3. Objective(s):
Strategic Objectives
 Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritized utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural / cultural values as a guiding principle. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

Leaders Intent:
 Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct timely / effective communications.
- Personal safety and the safety of others, including driving safely and defensively while implementing tactics that offer a high probability of success.
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines.
- Ensure all personnel have been briefed in operational strategies and tactics.

Management Objectives

- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
- Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incidents priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
- Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near fire area.
- Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, CALFIRE Team 1 as well as the public.
- Utilize social media and all other communication tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

Control Objectives

- Keep the fire north of Grizzly Ridge and Davis Lake.
- Keep the fire south of Harvey Valley Road.
- Keep the fire east of Ponderosa Way and within established control lines.
- Keep the fire west of Highway 395 while ensuring infrastructure defense in the communities of Janesville and Milford.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

- Yesterday's passing cold front brought in cooler temperatures and precipitation to the area. This will have a very limited effect on current extremely low fuel moistures. Little effect on larger fuels, which will remain low. Greater impact on lighter fuels which are much more receptive to short pulses of moisture. This will last for a short period of time. Make your work count on reducing heat and fire activity near control lines while fire behavior is damped down. Minimal activity today over fire as normal southwest diurnal pattern re-establishes over the area.
- As moistures in fuels dry out in the fine dead fuels (grasses, leaf litter, pine needle litter and needle-cast). Expect increase in smoldering, active fire behavior and spread where heavier fuels and stump holes have retained fire activity and provide source ignition as fuels become available.

SPECIFIC:

DIV WW/XX: Minimal fire activity expected.

DIV UU: Heat holding on steep slopes near Devils Punchbowl will be holding in place as things dry out. Favorable for mopping up and reducing heat near fires edge. Careful to watch for slippery footing, especially where retardant has been applied.

DIV OO: Winds should be favorable for the west side along Squaw Peak towards the 177 Rd. Potential does exist for spots to cross the line with wind eddies.

DIV RR/QQ: SW winds should favor these divisions. From DP-623 to Lake Davis, SW winds will align with the fireline and there is potential for spots across this line. On Road 111, hot spots may flare up and have potential to spot into the Red Clover Valley and the improvements located there.

DIV PP: Minimal fire activity expected. Escarpment winds will not favor any fire along the rim and downslope. SW winds should be favorable for the handline above DP-626 but expect variable wind directions along the face and valley.

Honey Group: Minimal fire activity expected. The flanks should be mostly in alignment with the SW winds.

Night Ops: Lower temperatures, higher relative humidity and lower wind speeds will greatly reduce fire activity overnight.

AIR OPERATIONS: Clear air today. Expect minimum fire activity impacts to due to smoke to air operations.

SAFETY: Watch your footing when working in areas where retardant has been used to reduce fire spread. Very slippery when wet or damp!

- You may be going deeper into the fire area while mopping up. This can be a harsher environment. Look for fire weakened trees and stump holes. Stop and look around to mitigate all hazards before walking into an area.

- ▶ Dozer Avoidance Area

Medical Incident Report

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT, WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM ICP COMMUNICATIONS.

Use the following items to communicate situation to ICP COMMUNICATIONS.

1. CONTACT ICP COMMUNICATIONS: (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.

Ex: "ICP Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.) This will be the Trout Meadow Medical, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
