fire intensity will reduce as the fuels begin to thin to the north along the Hat Creek Rim.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Lassen Sector:** The fire spread will be driven by the high winds in the morning. The fuels to the north become lighter with more spacing in the timber. The open stand allows for the wind to have a higher effect on the fire, increasing the rate of spread. The fire intensity will reduce with the lighter fuels.

**Shasta Sector:** The fire will continue to flank towards Highway 44. The fire will progress at a slow to moderate rate of spread, with some head runs with the wind in the morning. Fire intensity will be high with the heavy fuels and will abate in the grass meadows. The spotting will be short range, but still has the potential to cross Highway 44.

**Butte/Westwood Sector:** The wind will be strongest over the ridge in the morning and subside slightly through the afternoon. A spot fire across the control line would spread rapidly. The overstory will continue to build a new ground fuel especially with stronger winds. Fires in this new layer will have low intensity but could lead to fire outside of the control lines.

### AIR OPERATIONS


Visibility will be clear in the fire area throughout the day with high winds in the morning.

There is a slight chance for thunderstorms in the morning. Observe the weather in the morning and plan for the changes in the afternoon.




