**3. Objective(s):**
**Strategic Objective**

Implement a full suppression strategy on the Dixie Fire. Strategy and Tactics implemented on the incident are to be prioritize utilizing life safety, community infrastructure defense, and natural/cultural values as a guiding principal. Minimize acres burned on all lands by effective and efficient firefighting efforts that offer the highest probability of success while maintaining safety first.

**Leaders Intent**

Work effectively with cooperative partners towards a common goal of protecting values in a safe and efficient manner. All incident assigned personnel should be prepared to take the appropriate actions regarding:

- Professional behavior, conduct timely / effective communications
- Personal safety and safety of others, including driving slowly, safely and defensively Implementation of tactics that offer a high probability of success
- Manage fatigue by taking breaks and maintaining work rest guidelines
- All line supervision personnel including crew and striketeam leaders must attend the morning Operational Briefing

**Management Objectives**

- Utilize the risk management process to identify and mitigate hazards to protect first responders and the public. Emphasize strategies and tactics that have the highest probability of success and the least exposure to first responders and the public.
- Develop proactive strategies to protect life, residential properties, communities, businesses and infrastructure. Employ tactics that fulfill these strategies while being mindful of the necessity for contingency and emergency plans. Ensure strategies account for incident priorities, applying resources to those protecting life and residential properties first.
- Follow COVID-19, CDC and established local, state and federal guidance to limit virus spread within the incident and surrounding communities near the fire area.
- Provide timely and continuous incident information to affected agency partners, cooperators, California Team 1 as well as the public.
- Utilize social media and all other communications tools to keep the public well informed of the fire conditions and other pertinent information.
- Maintain fiscal accountability and keep costs commensurate with values at risk.

**Control Objectives**

- Keep the fire north of Grizzly Ridge and Lake Davis
- Keep the fire south of Highway 299
- Keep the fire east of Ponderosa Way and within established control lines
- Keep the fire west of Highway 395 while ensuring infrastructure defense in the communities of Janesville and Milford

**General Situational Awareness**

Steep and rugged terrain, critically dry and receptive fuel beds, active area for fire history and drought stressed trees.

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**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Calm weather continues today. Mostly sunny conditions and cooler temperatures can be expected. RH values will start to dry again, with minimum RH values dropping to the teens in the afternoon. Winds will be light and terrain driven.

**MAX TEMP:** **Valleys:** 75-82°

### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY:

The weather will be cool and continue to dry out. Temperatures will be 72-82 degrees during the day and 35-52 degrees overnight. Humidity will be 12-22 percent during the day and 40-70 percent overnight. The wind will be southwest 5-10 mph with gust to 15 mph in the afternoon. Overnight winds will be northwest around 5 mph.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

##### GENERAL: \*\*\*FUELS AND FIRE BEHAVIOR ADVISORY IN EFFECT FOR THE FIRE AREA\*\*\*

The fuels will continue to dry out from the small amount of rain received on Friday morning. The relative humidity recovery overnight will help to moderate the behavior in the morning. In the afternoon the fire will increase in activity as the sun heats the fuels and continues to dry them out. The rate of spread will also increase in the afternoon, with potential moderate rates of spread in wind prone areas. The spotting potential continues to increase as the fire fuels dry with the wind and sun. The spotting distance will be short range, several hundred feet, unless the fire becomes established and develops a column.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Lassen Sector:** The fuels will continue to dry, and the fire will become more active in the afternoons. The winds will return to more terrain driven, creating different wind patterns around the peaks. The fuels on top of the Hat Creek Rim will continue to be more active. Torching can be expected in the afternoon, with potential for short range spotting.

**Shasta Sector:** The heavy materials will continue to consume, and the ground fuels will continue to smolder in the morning and active in the afternoon. The terrain driven winds will create different wind patterns throughout the day. The denser tree stands can expect interior torching, with potential for short range spotting.

**Butte/Westwood Sector:** The rain and wind increased the mount of overstory dropping to the ground. The rain was not enough to completely extinguish the heavy materials. The increasing new ground layer will dry out over the next couple of days and new smokes will continue to emerge.

### AIR OPERATIONS

Visibility will be good for aircraft operations over all areas of the fire throughout the day.

### SAFETY

Be prepared for fire activity to increase in the afternoon and base all decisions of expected weather and fire behavior.

### CONTACTED OR EXPOSED PERSONNEL AND ASYMPTOMATIC

- Notify supervisor
- Maintain appropriate face covering
- Self-monitor for symptoms

### PREVENTATIVE MEASURES TO SLOW THE TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water or clean them with alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Maintain at least six feet distance between you and people coughing or sneezing
- Avoid touching your face
- Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing






