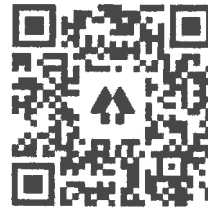

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Calm weather continues today. Mostly sunny conditions can be expected. Temperatures cool a little and RH increases slightly, but generally little change.. Winds will be light and terrain driven in valleys. However expect some gusty winds in higher elevations in the afternoon.

TODAY:

SKY/WEATHER: Sunny with fair weather.

MAX TEMP: Valleys: 78-85° **MIN HUMIDITY:** Valleys: 10-18%
Ridgetops: 72-80° Ridgetops: 14-20%

CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS: 0% **LAL:** 1.

WINDS: Valleys: Downslope/Downvalley 2-5 mph until 1000. 4-8 mph terrain driven winds in the afternoon.
Ridgetops: Variable in the morning. Becoming West-southwest 5-10 mph with gusts to 18 mph in the afternoon.

HAINES: 4 (low)

MIXING HEIGHT: Rising to 7,300 feet by 1700. **TRANSPORT WIND:** West-southwest 15-20 mph.

VISIBILITY: Unrestricted visibility south side of fire. 3-5 miles in smoke north side of fire.

INVERSION: Inversion lifting around 1000. Good afternoon ventilation.

SKY/WEATHER: Clear skies with quiet weather.

MIN TEMP: Valleys: 38-55° **MAX HUMIDITY:** Valleys: 45-70%
Ridgetops: 40-50° **Mid Slopes:** 40-50%
Ridgetops: 40-50%

CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS: 0% **LAL:** 1

WINDS: Valleys: Downslope/Downvalley 2-5 mph beginning after 2000.
Ridgetops: Southwest 10-15 mph.

TRANSPORT WIND: Southwest 15-20 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion setup around 2200.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Thursday through Monday: Weather will remain stagnant through Thursday. A frontal system approaches Friday, increasing winds. The front will move through over the weekend. This will bring strong southwest winds, high RH with cooler temperatures and possible rain. This system exits Sunday. Winds switch to a northeast direction on Monday behind the front.

- Daytime: Max. Temp: 77°, Min. RH: 15%; Nighttime: Min. Temp: 40°, Max. RH: 42%
- Winds: Terrain driven, west/southwest @ 7 mph with gusts up to 18 mph in the afternoon

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Energy Release Component is 75 in Northeast California

- **Potential for very active fire behavior.** Hot temperatures, mid-teen RH's and gusty afternoon winds could cause short to medium timber and brush timber crownfire runs and short to medium range spotting with a high probability of ignition (85%) during the heat of the burn period.
- **Live and dead fuels are critically dry** due to the drought. The vegetation is sierran mixed conifer, plantation timber and shrubs and grass - Scott and Burgan fuel models GS2, SH3/4/9, TU1/5 and TL 6/9. 1000-hr dead fuel moistures are estimated to be under 10% and live fuels are 60 – 70%. The fire is burning actively in the post-high severity 2012 Reading fire footprint in Lassen National Park.
- **Topography is mixed with flats, benches and moderately steep slopes.** The elevation ranges from 4000' near Old Station to over 8000' in Lassen National Park with all aspects represented and slopes ranging from 0 to 75%.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Expect mostly moderate fire behavior – smoldering and creeping and 4 - 5' headfire flame lengths with group brush and timber torching possible in unburned areas within the fire perimeter or if fire escapes control lines. Understory or surface rates of spread expected are between 4 – 10 chains/hour.

Maximum headfire behavior potential (Behave). Reduce these numbers by about ½ for flanking/backing/night time fire behavior:

The most active portions of fire are likely to remain in unburned interior islands/peninsulas and isolated hotspots around the fire perimeter. These areas include Lassen Park near Cluster Lakes and between North Prospect Peak, Little Bunchgrass, Rim Spur and Baker Roads. Watch for isolated heat along Suicide Tie and between Jelly Cap and Pole Line Roads and across Hwy. 44 that could flare up and rapidly spread north and east into continuous vegetation and checkerboard timber plantations.

AIR OPERATIONS

- If present, inversion/smoky conditions could limit aviation operations until it lifts between 1000 – 1200 hours
- Sunrise 0647 hours, Sunset 1916 hours

SAFETY

- Relatively quiet portions of the fire perimeter can easily flare-up as afternoon winds increase causing safety and control issues, **always remain vigilant.**

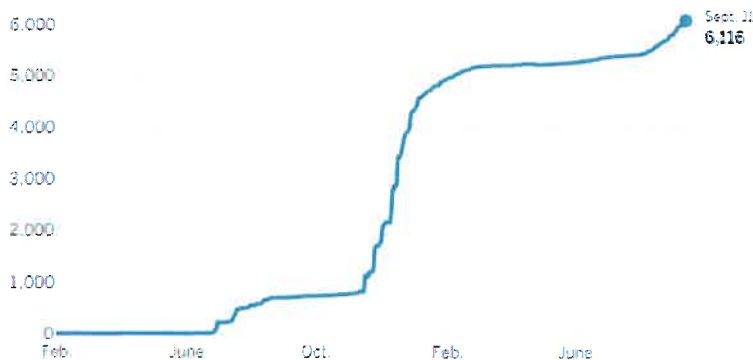

FOR A **NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT**: WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.
