

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Fair weather again today with continued drying. Warming also continues. Expect afternoon minimum RH values to drop into the teens across the fire. Winds will stay gusty out of the southwest. Winds shift to the northeast overnight and remain from this direction through Thursday.

TODAY:

SKY/WEATHER: Fair weather, clear skies. Gusty winds from the southwest.
MAX TEMP: Valleys: 78-85° **MIN HUMIDITY: Valleys:** 13-18%
Ridgetops: 73-80° **Ridgetops:** 15-20%

CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS: 0% **LAL:** 1.

WINDS: Valleys: Downslope 2-5 mph in the morning becoming southwest 6-12 mph after 1100L.
Ridgetops: Southwest 10-15 gusting to 23 mph in the afternoon.

HAINES: 4 (low)

MIXING HEIGHT: Rising to 8,000 feet by 1700. **TRANSPORT WIND:** Southwest 25-30 mph.

VISIBILITY: Unrestricted visibility.

INVERSION: Inversion break around 1000L. Good afternoon ventilation.

TONIGHT:

SKY/WEATHER: Calm weather and wind shifting to the northeast overnight.
MIN TEMP: Valleys: 36-46° **MAX HUMIDITY: Valleys:** 50-70%
Ridgetops: 40-48° **Mid Slopes:** 40-60%
Ridgetops: 40-60%

CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS: 0% **LAL:** 1

WINDS: Valleys: Southwest 5-10 mph in the evening becoming downslope 2-5 mph after 2000L.
Ridgetops: West 10-15 mph becoming northeast 6-12 mph.

TRANSPORT WIND: West becoming northeast 10-15 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Weak and shallow inversion setup at 2200L.

EXTENDED OUTLOOK: Thursday through Monday: Calm weather through the foreseeable future. High pressure means dry conditions and warm temperatures with little change day to day. RH recoveries will be poor overnight with no precipitation in the forecast to offset the dry conditions.

- Mild temperatures with breezy southwest winds
- Maximum Temperature: 75°
- Minimum RH: 21%, night time RH recovery: 50%
- Winds: Southwest with gusts 12-22 mph

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Northeast California Energy Release Component is 56 and climbing

- **Expect mostly low to moderate fire behavior** with smoldering, creeping and flaming on interior unburned islands. Isolated torching possible in areas with heavier or more continuous fuels.
- **Fuels are drying from precipitation event** and consist of grass, brush and timber - Scott and Burgan fuel models GS2, SH3/4/9, TU1/5 and TL 6/9. 1000-hour fuel moistures are < 10% and live fuels are 60 – 70%.
- **Topography is varied** and includes mountains, hills, drainages, benches and meadows. The elevation ranges from 4000' to over 8000' in Lassen Park. All aspects are represented and slopes range from 0 to 80%.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Mostly low fire behavior expected.

Maximum fire behavior potential in unburned interior islands or if fire escapes. Assumes dry fuels and sustained winds 5-20 mph.

With southwest winds, any remaining hotspots near the line in Divisions U, W and Z could flare up and potentially threaten control lines. Large interior unburned islands near Prospect Peak and in Lassen Park will continue to burn down with potential for isolated single and group tree torching.






- **Extended Medical Extractions Times:** Have a Primary, Alternate, Contingency and Emergency (P.A.C.E.) plan in place. Follow the 8 line in the 206/Medical plan (Last page in the IAP). Develop a plan before you need it.
- **Driving:** Observe posted speed limits and follow traffic laws. Don't be in a hurry. Fasten seatbelts and use backrests. Do not multi task while driving. Be prepared to encounter the public as they are allowed back into their areas. ***Slow Down!***
- **Uneven terrain/Slips, Trips and Falls:** can be dangerous due to areas with severe slope, holes, tree roots or rocks in your path. There's one primary tip that can help: Keep an eye on the ground. When walking downhill/downslope, walk perpendicular to the hill, taking shorter strides and going slowly while remaining cautious of obstacles.
- **Infectious Disease Control:** Wash hands frequently, practice social distancing, wear face coverings when and where required. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces, don't share cell phones, radios etc.

