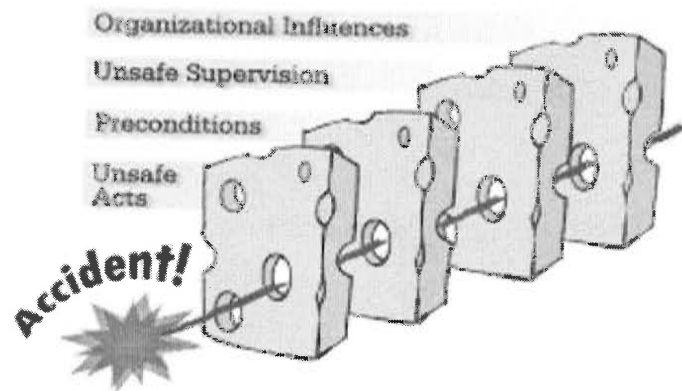
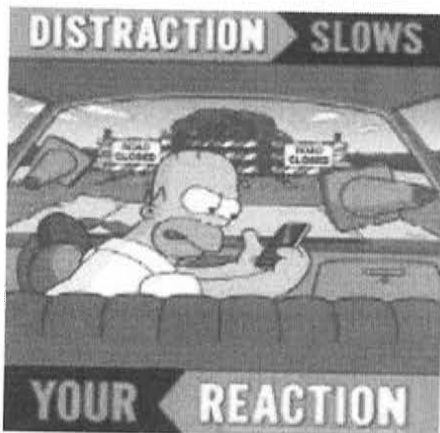



Discussion: After several days of warm and dry conditions, today we will add some breezy winds into the equation. RH should fall back into the 10-15% range and temperatures in the mid to upper 70s. As the SW winds increase during the afternoon, this could make for critical fire weather conditions-primarily between 1300-1700. The haze/smoke shading will help to hold conditions somewhat in check. Winds will increase further on Tuesday, while cooler/moister air moves in.

Forecast for Monday: *****Enhanced Fire Weather Conditions 1300-1700*****
Sky/Weather: Haze/Smoke. Very dry and breezy. Haines 5 (increased instability).

Extended Outlook: After several days of warm/dry conditions with breezy winds to start the week, the pattern will shift in a major way. A much cooler airmass with higher RHs will move in by the end of the week. So even though SW winds might be gusty in the afternoon, fire weather concerns look to drop off significantly.

FUEL ASSUMPTIONS: The fuels involved on the Dixie fire consist primarily of conifer timber litter with a shrub or grass understory. Fuel model TU 5 (timber/shrub) best represents these conditions. There are also areas of fuel model GS 2 (shrub/grass) especially on the eastern side and lower elevation areas.

Consider all fuels available to contribute to fire spread. Grass fuels are completely cured, and live fuel moistures in shrubs and canopy are at levels that will easily carry fire. **Fine fuel moistures will be at critically low levels again today!**

WEATHER SUMMARY: Reference fire weather forecast for specifics. Remaining warm and dry today but breezes will be on the increase from the SW. Gusts may approach 25 mph on the ridges.

General Fire Behavior Forecast: Burning Conditions Remain Elevated Today! - Expect low to moderate fire behavior inside the fire footprint today. Interior islands will continue to consume slowly. A few visible smokes are likely. Reburn potential remains high.

Outside the fire footprint, fuels are extremely dry. Probability of Ignition is high and any heat source makes an ignition likely. Be extra careful with equipment and dozer berms. Rates of spread will be moderate but spotting will likely be a major challenge. Fires will display high resistance to control. Burn period likely to persist well into the evening.

Specific:

Areas of heat near Lassen and Prospect Peaks will continue to be active. Expect smoldering and creeping to continue with visible smoke production in these areas. Heat appears to be in a fire scar, so intensity is likely to remain low, but if heat finds a continuous stringer of fuel, open, spreading flame is likely. It is doubtful that intensity would be great enough to spot out of the containment lines.

Initial Attack – IA could easily occur today. PIG is very high and spread rates could be moderately high today as well. Spotting would be a problem. Fire growth in an uphill run could be substantial. Fire would most likely be difficult to suppress.

Fine fuel moisture today is – 3 to 4%	Rates of Spread in Timber- 9 to 13 chains per hour
Probability of Ignition today - 85%	Rates of Spread in Grass- 15 to 40 chains per hour
Spotting Distance Today- ½ - mile or >	Flame Lengths- 4 to 9 feet on the surface

AIR OPERATIONS: Noticeable haze forecasted, but is not expected to impact aviation visibility.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY: There is a Haines 5 forecasted for today. Haines is a good predictor of large fire growth should an initial attack occur. Do not expect containment of a new start to be routine today.



Shared Vision:

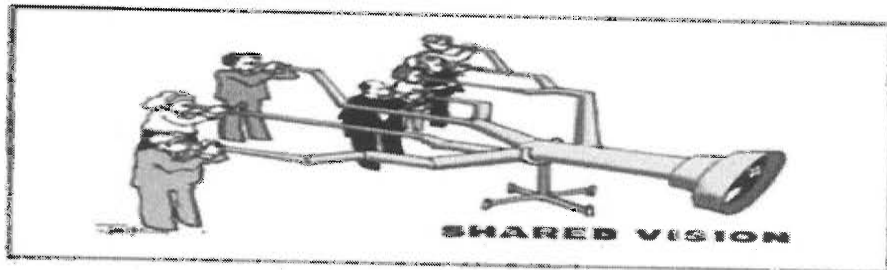

While out on assignment consider explaining the daily mission and work, not in terms of orders or direction, but rather create a story or narrative so that everyone understands. Take time throughout the day to ask if the crew understands how important the work they are doing ties in to the bigger plan. Check with everyone to see if there are suggestions on how to improve. Creating the buy-in rather than directing your people will keep them emotionally connected to the mission and it won't feel like work as much as it will feel right.

Use stories and experience to create the sense of shared vision and seek feedback
