## Adapting After Trauma and Stress

In the aftermath of a wildfire, post-fire recovery is critical to stabilize the landscape and to protect public safety and prevent further harm to the land and cultural resources. Likewise, in the aftermath of a traumatic experience, adversity, or cumulative stress, adapting to provide for wellbeing and resilience can be challenging and overwhelming, but it's essential for mental health. The following tips are provided to assist you with achieving health following trauma and stress:

### Tips for Healing

- **Process your thoughts.** During and after experiencing trauma, it's common to go into survival mode and not have the energy to wrap your head around what happened. It may feel safest to bury painful feelings and avoid confronting them, but acknowledging what happened and how it has impacted you is an important part of healing. When you feel ready, take time to think about how you've been affected.
- **Connect with people.** The pain of trauma can lead some people to isolate themselves, but a support system is a crucial part of wellbeing. Emotional support helps us to feel less alone or overwhelmed by what's going on or has happened in our lives. Talking to someone who has gone through a similar experience or someone who cares about you can be validating and help you feel more able to overcome the challenges you're facing.
- **Don't compare your experience to others'.** We often question our own thoughts or experiences, and you may convince yourself that what you experienced wasn't a big deal because others have it worse. Everyone experiences trauma differently, and no one trauma is worse than another. If it hurt you, then it hurt you – your feelings and experiences are valid.
- **Take care of your body.** Stress and trauma impact your body and physical health just as much as your mind. Listening to your body and giving it what it needs will help you heal. This includes eating a nutritious diet, getting enough sleep, staying hydrated, and exercising regularly. Moving your body is especially helpful in trauma healing – aim to do it every day, even if it's only a few minutes of stretching.
- **Know it will take time.** There is no set timeline for how you should heal. Remove the pressure of needing to bounce back quickly and focus on taking it one step at a time. Remember: recovery isn't linear, and it's normal to have bad days and setbacks. It doesn't mean you're failing; it's just part of the process.
- **Give yourself grace.** Dealing with trauma and stress is no easy feat, but it's still common to get frustrated with yourself and what can sometimes be a slow recovery process. Try to catch when you hold yourself to unreasonable standards. Instead of angrily asking yourself why you're acting this way, think about how impressive it is that you keep going, despite what you have faced.
- **Don't feel ashamed to ask for help.** It's easy to compare how you're feeling to how you assume others who have been through similar experiences are feeling, and you may get down on yourself because it seems like everyone else is doing just fine. What others experience and how they cope doesn't matter in your journey. If you feel like you need (or want) help, it's important to get that as soon as you can.

**Strategic Objectives:**  
 Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritized utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principle. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

- Leaders Intent:**  
 Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:
- Professional behavior, conduct timely/effective communications.
  - Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely, and defensively while implementing tactics that offer a high probability of success.
  - Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines.
  - Ensure all personnel have been briefed in operational strategies and tactics.

- Management Objectives:**
- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
  - Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
  - Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
  - Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, CALFIRE Team 1, as well as the public.
  - Utilize social media and all other communication tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
  - Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

- Control Objectives:**
- Keep the fire north of Grizzly Ridge and Davis Lake.
  - Keep the fire south of Harvey Valley Road.
  - Keep the fire east of Ponderosa Way and within established control lines.
  - Keep the fire west of Highway 395 while ensuring infrastructure defense in the communities of Janesville and Milford.

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**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** The cold front that is bringing thunderstorms and wind will continue quickly moving eastward. By mid-day, skies will be clear, but wind will increase strongly.

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### **WEATHER FORECAST:**

**...RED FLAG WARNING UNTIL 2300...**

**WEATHER:** Mostly cloudy, by 1200 becoming sunny. Showers likely until 0900. A slight chance of thunderstorms until 1200. Gusts to 45 mph near thunderstorms. Rainfall: None to 0.25 inch.

**TEMPERATURE:** Ridge high 66 to 72. Valley high 72 to 80.

**HUMIDITY:** Ridge minimum 26 to 32 percent. Valley minimum 18 to 26 percent.

#### **20 FT WIND:**

**RIDGETOP** – SE to S 6 to 14 mph gusts to 23 mph, by 1100 SSW to SW 14 to 24 mph gusts to 42 mph. **Escarpment wind** SW 6 to 16 mph gusts to 22 mph, by 1100 increasing to 14 to 24 mph gusts to 46 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – SE to SSE 2 to 7 mph gusts to 12 mph, by 1100 becoming SSW to SW 12 to 19 mph gusts to 36 mph. By 1600, valley wind becoming WSW 10 to 16 mph gusts to 30 mph.

**MIXING HEIGHT/TRANSPORT WIND:** Rising to 3600 to 5600 ft AGL.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** No inversion, mixing height 200 to 1000 ft AGL.

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**OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT:** Clear. Possible fog. **Low temperature:** Ridges 42 to 54. Valleys 36 to 46. High elevation basins 30 to 36. **Maximum humidity:** Ridges 53 to 69 percent. Valleys 75 to 100 percent. **Ridge wind** SW 7 to 14 mph gusts to 24 mph, by 2200 becoming S to W 4 to 11 mph gusts to 15 mph. By 0100, ridge wind becoming NW to E 2 to 6 mph. **Escarpment wind** WSW to W 8 to 15 mph gusts to 26 mph, by 0100 becoming NW 2 to 7 mph. **Valley wind** SW to WSW 3 to 7 mph gusts to 11 mph, by 2300 becoming downslope/down valley 1 to 5 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Inversion top 5900ft elevation, ENE 6 mph.

