**3. Objective(s):**

Strategic Objective

Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritize utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principal. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

Leaders Intent

Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take the appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct timely / effective communications
- Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely and defensively Implementation of tactics that offer a high probability of success
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines
- All line supervision personnel including crew and striketeam leaders must attend the morning Operational Briefing

Management Objectives

- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
- Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
- Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
- Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, Great Basin Team 1 as well as the public.
- Utilize social media and all other communications tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

Control Objectives

- Keep the fire north of Grizzly Ridge and Lake Davis
- Keep the fire south of Highway 299
- Keep the fire east of Ponderosa Way and within established control lines
- Keep the fire west of Highway 395 while ensuring infrastructure defense in the communities of Janesville and Milford

General Situational Awareness

Steep and rugged terrain, critically dry and receptive fuel beds, active area for fire history and drought stressed trees.






**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Calm weather behind the passage of the cold front yesterday. Mostly sunny conditions and cooler temperatures can be expected today. Minimum RH values will be moderated due to moisture that was received yesterday morning. Good RH recoveries overnight.

## TODAY:

**SKY/WEATHER:** Mostly Sunny with fair weather.

**MAX TEMP:** Valleys: 75-80°      **MIN HUMIDITY:** Valleys: 20-30%

Expect wind gusts no more than 20 mph in afternoons. Overall quiet weather.

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY:

The weather will be cooler and start to dry out. Temperatures will be 70-80 degrees during the day and 32-50 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 20-30 percent during the day and 55-78 percent overnight. The wind will be southwest 5-10 mph with gust to 20 mph in the afternoon. Overnight winds will be south-southwest 5-10 mph.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**GENERAL:** \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\*

The less than ¼ inch of rain from yesterday and the humidity recovery last night will help to moderate the fire activity. The afternoon will increase in fire activity as the sun warms the fuels and continues to dry them out. The areas in the heavy timber will see increase in fire activity sooner as the rain will have less effect on the ground fuels. The reduced activity will only last for a couple days before the conditions begin to return to before the rain came. The large, 100 and 1,000 hour, fuels will continue to burn readily as the limited moisture will not have enough of an affect on them. The rates of spread will be slow, and the probability of ignition will be low in the shaded areas. Short range spotting will be possible especially in exposed fuels in the afternoon sun.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Lassen Sector:** The ground fuels under the heavier tree canopy will have less moisture as they were more sheltered from the rain. The fire will continue to smolder and skunk around in the understory and burn the heavy dead and down. The brush and grass fields will continue to dry out in the afternoon and promote active fire.

**Shasta Sector:** The fire will continue to burn under the canopy of the trees until the afternoon as the exposed fuels dry out with the sun exposure. The spotting potential will continue to increase in the afternoon over the next several days. The trees will have torching potential as the ground fuels dry out and become more active.

**Butte/Westwood Sector:** The rain and wind increased the mount of overstory dropping to the ground. The rain was not enough to completely extinguish the heavy materials. The increasing new ground layer will dry out over the next couple of days and new smokes will continue to emerge.

### AIR OPERATIONS

Visibility will be good for aircraft operations over all areas of the fire throughout the day.

### SAFETY

Light fuels react quickly to environmental changes, as the atmosphere dries the fuel dries. The limited rain will only affect the fuels for a day or two before it returns to its dry state and increase in activity.

### PERSONNEL WITH COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

- **Symptoms per CDPH current guidelines include the following:**
  - Cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath

- Notify supervisor
- Maintain appropriate face covering
- Self-monitor for symptoms

### PREVENTATIVE MEASURES TO SLOW THE TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19:

- Maintain at least six feet distance between you and people coughing or sneezing

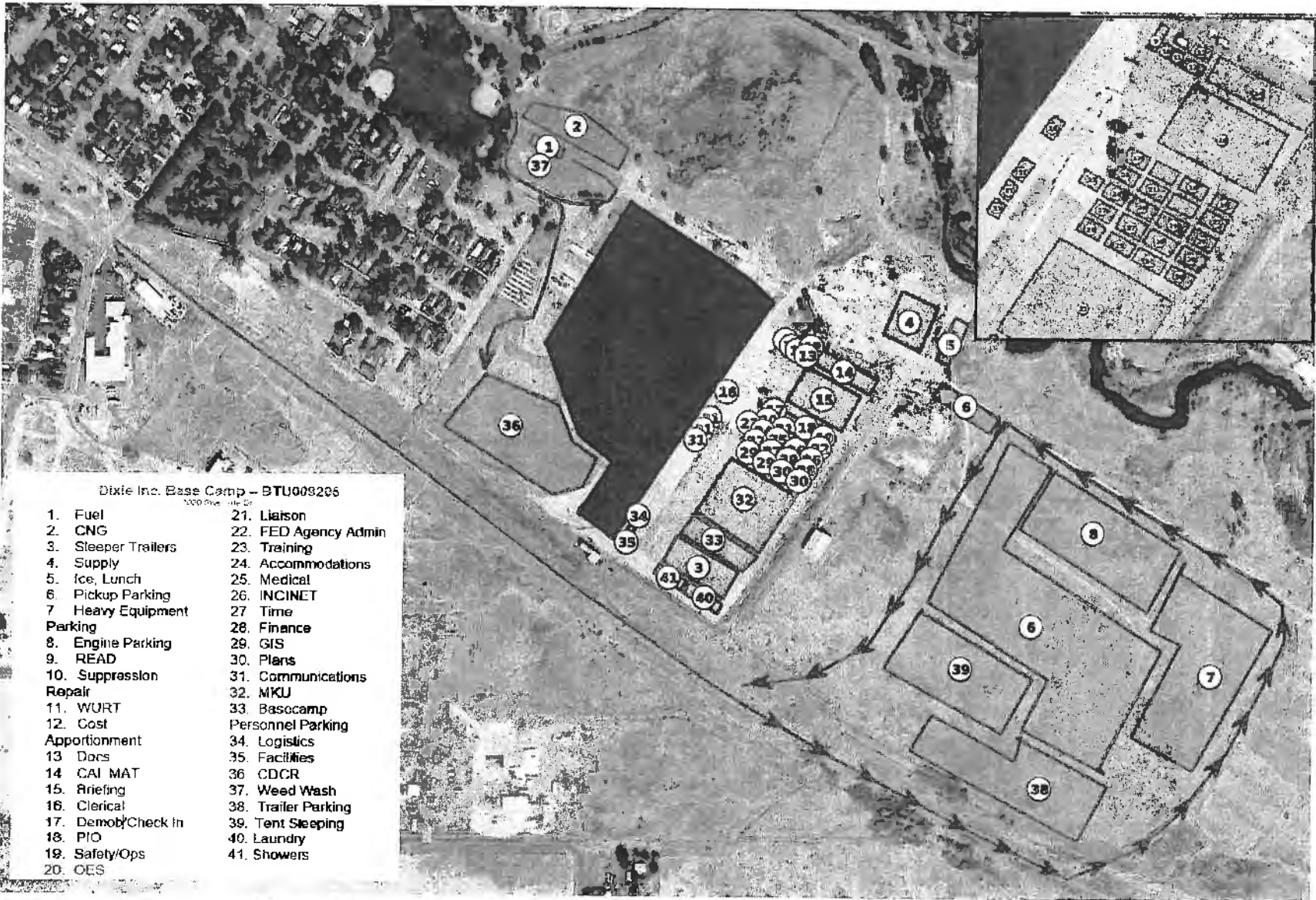