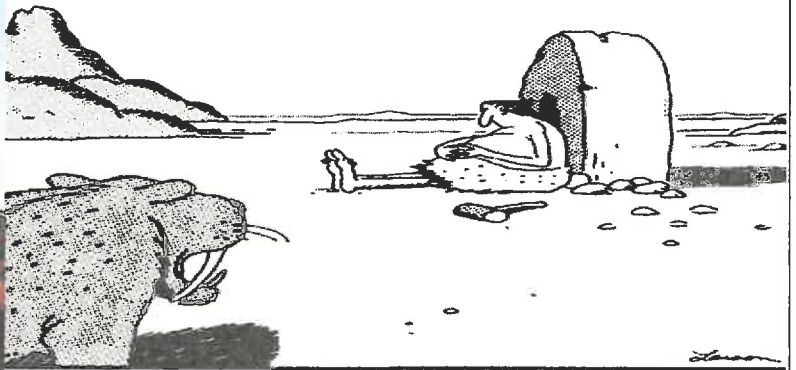

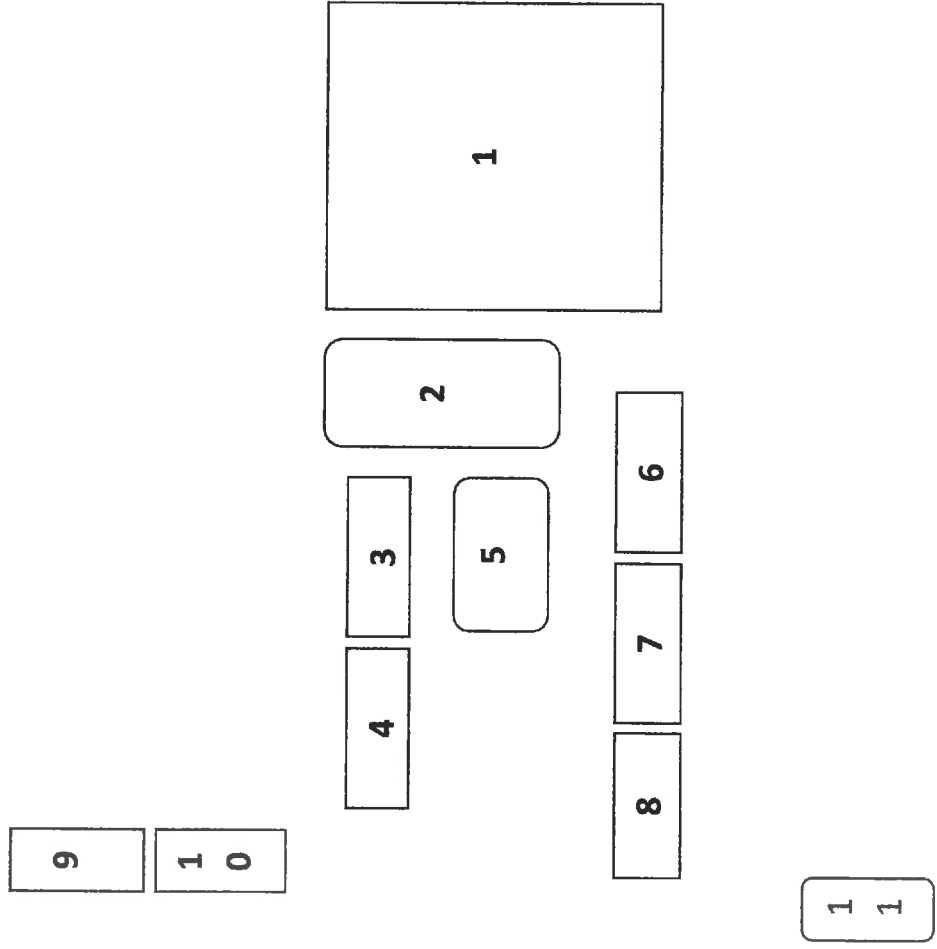

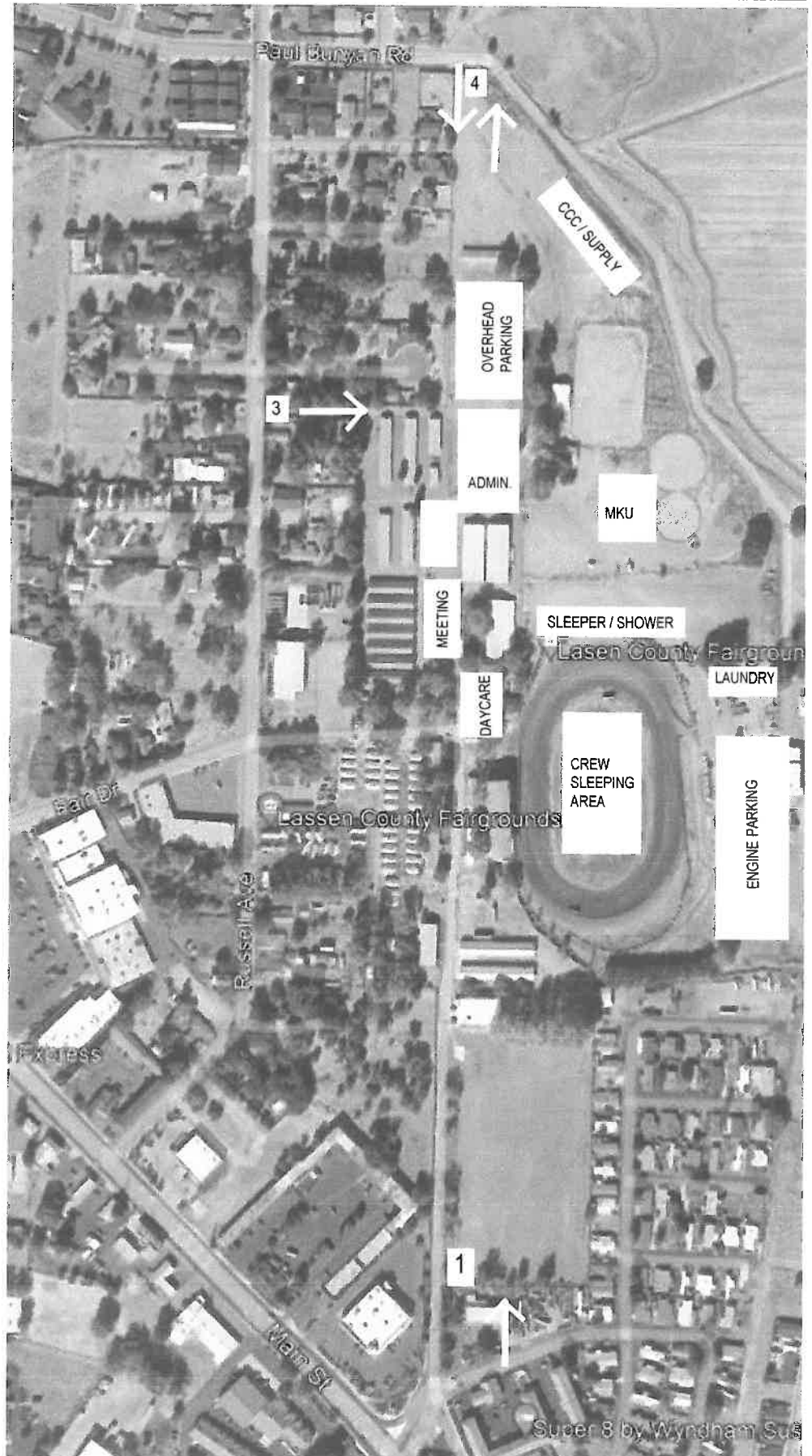

EMERGENCY DURING OPS. BRIEF 0700-0730:

- If you have an emergency while briefing is going on over the command channel. Wait for a break and transmit your emergency traffic.

LINE "NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT" PLAN:

 - Patient Complaint, Condition and Location via Tactical or Command frequency. **Priority 3/Green Tag** Patients **only** trigger an Incident within Incident (IWI) if they are being transported to a medical facility.

FOR A **NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT**: WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A **MEDICAL EMERGENCY**: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE **"MEDICAL EMERGENCY"** TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM COMMUNICATIONS

Use the following items to communicate situation to communications/dispatch.

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.) This will be the Trout Meadow Medical Incident, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