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**OUTLOOK FOR SATURDAY:** Sunny with some smoke. **High temperature:** Ridges 70 to 78. Valleys 77 to 85. **Minimum humidity:** Ridges 15 to 21 percent. Valleys 12 to 18 percent. **Ridge wind** E to SE 4 to 10 mph gusts to 16 mph, by 1000 becoming S to SSW 3 to 9 mph gusts to 16 mph. By 1600, ridge wind becoming SW to WSW 7 to 13 mph gusts to 24 mph. **Escarpment wind** SE 2 to 5 mph, by 1300 becoming WSW 6 to 12 mph gusts to 22 mph. **Valley wind** down valley/downslope 1 to 6 mph, becoming upslope/up valley 6 to 12 mph gusts to 22 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Rising to 3400 to 5400ft AGL, SSW 16 mph.

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**EXTENDED FORECAST:** **Sat Night/Sun:** Mostly clear/mostly sunny. Low 34 to 52. High 73 to 85. Lower humidity. Afternoon ridge wind WSW 4 to 10 mph gusts to 18 mph. **Sun night/Mon:** Clear/Sunny. Low 34 to 52. High 74 to 86. Humidity little changed. Afternoon ridge wind SW 3 to 8 mph gusts to 14 mph. **Mon night/Tue:** Clear/sunny. Low 36 to 52. High 74 to 86. Afternoon ridge wind WSW 5 to 13 mph gusts to 24 mph.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY

**RED FLAG WARNING:** Ridgetop winds: **SSW to SW** Gusting to **42 mph** in the afternoon.  
Escarpment Wind: by 1100 **SW** winds gusting to **46 mph**

#### Fuels

Despite the cooler temperatures and higher relative humidity, all fuels will remain available and susceptible to rapid rates-of-spread and extreme fire behavior.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**General:** Expect an increase in fire activity with the high winds. Even areas that have seen minimal fire activity over the last several days have the potential to see more stump holes, logs and duff burn actively. If spots occur outside the lines, extreme rates of spread and long-range spotting (over 0.5 miles) should be expected. Interior pockets continue to burn out. Needle cast will continue to be an issue for reburn.

**DIV WW/XX:** Minimal fire activity expected. Hot spots along the line could flare up and needle cast could become much more active with the high winds.

**DIV UU:** Hot spots in the Devils Punch Bowl should be sheltered from the SW winds. Should this wind cause a strong rotor effect on the north slope, increased activity with uphill spread is possible.

**DIV OO:** Winds should be favorable for the west side along Squaw Peak towards the 177 Rd. Potential does exist for spots to cross the line with wind eddies.

**DIV RR/QQ:** SW winds should favor these divisions. From DP-623 to Lake Davis, SW winds will align with the fireline and there is potential for spots across this line. On Road 111, hot spots may flare up and have potential to spot into the Red Clover Valley and the improvements located there.

**DIV PP:** Escarpment winds will not favor any fire along the rim and downslope. SW winds should be favorable for the handline above DP-626, but expect variable wind directions along the face and valley.

**Honey Group:** Winds will test the perimeter of this area. The flanks should be mostly in alignment with the SW winds.

**Night Ops:** Lower temperatures, higher relative humidity and lower wind speeds will greatly reduce fire activity overnight. There may continue to be some thermal belt activity above 5900 feet.

**AIR OPERATIONS:** Clear weather will prevail over most of the day. Gusty winds may impede air operations due to wind speeds and blowing dust and ash.

### SAFETY:

High winds and fire have a threshold where fire behavior increases much faster than anticipated. This has been seen before on this fire and should be expected again with the high wind speeds predicted. Ensure that you have adequate time to utilize escape routes and get to safety zones should they need to be utilized.

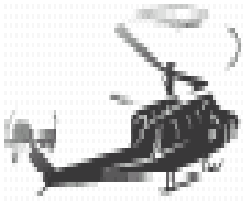

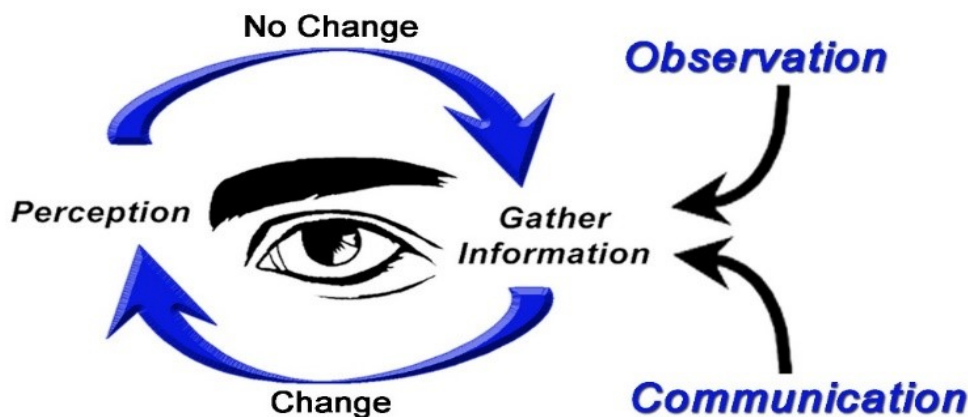

PINK DOTS: These are areas where the water could be contaminated. Drafting water from here and using it could contaminate other areas harming people and animals
- Suppression Exclusion Area**  
RED HASH: These areas where there is an existing hazmat situation, like soil contaminated with a chemical spill. **These are very dangerous areas that should not be entered by anyone.**
- Dozer Avoidance Area**  
TAN SLASH: These are areas where dozing would damage sensitive features on the soil surface or underground, like rare plants, fragile habitat, unstable soils or buried electrical line.
