...Breezy Southwest Winds with Low Humidity Today...

...Fire Weather Watch in Effect Monday for Gusty Winds and Low Humidity...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Cool in the morning, then sunny, dry and warm. Southwest winds increase today, with gusts to 25 mph over ridges this afternoon. High temperatures are expected to rise into the mid-70s to around 90. Moderate to poor humidity recovery in the morning, with afternoon humidity levels dropping into the teens. This will bring periods of elevated fire weather concerns for today. There is a **Fire Weather Watch** Monday afternoon through evening for stronger winds and low humidity.

WEATHER FORECAST:

WEATHER: Sunny. Hazy.

TEMPERATURE: Ridge high 70 to 79. Valley high 81 to 87.

HUMIDITY: Ridge minimum 9 to 14 percent. Valley minimum 10 to 15 percent.

20 FT WIND:

RIDGETOP – SW 4 to 6 mph gust 13 mph until 1200, then becoming SW 9 to 12 mph with gusts 20 to 25 mph in the afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY – Downslope 2 to 4 mph until 1200, then SW 5 to 10 mph with gusts to 18 mph in the afternoon.

HAINES INDEX: 4 Low

LIGHTNING ACTIVITY LEVEL: 1.

MIXING HEIGHT/TRANSPORT WIND: Rising to 5500 to 6500 ft AGL, SW 21 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion breaking 1100.

OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT: Mostly clear. Hazy. **Low temperature:** Ridges 42 to 50. Valleys 38 to 43. **Maximum humidity:** Ridges 35 to 55 percent. Valleys 50 to 60 percent. **Ridge wind** SW 6 to 11 mph with gusts to 15 mph until 2000, then SE 3 to 5 mph. **Valley wind** SW 4 to 8 mph. **Haines Index** 4. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Mixing height 4800ft dropping to 300ft, SW 10 mph.

OUTLOOK FOR MONDAY: **Fire Weather Watch Monday** Sunny and hazy. **High temperature:** Ridges 65 to 72. Valleys 73 to 78. **Minimum humidity:** Ridges 16 to 20 percent. Valleys 17 to 21 percent. Ridge wind SW 5 to 10 mph through 1200, then SW 9 to 15 mph with gusts to 30 mph. **Valley wind** Variable 2 to 5 mph through 1100, then SW 5 to 10 mph gust 15 mph. **Haines Index** 4 Low. **LAL** 1. **Mxg Hgt/Trans Wind:** Rising to 5000ft AGL, SW 23 mph.

EXTENDED FORECAST: **Mon night/Tue:** Mostly cloudy. A slight chance of Monday evening rain. A chance of rain Tuesday. Low 38 to 50. High 68 to 68. Ridge wind SW 6 to 11 mph with gusts to 21 mph. **Tue night/Wed:** Mostly clear. High 58 to 68. Ridge wind ENE 5 to 10 mph with gusts to 18 mph.

FUEL ASSUMPTIONS: The fuels involved on the Dixie fire consist primarily of conifer timber litter with a shrub or grass understory. Fuel model TU 5 (timber/shrub) best represents these conditions. There are also areas of fuel model GS 2 (shrub/grass) especially on the eastern side and lower elevation areas.

Consider all fuels available to contribute to fire spread. Grass fuels are completely cured, and live fuel moistures in shrubs and canopy are at levels that will easily carry fire. *1000 hour fuel moistures are in the single digits.*

WEATHER SUMMARY: Reference fire weather forecast for specifics. Breezy southwest winds and low relative humidities will create elevated burning conditions today!

General Fire Behavior Forecast: Expect minimal fire behavior inside the fire footprint today. A few visible smokes are likely across the fire area – predominantly from stump holes, heavies or dozer berms. Reburn from needle cast has been occurring in recent days, with creeping active flame. Should fire escape the current footprint or a new start occur – expect very active fire behavior that will organize and begin to move rather quickly. Spread rates would be high and fire would likely prove difficult to suppress.

Night Shift: Minimal fire behavior expected. Some smoldering or isolated smokes will continue. Minor fire spread in reburn/needle cast is possible. Initial attack during nighttime hours could display active fire behavior until at least midnight and diminish thereafter.

Large Fire Growth Predictors on the Plumas NF:
RH below 15% + Wind speed > 10 mph + Burning Index > 90
All 3 of these parameters could be exceeded today
Month that large fire growth conditions occur most frequently on the Plumas – September!

Specific:

DIV UU – Minimal fire behavior expected. Isolated smokes likely. Handline in Devil's Punchbowl warrants attention.

DIV RR – Minimal fire behavior expected. Scattered heat/smoke exists along Grizzly Ridge containment line.

DIV WW/XX- Minimal fire behavior expected. Isolated heat remains around Mt Hough, but appears well interior.

Div NN/QQ/PP/OO – Minimal fire behavior expected. Isolated smokes visible from Hwy 395, but appears interior.

Reburn from needle cast could occur in any of the divisions.

Initial Attack – If IA occurs, expect fire to develop quickly and to display fire behavior that could challenge control efforts.

Fine fuel moisture today is - 3 to 4%	Rates of Spread in Timber- 6 to 20 chains per hour
Probability of Ignition today - 85%	Rates of Spread in Grass- 20 to 60 chains per hour

AIR OPERATIONS : Clear skies today. Will be a bit breezy, but should not hinder aviation activities.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY: Most fire entrapments happen between 1430 and 1645. Average time from blow-up to entrapment is 24 minutes. It is wise to be within easy reach of your safety zone between 1430 and 1645.



Resource Advisor Message

- Resource advisors will continue to work with operations staff to coordinate the big picture of where equipment is best allocated over time.
- Remember to follow Regional guidelines on hazard tree removal; REAFs will have copies of those. Guidelines state no tree removal from more than one tree length from the road and 1.5 tree lengths on the uphill side of the road. Trees removed should be dead or showing sufficient mortality to be removed.
- Fuel breaks should retain large trees for shade. Valuable logs should be decked; smaller logs and branches should be chipped. Fuel breaks should not be wider than one tree width. Shrubs and smaller trees can be masticated. Avoid leaving bare soil.
- In general we are not repairing lines on private land. REAFs can document suppression damage and prepare a report if requested. Consult a REAF if you have questions. In cases where a line goes in and out of NF we will repair the line. Consult with the Agency Administrator if needed.
- REAFs will help facilitate involvement and guidance from Forest personnel on the repair effort; i.e. continue to coordinate on fire lines to be left open.

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT, WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM IMT COMMUNICATIONS/DISPATCH.

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (**Verify correct frequency prior to starting report**)

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.

Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.) This will be the Trout Meadow Medical, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."

Severity of Emergency / Transport Priority	<input type="checkbox"/> RED / PRIORITY 1 Life or limb threatening injury or illness. Evacuation need is IMMEDIATE Ex: Unconscious, difficulty breathing, bleeding severely, 2° – 3° burns more than 4 palm sizes, heat stroke, disoriented. <input type="checkbox"/> YELLOW / PRIORITY 2 Serious Injury or illness.
